77.26 crores disbursed to 1899 beneficiaries in Isles to start their income generating businesses

Port Blair, May 15

Pradhan Mantri MUDRA Yojana (PMMY) is being implemented in letter & spirit by banks in these Islands. MUDRA Yojana, a loan scheme initiated by the Government of India to offer loan amount up to Rs. 10 lakh for individuals and MSMEs to start their new business or for existing businesses, without submitting any collateral or security was launched in 2015 for providing loans up to 10 lakh to the non-corporate, non-farm



small/micro enterprises.

These loans are classified as MUDRA loans under PMMY. So far, 77.26 crores have been disbursed by different banks to beneficiaries in A&N Islands to start their income generating

business.

Under the aegis of PMMY, MUDRA has created three products namely 'Shishu', 'Kishore' and 'Tarun' to signify the stage of growth/development and funding needs of the beneficiary micro

unit/entrepreneur and also provide a reference point for the next phase of graduation/growth.

In A&N Islands, under the Shishu loan scheme, 348 beneficiaries were disbursed loan amounting to Rs. 0.78 crores. Similarly, under the Kishore loan scheme, 958 beneficiaries were disbursed loan amounting to 27.68 crores while under Tarun loan scheme, 593 beneficiaries were disbursed loan amounting to Rs. 48.80 crores as on March 31,

Eligible registered farmers urged to update their KYC by May 31

The Government with a view to augment the income of the farmers, launched the Central Sector Scheme - 'Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi' (PM-KISAN) during the financial year of 2018-19 which is 100% funded by Govt. of India. Under the Scheme, eligible farmer families receive

financial benefits of Rs. 6000/- per year payable in 3 equal instalments of Rs. 2000/- each, every four months. The Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi released the 10th instalment of the scheme on 1st January, 2022 directly to the bank accounts of the PM KISAN beneficiaries.

National Family Benefit Scheme BPL category family eligible for availing benefit under the scheme

Port Blair, May 15

The Directorate of Social Welfare is implementing the National Family Benefit Scheme (NFBS) under the National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP). Under this scheme, an amount of Rs.20,000/- will be given as a lump sum assistance to the bereaved household in the event of death of the breadwinner.

It is clarified that in the event of death

(natural or otherwise) would make the family eligible for assistance. A woman in the family, who is a homemaker, is also considered a 'bread-winner' for this purpose. The family benefit will be paid to such surviving member of the household of the deceased poor, who after local enquiry, is found to be the head of the household. For the purpose of the scheme, the term 'household'

would include spouses, minor children, unmarried daughters, and dependent parents. In case of death of an unmarried adult, the term household would include minor brothers/ sisters and dependent parents.

The death of such breadwinner should have occurred while he/she is more than 18 years of age and less than 59 years of age. The assistance would

New Delhi, May 15

Environment Minister, Shri Bhupender Yadav participated in the BRICS High-Level Meeting held virtually yesterday. Speaking at the BRICS High-Level Meeting on Climate Change, the Minister highlighted the relevance of the forum to jointly address climate change, explore approaches to accelerate low-carbon and resilient transition, and achieve sustainable recovery and development.

The BRICS High-Level Meeting was chaired by Chinese Minister for Ecology and Environment, Mr. Huang Runqiu and was attended by Environment Ministers

of BRICS nations including Brazil, Russia, India, and South Africa.

Shri Yadav in his address underscored India's commitment to strong climate action including the promotion of sustainable lifestyles based on mindful consumption and reduction of waste. He informed the BRICS Ministers that under the visionary leadership of Prime Minister, how India is leading by example today by taking several robust steps in the field of renewable energy, sustainable habitats, creation of carbon sinks through additional forest and tree cover, transition to sustainable

transport, e-mobility and mobilizing the private sector to make climate commitments.

The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries can be done by both e-KYC OTP mode as well as e-KYC biometric mode. The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries through OTP mode can be done on PM-KISAN portal free of cost by the beneficiaries or State functionaries and for e-KYC biometric authentication facility, the beneficiary may visit the nearest CSC center. The CSC will charge for bio-metric authentication from each beneficiary. For any query/doubt related to e-KYC, the beneficiaries can also contact the concerned Zonal Agriculture Office/ Field Extension functionaries of Agriculture Department.

The farmers have been advised to use only the official website of PM-KISAN portal and not to download any other App for e-KYC authentication, a press release from Agriculture Department said.

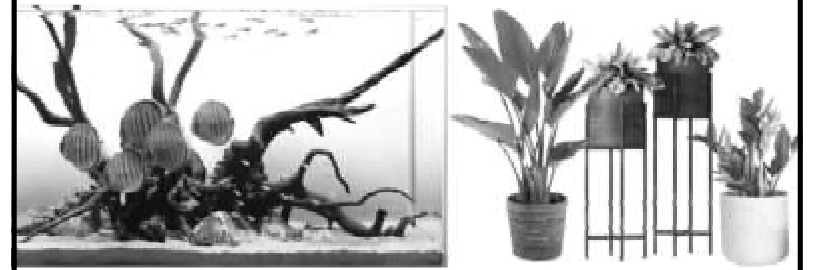

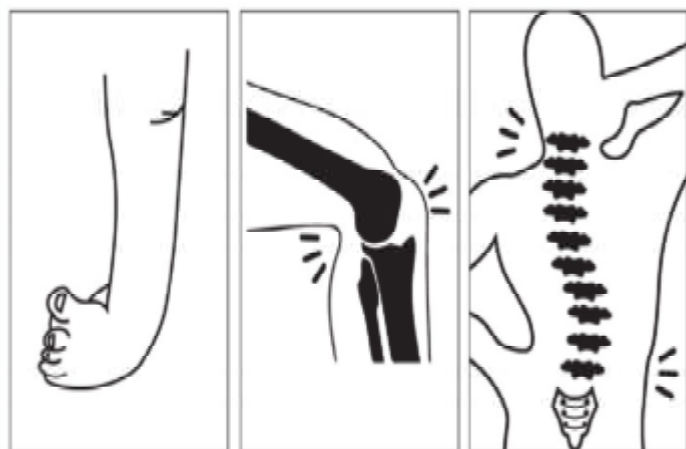

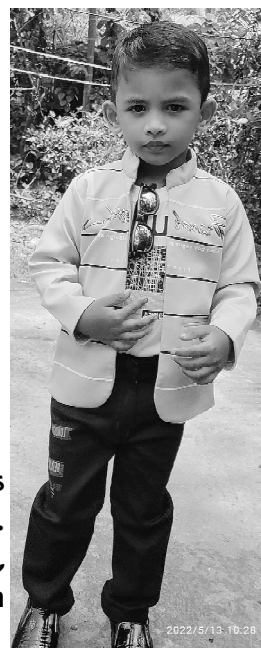
