### Forty Years Ago

Two Andhra Pradesh ministers, C Das and Chandrababu Naidu, who were suspended by PCC chief K Prabhakara Rao for defiance of party directives, handed over their resignation to CM T. N. T. Arjunan on October 9, 1981, who returned from Delhi on that day, held consultations with the party chief and his ministerial colleagues. The two ministers were suspended by Rao for participating in the Chittoor zila parishad elections in violation of the party directive.

#### Punjab Explosions

Despite an intensified police bundobast, bomb explosions continued to rock various parts of Punjab for the fourth day on Saturday. Reports of explosions were received at Chandigarh from Moga and Gurdaspur. Similar reports were received from other places in the state as well, but could not be confirmed. A high-powered bomb was reportedly hurled at the residence of a police official in Moga on Friday night. No one was reported injured, although the house was damaged. In Ghuvana village of Gurdaspur district, some miscreants were reported to have thrown a bomb at a petrol pump. The damage was, however, not "extensive", an official said. No arrests were made. A senior police official told UNI that the police had taken fresh measures to curb the "growing activity of extremists".

#### Sadat's Funeral

The body of the assassinated President Anwar Sadat was laid to rest on Saturday afternoon under the monument for the country's unknown soldier at a ceremony witnessed only by foreign dignitaries, a knot of high Egyptian officials and members of the late President's immediate family. The ceremony was held on an island with very tight security, stretching over 800 metres of an avenue along which lies the grandstand from which Sadat was reviewing a military parade when he was assassinated. A solid flank of soldiers stood shoulder-to-shoulder within the screened off avenue along which the body made its last journey. Within that area, there were soldiers watching soldiers.

## HOW MUKESH AMBANI IS ACCELERATING RELIANCE'S PUSH INTO RENEWABLE ENERGY

At the Reliance Industries' annual shareholders meeting on June 24, 2021, Mukesh Ambani announced a Rs 75,000 crore investment in a massive push into new energy business—Rs 60,000 crore towards setting up four gigafactories, and Rs 15,000 crore in value chain, partnerships and future technologies.

RIL made fortunes from petrochemicals and oil refining, but has now rightly identified that bigger opportunities lie in renewable energy. The group is accelerating its push here, with two big deals on Sunday.

On the one hand, it is acquiring REC Solar Holdings, a solar panel manufacturer, from China National Bluestar Group, and on the other, it is picking up a 40 per cent stake in Shapoorji Pallonji Group's Sterling & Wilson Solar.

The two acquisitions could clearly fast-track Ambani's ambitions in the renewable energy space. The REC Solar buy will help Reliance New Energy Solar expand into global markets including US and Europe. The investment in Sterling & Wilson will make it a stakeholder in a company that has already installed 11 GW of

solar power projects and has a presence across 24 countries.

REC has two facilities in Norway for making solar grade polysilicon, and another factory in Singapore to make PV cells and modules. In addition to this, REC has plans for a 2 GW cells and modules unit in France, 1 GW module plant in the US and expanding

its facilities in Singapore.

RIL will be able to use REC's technology to make metallic silicon and PV panels at its gigafactory in Gujarat. RIL aims to start with a 4 GW per year capacity at this Gigafactory in Jamnagar, eventually expanding to 10 GW per annum.

"It is in line with our strategy of

investing in new and advanced technologies and operating capabilities aimed at achieving Reliance's goal of enabling 100 GW clean and green energy before the end of this decade," said Mukesh Ambani, the chairman of RIL.

Sterling & Wilson with its engineering talent, deep domain knowledge, global presence and experience of executing some of the most complex projects globally, will become an important part of RIL's value chain, added Ambani.

In August this year, Reliance New Energy Solar, along with other investors, had announced an investment in US-based energy storage company Ambri Inc. RIL also recently signed a memorandum of understanding with Denmark's Stesdal Fuel Technologies for developing hydrogen electrolyser.

