New Delhi, June 8 (PIB)

Union Minister for Finance and Corporate Affairs Smti. Nirmala Sitharaman launched the Iconic Day celebrations of the Department of Economic Affairs with Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) under the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) here today. In her address, the Finance Minister said that India's fundamentals are once again sound because of the many steps taken by the Government since 2014. State Level Zoonosis Committee Meeting on Monkeypox Virus held Steps for prevention & containment of monkeypox virus in Isles in case of its occurrence discussed

Screening at airport to be enhanced; active surveillance to keep tab on any symptomatic cases stressed

Port Blair, June 8

For establishing better inter-sectoral co-ordination for prevention and control of Zoonotic diseases like Monkeypox Virus in Andaman & Nicobar Islands under the overall supervision of the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, a State Level Zoonosis Committee Meeting was held under the Chairmanship of the Commissioner-Cum-Secretary (Health),

Shri Vikas Anand in the Mini Conference Hall of Secretariat today. The objectives of the meeting are to create awareness, inform readiness and response efforts and to provide technical guidance for recommended actions.

The meeting focused on the steps to be taken for the prevention and containment of monkeypox virus in the Islands in case of its occurrence. The

Committee was briefed about the background of the disease which was followed by discussion on the possible measures that must be taken by the A&N Administration for its prevention. It was decided that the travellers coming from the endemic countries must be advised at the Point of Entry about self-monitoring for 21 days and also to issue advisory to general

populace about the disease. The Commissioner-cum-Secretary expressed his happiness over the preparedness and said, as of now, there is no case of Monkeypox in India but the screening at the airport has to be enhanced, as many tourists are arriving in the Islands. There is a need for active surveillance to keep a tab on any symptomatic cases as was done during

COVID-19. He directed the Health Department to work in tandem with the immigration at the Airport. This meeting has paved the way for future planning and implementation of Zoonotic disease surveillance in the UT. The Secretary (H)/MD UTHM, Shri Arjun Sharma and other senior officers of the Administration attended this meeting, a press release from DHS said.

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, June 8

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 179 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 13 flights with 1741 passengers arrived, out of which, 1511 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR

test was conducted on 187 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 61 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 59 passengers were tested with RAT, no

positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 44 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus and the reports were negative. At Helipad, 1 passenger was tested with RAT and the report was negative, a press release from IP&T said.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 12,800 doses of vaccine administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs so far in Isles

Port Blair, June 8

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,82,131 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,545 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 12,800 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in

the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 25890.

A total of 227 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 146 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 23 beneficiaries were vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs, 1 beneficiary was in

the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 56.

48 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 42.

Mithali Raj announces retirement from all forms of International Cricket

New Delhi, June 8

The legend of Indian Women's cricket, Mithali Raj today announced her retirement from all forms of international cricket at the age of 39 years. She retired from T20 way back in September 2019, but continued to play in ODIs and Test matches.

Mithali retires as the leading run-getter in women's ODIs. She represented India in 232 matches, scoring 7,805 runs at an average of 50.68. Mithali made her international debut in June 1999, in an ODI against Ireland. She captained India in the ICC Women's World Cup earlier this year in New Zealand, where India



failed to qualify for the semi-finals.

The stylish batter scored 2,364 runs in 89 T20Is, the most by an Indian till date. Mithali also represented India in 12 Test matches scoring 699 runs. She scored eight test centuries and 85 fifties during her more than two decades long career. Her innings of 214 against England in 2002, remains the second highest individual score by a batter in women's Test cricket.

M.V Swaraj Dweep arriving
