

First National Conference of Chief Secretaries begins in Dharamsala, Himachal Pradesh

Prime Minister to preside over three-day Conference on June 16 & 17

Dharamsala, June 15

The three-day National Conference of Chief Secretaries began at Dharamsala, Himachal Pradesh today. Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will preside over the first National Conference of Chief Secretaries tomorrow and the day after at the HPCA Stadium in Dharamsala. More than 200 participants representing the Central Government, all States/ UTs, and domain experts are taking part in the conference. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain is also participating in the Conference. The concept



and agenda of this conference have been prepared after more than 100 rounds of deliberations over a period of six months.

Three themes have been identified for detailed deliberations in the Conference: (i) Implementation of the National Education Policy; (ii) Urban governance; and (iii) Crop diversification and

achieving self-sufficiency in oilseeds, pulses, and other agri-commodities.

The conference will lay emphasis on the development and implementation of a common development agenda and a roadmap for united action to achieve the aspirations of the people.

The outcome of the conference will be discussed later in a meeting of the Governing Council of NITI Aayog, in which Chief Ministers and Administrators of all States and Union Territories will be present, to finalize an action plan with broad consensus at the highest level. (Source: india.gov.in)

IGNOU to offer a special three-year programme for 'Agniveers'

New Delhi, June 15
In order to enhance the future career prospects of Agniveers, and equip them for various job roles in the civilian sector, the Ministry of Education is to launch a special, three-year skill-based bachelor's degree programme for serving defence personnel that will recognize the skill training received by them during their tenure in the defence establishments.

The programme has been designed by IGNOU and will also be executed by them. Under this programme, 50 % of the credits required

for a graduate degree will come from the skill training - both technical and non-technical - received by the Agniveer and the remaining 50 % will come from a basket of courses that cover a wide variety of subjects like languages, Economics, History, Political Science, Public Administration, Sociology, Mathematics, Education, Commerce, Tourism, Vocational Studies, Agriculture and Jyotish, as also Ability Enhancement Courses on Environmental Studies and

Communication Skills in English.

This programme is aligned with UGC norms and with the National Credit Framework and National Skill Qualification Framework. It also has provision for multiple exit points - Undergraduate Certificate on successful completion of the first-year courses, Undergraduate Diploma on successful completion of the first and second-year courses, and Degree on completion of all the courses in the three-year time frame. Olympics gold medalist Neeraj Chopra sets new javelin record at Paavo Nurmi Games in Finland

Finland, June 15
Tokyo Olympics gold medalist ace Javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra set a new national record of 89.30 metres at Paavo Nurmi Games in Finland. Chopra's earlier national record was 88.07m which he had set in Patiala in March

last year. He had won the Tokyo Olympics gold with a throw of 87.58m on August 7, 2021. Neeraj Chopra is India's first-ever Olympic gold medallist in athletics and only the second individual gold medallist at Olympics. Neeraj Chopra won the

silver medal with his throw at the event. This was Neeraj's first competitive outing since winning the historic gold medal at the Tokyo Games. Finland's Oliver Helander won the gold medal at the event with a throw of 89.83 metres.

HS Prannoy defeats compatriot Lakshya Sen to reach second round of Indonesia Open

Jakarta, June 15
In Badminton, HS Prannoy defeated compatriot Lakshya Sen by 21 - 10, 21 - 9 to reach the second round of the Indonesia Open. This was HS Prannoy's first-ever win over World No 8 Lakshya Sen out of their three head-to-head meetings.

In Men's doubles, the duo of M.R. Arjun and Dhruv Kapila beat the Japanese pair of Kelichiro Matsui and Yoshinori Takeuchi 27-25, 18-25, 21-19. However, in women's doubles, Indian pair, Ashwini Bhat and Shikha Gautam have lost to their Chinese counterparts Zhang

Shu Xian and Zheng Yu 9-21, 10-21.

The campaign also ended for another women's pairing of Haritha M Harinarayan and Ashna Noy as the duo also faced straight games defeat against their strong South Korean counterparts of Jeong Na Eun and Kim Hye Jeong.

Common Yoga Protocol of International Day of Yoga: Day 2

VRKṢĀSANA (The Tree Posture)

Ṛkṣa means tree. The final position of this āsana resembles the shape of a tree, hence the name.

Technique

- Stand with feet 2 inches apart.
- Focus on a point in front.
- Exhale, hold and bend the right leg then place the foot on the inner side of the left thigh. The heel should be touching the perineum region.
- Inhale and extend the arms up and join the palms together for Namaskar Mudra.
- Stay in the position for 10 to 30 seconds and breathe normally.
- Exhale bring the arms down. Release the right leg and bring it to initial position.
- Repeat this āsana from the left side also.

Benefits

- Helps to improve neuro-muscular coordination, balance, endurance, alertness and concentration.

Caution

- Please avoid this practice in case of arthritis, vertigo.