"RIL is well-positioned to capitalise on a sufficiently large opportunity in domestic solar business underpinned by anticipated growth in renewable power generation and recent policy initiatives for solar business including production-linked incentive scheme and customs duty protection,"

said Tarun Lakhota, analyst, Kotak Institutional Equities. The analyst said that the broking firm's preliminary analysis suggests RIL will require to invest \$3 billion to set up 10 GW of integrated capacity and it can potentially generate Rs 4,600 crore EBITDA (earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation and amortisation) in a steady-state environment.

Other analysts too have been bullish on RIL's investments into the new energy business, including for setting up the gigafactories, which will offer a diverse spectrum of renewable energy solutions.

"These investments could help capture not only India's large total addressable market of 300 GW of renewable solar capacity and 20 GW of electrolyser, but also contribute to the upcoming global demand in these areas. We estimate the new energy business could contribute EBITDA as large as its petrochemicals vertical," analysts at Morgan Stanley said in a report earlier this month.

On Monday, RIL's shares were trading 0.7 per cent higher at Rs 2,688.25 on the BSE. Sterling & Wilson was up over 7.7 per cent at Rs 468.45.

### Prime Minister to participate in G20 Extraordinary Leaders' Summit on Afghanistan in virtual format tomorrow

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will participate in the G20 Extraordinary Leaders' Summit on Afghanistan in virtual format tomorrow after the invitation of the Italian Presidency of the G-20. External Affairs Ministry said the agenda of the meeting will include a discussion on response to humanitarian needs and access to basic services and livelihood. Security and the fight against terrorism, mobility, migration and human rights will also be discussed. Prime Minister had earlier participated in the SCO-CSTO outreach Summit on Afghanistan. External Affairs Minister, Dr. S. Jaishankar, participated in the meeting of G20 Foreign Ministers on Afghanistan on the margins of the UN General Assembly in New York. The G20 comprises twenty of the world's major economies and is an important platform to help build international consensus and facilitate a coordinated approach between multilateral organizations, including the UN and its agencies and global and regional actors to address the worsening humanitarian crisis in Afghanistan.

### A growing worry for charities: Tax havens for the rich

Aspolit that has been thrown on how many of the rich and powerful shield their wealth is also intensifying a fear among philanthropy experts: That the tax havens being used by the wealthy will increasingly siphon money away from charitable causes.

Wealthy Americans have long

sought to use charitable contributions to reduce their tax burdens. But the Pandora Papers report, issued Sunday by the International Consortium of Investigative Journalists, revealed how world leaders, billionaires and others have stashed trillions of dollars out of the reach of governments by using shell companies and offshore accounts, which are considered legal.

One maneuver described in the report, a "daisy trust," can exist in perpetuity in states like South Dakota. Using these trusts, Americans can legally shield themselves from estate and other taxes and thereby remove a major incentive for charitable giving.

When the wealth of an American individual or couple exceeds a threshold of USD 11.7 million or USD 23.4 million, respectively, each donor has a duty to file a gift tax return, which is subject to a

trusts last, the longer the user can avoid taxes and the longer he or she may lack a financial incentive to donate a charity.

Experts note some Americans are also legally able to avoid state income taxes on revenue generated by their assets by setting up trusts in states that don't levy income taxes. One of them is South Dakota, which also doesn't have its own estate, capital gains or inheritance tax, thereby making it an especially attractive destination to park wealth.

There's every reason to think that the ultimate effect of this type of wealth being put into these vehicles will also be a long-term loss in revenue for charitable organizations, said Ray Madoff, a professor at Boston College Law School who teaches philanthropy policy and taxes.

The impact on the charitable sector, I would say, is probably already underway, but it will grow over time.

Tax policy, after all, consistently affects charitable giving. After the tax law changes pushed through Congress by President Donald Trump in 2017, charitable donations dropped 1.3 per cent in 2018 compared with the prior

year, the Treasury Department reported. Normally, such donations tend to grow at roughly the same pace as the nation's gross domestic product, which climbed 5.2 per cent that year.

