MP demands to allow small tourist boats of Shaheed Dweep and Swaraj Dweep to operate

Port Blair, Nov 07: The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Island Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma today called on the Chief Secretary of Andaman and Nicobar Administration, Mr. Jilendra Narain and during the meeting, the Member of Parliament highlighted the issue of tourist boat operation timing in Shaheed Dweep and Swaraj Dweep. The Member of Parliament informed the Chief Secretary that instead of 8.00 AM presently the small tourist boats are being permitted to operate only after 10 AM as per the latest SOP. He informed that before lockdowns the small tourist boats were allowed to operate in these two islands from 8.00 AM. Now because of this change in timing, the boat operators are unable to reap the benefits of the

island and a large number of tourists are coming to these islands but due to present timing, the boat operators are unable to visit tourists for various water sports activities. The Member of Parliament mentioned that a large number of unemployed youths of Shaheed Dweep and Swaraj Dweep have purchased these small tourist boats for tourism activities by taking loans from Banks and now they are suffering a huge loss, even after the opening of Tourism. Hence the Member of Parliament has requested the Chief Secretary to change the timing of the boat operation from 10.00 AM to 8.00 AM, as it was there, before the COVID-19 lockdown. During the meeting, the Chief Secretary assured the Member of Parliament to do needful in this regard.

Former Civic Chief renews demand for transfer of RBD services to PBMC

Port Blair, Nov 07: While the Union Government has proposed amendments to the Registration of Births and Deaths Act (RBD), 1969 to enable it to maintain the database of registered birth and deaths at the national level and to make it people friendly, the former Chairperson of Municipal Council, Shri K. Ganesan has renewed demand for transfer of RBD services to the Port Blair Municipal Council. Despite active provisions under the Constitution of India and section 44 (p) of the Municipal Regulation 1994, the A & N Administration has retained the services of Registration of Birth and Death (RBD) under its control since 1988. The Registration of Birth and Death in the city were earlier executed by the Municipal Council after the formation of Municipal Board under the A & N Islands (Municipal) Regulation 1957. On promulgation of the Registration of Birth and Death Act 1969, the Administration framed its set of rules and notified on 08-02-1982 after which the service of registration of birth and death in the city was entrusted to the Municipal Board. But in 1988 due to some administrative reasons, the work was transferred to the Directorate of Health Services, A & N Islands, as per reports.

Temple theft case solved by Police of PS Pahargaoon

Port Blair, Nov 07: On receipt of a complaint from Shri. A. Chellazhagan, President, Sri Salva Vinayagam Temple Committee, Babubasi regarding theft of money worth approx. Rs. 30,000/- from Temple's hundi, a FR vide No. 107/21 dated 03/11/2021 U/S 380/427 IPC, was registered at PS Pahargaoon.

Acting swiftly upon the complaint, a team comprising of SI Dinesh Meena, PC/Santosh Kumar Yadav, PC/Jagdish Babu and PC/ Sudeep Kumar was constituted under the supervision of Insp. Girish Kumar, SHO PS Pahargaoon for search and arrest of the unknown accused person. Based on the analysis of CCTV footage and the modus operandi of the offence, the accused was identified as Mahesh Singh S/o Maran Singh (29) yrs R/o Brookshabad. Did You Know India Has an Active Volcano? It's Located in Andaman's Barren Island

At the heart of our planet lies a molten fiery core reaching temperatures as high as the surface of the sun. The core heats and melts portions of the mantle forming magma. Magma occasionally erupts through the openings of the crust which are called volcanoes. Of the 1,350 potentially active volcanoes in the world, only one lies in India. If you took a ferry from the southeast Indian city of Chennai, it will take you 58 hours to reach Port Blair, the capital of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Four-hour sail from there, you will get to see India's only active volcano, the Barren Island volcano.

ERUPTIONS

The Barren Island volcano, which sits on a 106-million-year-old oceanic crust, is believed to be erupted for the first time 1.6 million years ago, as indicated by its subaerial lava flow. The oldest recorded eruption, however, ranges from 1787 to 1832. The volcano went quiet for a century and erupted again in 1991. Ever since it erupts every two to three years. Its most recent eruption began in September 2018, exhibiting lava fountains — non-explosive forceful ejection of lava — and lava flows — streams of molten rock oozing from the eruption. The ash emissions continue to this day as the volcano was emitting ash clouds in frequent small eruptions till the published most recent observation was made in February this year.

THE VOLCANO

Barren Island is a 3-km-wide island, which hosts a 2-km-wide caldera surrounded by walls as high as 250 to 350 metres. About 99% of the volcano lies beneath the surface of the Indian ocean. The formation of the volcano dates back to 1.8 million years ago when a subduction-related volcano (created near the tectonic boundary of the Indo-Australian plate and Eurasian plate) was formed.

