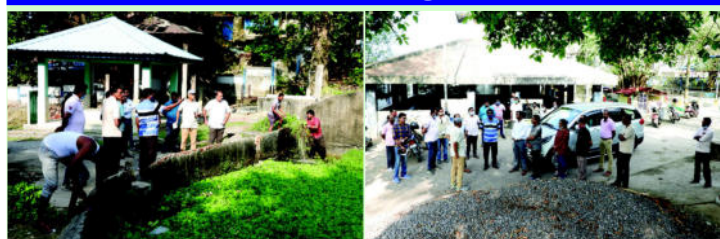

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

No positive case detected during RT-PCR test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, April 2

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 46 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 18 flights with 2431 passengers arrived, out of which, 2140 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR

test was conducted on 215 passengers and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 48 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus

Terminus, test was conducted on 24 passengers, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 27 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

9,749 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs vaccinated so far

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,10,732 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 12 and above so far. Similarly, 23,365 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 9,749

beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 10,883.

PS Pahargaon solves attempt to murder case

Port Blair, April 2

Working professionally, the team of PS Pahargaon solved the attempt to murder case of a young girl in Garacharma and arrested the absconding accused person within 24 hours. On 30/03/2022, an 18 yrs old girl was brutally assaulted with a machete inside her house at Garacharma Murdha Khadi Road by the offender Srikant Sardar. On receipt of information, an FIR was registered at PS Pahargaon. The offender absconded from the spot and went underground.

Acting swiftly, two teams were formed under the supervision of Insp. Girish Kumar, SHO PS Pahargaon for search and arrest of the absconding accused person. The teams followed several leads including sifting through various CCTV footages of the locality and examining several witnesses. Finally, the teams were able to track the accused who was hiding near Fish landing jetty, J u n g l i g h a t . Immediately, the accused person was nabbed by the team of PS Pahargaon and the weapon of

offence was also recovered. The accused is identified as Srikant Sardar, S/o Chamu Sardar, (33) yrs, Pvt. Worker, R/o Garacharma.

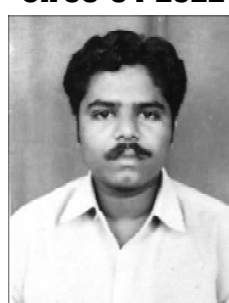