As the Biden administration promotes its plans to raise taxes on wealthy Americans, it is building into its estimates the consideration that many people who would be affected by the tax increases would donate more to charities to lower their tax burden.

But for many wealthy individuals, trusts like those outlined in the Pandora Papers would reduce their tax burden without the charitable giving. Trusts allow one person, a grantor, to transfer assets to a trustee who then manages and directs them for a third beneficiary. In such states as South Dakota, Alaska and Nevada, though, the person who transfers assets could name themselves the beneficiary of a trust.

These so-called self-settled trusts can shield assets from creditors and further reduce tax burdens by moving the assets out of the taxable estate, said Mitchell Gans, a professor at Hofstra University who specializes in tax law.

South Dakota also deploys

strict privacy laws to keep trusts out of the public eye. It is a feature that wealth advisors use as they appeal to potential clients with prospects of growing multi-generational wealth. According to the investigative report, the state's trust assets have skyrocketed to USD 360 billion during the past decade alone.

For charities, it's difficult to know what the long-term consequences of the trusts will be. Officials at numerous philanthropies and lobbying organizations declined to comment on the impact of the Pandora Papers revelations on charitable giving because, they said, they lack data on how widespread the use of these tax havens is. But some studies suggest there might be some impact. According to a recent study by the consulting firm CCS Fundraising, 25 per cent of donors cited the tax deduction as a motivation for their charitable giving.

A joint study from Bank of America and the Indiana University Lilly Family School of Philanthropy found that 22 per cent of the wealthy donors surveyed would reduce their donations if tax deductions for charitable giving were eliminated. The same study

found that 51 per cent of wealthy donors said they sometimes contribute to charity to receive a tax benefit.

Patrick Rooney, a professor of economics and philanthropic studies at Indiana University, said he believes that if daisy trusts will undermine philanthropic donations. Removing incentives for charitable contributions, he said, essentially raises the price of giving. On the other hand, Rooney noted, lower taxes could drive donors to contribute more but the causes they care about on their own terms.

Most high-net-worth households are donors to different types of charities for different reasons, he said. So we would expect some of these folks, even though they're trying to evade taxes, (to) also have some philanthropic impulses. But we won't know that for a while. Chuck Collins, director of the Inequality and the Common Good program at the progressive think tank Institute for Policy Studies, said that many wealthy Americans view their philanthropy as part of their wealth preservation technique. Still, he noted, some who are charitably inclined might nevertheless want to avoid taxes.

## Pre-budget meetings to begin from Tuesday



The annual budget exercise of the Union government will begin on Tuesday. It will start with meetings of various departments and ministries on their revised budgets for this financial year, as well as budget estimates for financial year 2023. The next Union budget, expected in the first week of February, will be crucial as it will be the blueprint on which the nation's post-pandemic recovery will depend on. Spurring demand in the market, creating jobs and aiming for high GDP growth will be the focal concerns, assuming that the worst of the pandemic is behind us. This will be the fourth budget from Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman. In a circular, the finance ministry asked all government departments to submit all the necessary information, ranging from expenditure statement entailed up to September-end, statement of budget estimates as well as demands for grants directly on the Union Budget Information System or UBIS, operated by the National Informatics Centre (NIC). "Given the special circumstances this year, the basis of the final budgetary allocations will be overall fiscal position and subject to the absorptive capacity of the ministry or department," according to the circular. The ministries also have to submit all details related to autonomous bodies or implementing agencies coming under their aegis, if they have any sum allotted to them previously. The meetings, which will be held separately, starting from Tuesday, will discuss non-tax revenue mobilisation with various government departments and the possibilities that can be tapped. The meetings are expected to go on till the second week of November, following which the doors will be thrown open to industry doyens, business chambers and also various state finance ministers to make their case.

## GOVT MAKING CONCERTED EFFORTS TO DEMOCRATISE SPACE TECH: J.SINGH

The Modi government is making concerted efforts to "democratise" space technology for the benefit of the common man and to liberate its transformative potential, Union minister Jitendra Singh said on Monday.