NASA TO LAUNCH SPACECRAFT TO DEFLECT ASTEROID'S PATH, ITS FIRST MISSION IN PLANETARY DEFENCE

New Delhi, 7th Oct, 2021: NASA will launch a mission to attempt a unique feat that is to slam into a tiny asteroid and slightly speed up its orbit. The mission is part its active planetary defense known as

the Double Asteroid Redirection Test (DART) and it will be launched in late November. The DART mission is planned to hit a non-threatening asteroid named Dimorphos, a moonlet

asteroid. As part of planetary defense it seeks to detect large asteroids that could potentially collide with Earth, evaluate the risk these rocks pose and attempt to avert calamity, if

required. DART will test one technique for that last step by slamming into the smaller moon of an asteroid while humans watch closely to see how much the moon's orbital period shortens.

"If there was an asteroid that was a threat to the Earth, you'd want to do this technique many years in advance, decades in advance. You would just give this asteroid a small nudge, which would add up to a big change in its future position, and then the asteroid and the Earth wouldn't be on the collision course," Nancy Chabot, scientist and DART coordination lead at Johns Hopkins Applied Physics Laboratory in Maryland, said at a pre-launch news conference on Thursday.

The planned planetary defense comes in two phases. The first requires searching the skies for as many space rocks

as possible, then tracking asteroids closely enough that scientists can model trajectories and compare them to Earth's orbit long into the future. As per NASA estimate, scientists have identified more than 27,000 near-Earth asteroids, of which nearly 10,000 are larger than 460 feet (140 meters) across, which experts worry may cause major regional damage.

While the second phase is to attempt to deflect the asteroid's path to prevent humans from going extinct like the dinosaurs.

Historically, a similar asteroid impact had wiped out most dinosaurs such creatures about 66 million years ago that specialists in planetary defense are trying to avoid.

The team hopes that mission will give scientists real data about how a kinetic impactor approach to planetary defense might work in the real world.

plate) breached the seafloor of the Indian ocean. The explosive eruptions started building andesite lavas from 2.2 km below the ocean surface. The volcanic activity continued for one million years transforming more and more lava into rocks and eventually climbing up to the ocean surface, more than 70,000 years ago. Eruptions became less violent after ards. Then, some 61,000 years ago, the volcano erupted violently emitting 15-km-high plumes of ash and a volume of magma so large within a week that usually took hundreds of years to come out. This caused the centre of the volcano to collapse, forming a 2-km-wide caldera.

OTHER VOLCANOES IN INDIA

• Narcondam Volcano: Also located in the Andaman sea, Narcondam is a dormant volcanic island that last erupted 5,60,000 years ago. Formed of andesite, the volcano's peak rises 710 above sea level.

• Deccan Traps: Now dormant, the Deccan Traps volcano last erupted 66 million years ago. One of the earth's largest volcanic features, the volcano lies in Maharashtra.

• Dhinodhar Hills: Now extinct the 385-metre-high volcano last erupted more than 500 million years ago. Located in Gujarat, the area has now become a tourist and pilgrimage spot.

• Dhosi Hill: A part of the Aravalli mountain range, the Dhosi

Hill volcano last erupted 732 million years ago after which it went extinct. The volcano is located in Dhosi, Haryana, which is about a four-hour-long drive from Delhi.

• Toshani Hill: Toshani Hill is another extinct volcano in Haryana that erupted 732 million years ago and belongs to the same suite of igneous activity as Dhosi Hill.

• Baratang: Baratang is not a regular volcano spewing lava but is a mud volcano, which erupts mud and slurries and falls in the normal habitable temperature range.

• Loktak Lake: A supervolcanic caldera, the extinct volcano that existed Loktak lake, located in Manipur, erupted 100 million years ago.

Chennai receives 'heaviest rain since 2015,' showers cause flooding on roads

Chennai, 7th Nov, 2021: Chennai experienced heavy rain overnight due to the conditions as a prelude to the forming of a low pressure over the Bay of Bengal. Private weather bloggers said this was 'heaviest rain' the city has experienced since 2015.

Nungambakkam received 215.3 mm of rain while Meenambakkam received 113.6 mm by 8.30 am on Sunday.

Rainfall in other areas till 8.30 am: Anna University 164mm, MRC Nagar 171mm, Taramani 127.5, YMCA Nandanam 157.5, ACS Medical College 103.5mm, Goodwill School Vilivakkam 200mm, Puzhal 146.5mm and Ennore Port 100mm. "Heaviest rains in Chennai since 2015, particularly in north and central Chennai areas and more clouds are moving in," weather blogger R Pradeep John posted on his Tamil

Nadu Weatherman Facebook page.