Singh was speaking at the launch ceremony of the Indian Space Association, a space sector industry body comprising companies such as Bharti Airtel, Larsen and Toubro,

repeat democratised space technology for the benefit of the common man," he said.

To liberate the transformative potential of space technology and make India self-reliant and technologically advanced in the space domain, the government has unleashed a series of reforms, the Union minister said.

"And then at the same time focusing on promoting ease of business for the industry and share, and

communication satellite navigation, humans in space, FDI in space, space scientific experiment space transport and technology transfer, etc.

"These policies relating to space communications, remote sensing satellite navigation and space transport have been put in public domain to seek the views of all the stakeholders and the public. I may inform you that we are now in an advanced stage of finalising the same," he said.

Singh said the prime minister has also been focusing on an industry led body, which equals the consensual voice of the industry.

"And therefore, that action, the formation of an Indian Space Association has been triggered based on this vision," he added.

Dr K Sivan, ISRO chairman and DOS secretary, said since the announcement of Space Sector Reforms in 2020, the Department of Space has taken forward the vision of the prime minister.

He said there is tremendous vigour and enthusiasm towards enabling the in-space organisations and private industry to contribute to the global space economy in a major way.

"This collective and unified effort of the ISPA should propel the ecosystem to accelerate and grow the space industry in India, including startups, MSMEs and academia. We have many challenges ahead but our efforts, including ISRO, in-space and ISPA, should be to take solid action and support large scale development of enterprises, strengthen technology and research and promote commercial space, ensuring sustained development of key components and exhibition activities," Sivan added.

The minister of state (independent charge) of earth sciences and science and technology said the government has been at the forefront of strengthening India's space capabilities.

"Over the last seven years, ever since Narendra Modi took over as the Prime Minister of India, space technology has entered every Indian household. The prime minister has ensured that concerted efforts are made by the government to democratise, I

ensuring that we are indeed on a firm trajectory to develop a niche and disruptive technologies for strategic solidarity, the prime minister has initiated a three pronged initiative to transform India into a strong space economy, which will significantly contribute to the making of India's \$5 trillion economy," he said.

Singh said on the policy front with the indulgence and support of Modi, the government has pushed for several policy initiatives such as the National Space Policy, as well as segment specific policies related to remote sensing space

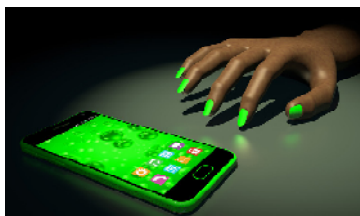
## Vaishnaw, DoT secy make 1st test call on indigenously developed 4G tech

First test call on indigenously developed 4G technology, installed in BSNL network for trial, was made on Sunday by Department of Telecom secretary to Telecom Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw, an official statement said.

To achieve the dream of Atmanirbhar Bharat in creating Indian telecom equipment for the globe, BSNL is conducting a Proof of Concept (PoC) with Tata Consultancy Services and state-run telecom research organisation C-DOT in Chandigarh, the statement said.

The PoC aims to install, integrate and test the 4G equipment in BSNL's new network for establishing its suitability for commercial deployment.

"Made first call over Indian 4G network of BSNL (Designed and

An official statement said that the first test call was made from 4G network which is designed, developed and made in India, under installation in BSNL at Chandigarh.

Rajaraman, along with BSNL chairman and managing director P K Purwar, C-DOT executive director Dr Rajkumar Upadhyaya and senior officials from TCS visited Chandigarh to review the PoC installation and performance.

"The 4G core equipment is deployed in the Manimajra telephone exchange. TCS has also installed 4G radio equipment at 5 locations in Chandigarh. The core and Radio equipment of TCS is under integration with BSNL's equipment," the statement said.

BSNL is in the process of deploying a pan-India 4G network. It has sought support of Rs 40,000 crore from the government out of which it wants to use Rs 20,000 crore for the purchase of indigenously developed 4G technology.