The heavy showers caused flooding in many streets and neighborhood. T Nagar, Vyasaradi, Royapet, Mylapore, Adyar and many parts of the city suffered waterlogging. Many main roads had knee-level of water in the morning. Other affected areas include Tondiarpet High Road, Jeevan Lal Nagar, Great Northern Trunk Road, Jawahar Nehru Nagar, parts of Madhavram (Ganapathy) Siva Nagar, Deepan Nagar, Raghavendra Nagar, parts of Tondiarpet (T P Scheme Road, Tiruvallur Nagar, Vinobha Nagar), parts of Royapet, parts of Teynampet (Khader Nawaz Khan Road, Sivananda Salai and others), Velachery and Sholinganagar.

Vyasarpadi Ganesapuram subway and T Nagar Duraisamy

subway were closed for traffic.

Tiruvallur collector said 3,000 cusecs of water would be released from Pooneri reservoir starting at 9 am. People residing in low-lying areas on the banks of the river Kosasthalayam were advised to be on alert. Officials of the Chennai Corporation, Metrowater and PWD were discussing if water should be released from Chembarambakkam lake.

Evacuations were under way in some areas. Officials said 500 cusecs of water would be released from Puzhal reservoir from 11 am.

The met department had forecast widespread heavy rain in the intervening night of Saturday and Sunday. The department has also forecast that a low pressure would form over the Bay of Bengal and is likely to move towards the north Tamil Nadu coast after becoming more marked low pressure.

PM Narendra Modi tops Global Leader Approval ratings with 70 per cent score, ahead of Angela Merkel, Joe Biden

New Delhi, 7th Nov, 2021: In yet another proof of his growing stature as one of the top world leaders, Prime Minister Narendra Modi has topped the 'Global Leader Approval' ratings released by American research firm - Morning Consult, with the highest percentage of ratings.

According to the data put out by the US firm on Saturday, PM Modi was ranked as the most approved world leader with a score of 70%. PM Modi is followed by Mexico President López Obrador at 66% and Italy Prime Minister Mario Draghi at 58%.

This is also not the first time that PM Modi has topped

the ratings of the American research firm. In January 2021, 'Morning Consult' rated Prime Minister Narendra Modi as the "Most Popular Head of Government". Even in September 2021, PM Modi was ranked the most approved world leader by the firm among 13 world leaders, with a percentage of 70%.

The Prime Minister is also way ahead of US President Joe Biden and UK PM Boris Johnson. Among other world leaders, German Chancellor Angela Merkel secured 54% and Australian PM Scott Morrison got 47% approvals.

US President Joe Biden ranks at the sixth spot with 44

per cent approvals. Canada's Justin Trudeau at seventh with 43 per cent while United Kingdom's Boris Johnson rounded the top 10 with 40 per cent.

The rating state that as of November 4, 2021, 70% of average Indians (sample representative of the literate population) approve Prime Minister Modi while only 24% disapprove his leadership. The US research firm tracks the approval rating for governmental leaders in Australia, Brazil, Canada, France, Germany, India, Italy, Japan, Mexico, South Korea, Spain, the United Kingdom, and the United States. On a weekly

basis, it updates the data for all 13 countries, offering real-time insight into the shifting political dynamics across the globe. Approval ratings are based on a seven-day moving average of adult residents in each country, and samples sizes vary by country.

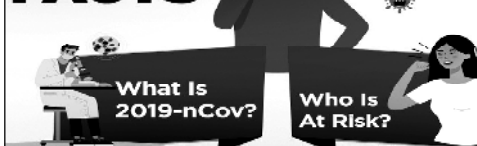

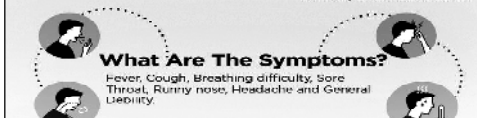

DARK SKINNED LATINOS FACE MORE DISCRIMINATION, EVEN IN THEIR OWN COMMUNITY: STUDY

Skin tone impacts the everyday lives and the long-term success of Latinos in the United States, according to a Pew Research Center finding that comes as the issue of colorism has become more mainstream.

The nonpartisan research center surveyed 3,375 Latinos who live in the U.S. finding that 62% say having darker skin hurts their chances of getting ahead while 59% say having light skin helps them. The study was released Thursday.

It comes just months after colorism discrimination based on skin tone, often from within someone's own ethnic group captured wide attention with the release of the movie *In the Heights*, which was criticized for its lack of dark-skinned Afro Latinos in leading roles.

Over the last couple of years, racism has been at the forefront of the nation's attention, but colorism isn't deliberated as often.

Some social scientists believe this is in part because colorism highlights divisions within racial and ethnic groups. Others add that colorism is a centuries-old worldwide issue that's notable in Latin American countries

colonized by Spain and where white skin has long been considered superior to dark skin and Indigenous features. Many Latinos in the U.S. may have those internal biases.

The Pew study found that 57% of Latinos say their skin tone affects their everyday life, and the majority of dark-skinned Hispanics have

white-skinned Mexicans are among the most powerful politicians, businesspeople and celebrities.

The way people with dark skin are portrayed in movies and in TV if at all also impacts how we perceive them, Flores-Yeffal said. In the Heights was hardly the exception in most American media, darker Latinos

are overrepresented in background roles or as gangsters, while lighter ones are more likely to have prominent roles, even as Latinos in general are underrepresented.

Flores-Yeffal says colorism has been going on for centuries. And it doesn't look like it's going anywhere, she said.

Laura E. Gomez, a law professor and author of *Inventing Latinos: A New Story of American Racism*, lauded the Pew study, saying it was based on rigorous data.

For Gomez, even talking about colorism is a good step toward solving the issue. While some Latinos may not feel comfortable talking about internal divisions, they are synonymous with racism in general, she said.

You can't choose one or the other. In order to combat anti-Latino racism, we must talk about racism within the Latino community, Gomez said.

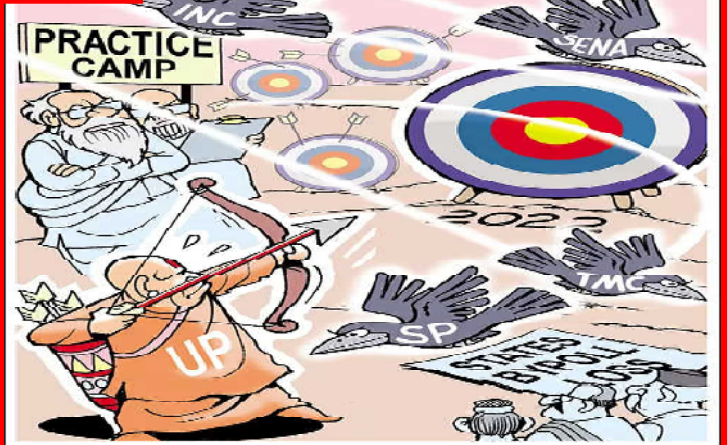

Vaughan dropped from BBC show after allegations of racism

Former England skipper Michael Vaughan has been dropped from a BBC show after allegations of racism were leveled against him by two players.

Vaughan has been working as an analyst on Test Match Special for 12 years on the BBC 5 Live's 'The Tuffers and Vaughan Cricket Show'.

But he will not appear in the show on Monday following allegations of racism by Azeem Rafiq, who claimed that Vaughan had made racist comments towards

him and other players before a Yorkshire match in 2009.

In a column for Daily Telegraph, Vaughan admitted that he was the former player implicated in the investigation into Rafiq's allegations of institutional racism at Yorkshire but "completely and categorically" denied the charges and vowed to "fight" to clear his name.

Vaughan, who represented the county from 1991 until his retirement in 2009, apparently, told a group of Asian players, including Rafiq, "Too

many of you lot, we need to do something about it."

The alleged incident occurred as Yorkshire were taking the field during a match against Nottinghamshire in 2009, Rafiq's maiden season as a professional.

"I completely and categorically deny that I ever said those words. I have nothing to hide. The 'you lot' comment never happened," the 2005 Ashes-winning captain wrote in the column. "Anyone trying to recollect words said 10 years ago will be fallible but I am adamant

those words were not said. Rafiq believes something was said at the time to upset him then that is what he believes."

BJP national executive meet to deliberate strategy for 5 state polls

New Delhi, 7th Nov, 2021: The BJP's strategy for the upcoming assembly polls in five states will come up for extensive discussion in the party's national executive meeting on Sunday as the key organisational body meets for the first time following the COVID-19 outbreak.

Addressing a press conference, BJP general secretary Arun Singh said 124 national executive members, including Prime Minister Narendra Modi, party president J P Nadda and many Union ministers, will attend the meeting physically while the members based in various states, including chief ministers, will join it virtually in line with the Covid protocol. Among other pertinent national issues and customary agenda items, the five assembly polls scheduled for early next year will be particularly deliberated, he added. One political resolution is expected to be passed at the meeting where Modi will deliver the valedictory address, which is expected to shape the party's views on a variety of issues. Nadda will deliver the inaugural address. The party will also pass a condolence message for Covid victims. The meeting assumes an extra significance as it comes against the backdrop of the results to 29 assembly and three Lok Sabha by polls spread across 13 states in which the party's performance has been mixed.

While it did well in Assam and Madhya Pradesh, it lost all three assembly and one Lok Sabha seat in Himachal Pradesh and was decimated by the TMC in West Bengal. At the venue of the national executive meeting, the party will hold exhibitions about the Modi governments 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' programmes and pro-poor measures like providing free grains to the poor and the Covid vaccination exercise. The party will highlight its efforts to help people during the pandemic.
