The Prime Minister of India formally launched the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) on September 1, 2017. The Yojana implemented by the Ministry of Women and Child Development is a maternity benefit programme. It is a conditional cash transfer scheme for pregnant and lactating women of 19 years of age or above for the first live birth. The objective of the Yojana is to provide partial compensation for the wage loss in terms of cash incentives so that the woman can take adequate rest before and after delivery of the first living child and the incentive provided would lead to improved health seeking behaviour amongst the Pregnant Women and Lactating



Mothers (PW&LM).

The Social Welfare Department is instrumental in implementing the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana in letter & spirit in these Islands. The number of beneficiaries' enrolled (till date) stands at 6932. A total number of

6749 beneficiaries were paid under this scheme.

The targeted beneficiaries under this Yojana are all Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers, excluding PW&LM who are in regular employment with the Central Government or the State Governments or PSUs or those who are in receipt of similar benefits under any law for the time being in force, all eligible Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers who have their pregnancy on or after 01.01.2017 for first child in family. The date and stage of pregnancy for a beneficiary would be counted with respect to her LMP date as mentioned in the MCP card.

The mother is entitled to a cash incentive of Rs. 5,000 in three

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands One positive case detected during test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, Feb. 13

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 214 passengers who arrived here yesterday, one positive case has been detected. Today, 11 flights with 1647 passengers arrived, out of which, 1439 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 188 passengers (8 foreign travellers) and the reports are awaited. During RAT

conducted on 45 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 52 passengers, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 10 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

Indian skier Arif Khan gives the country its best finish in Men's Giant Slalom event

New Delhi, Feb. 13

India got its best ever finish in Men's Giant Slalom event at the ongoing Winter Olympics in Beijing as Indian alpine skier Mohammad Arif Khan secured 45th position after a challenging second run today. After clocking 2:47.24 seconds in the second run of the event, Arif earlier finished at 46th spot, but after the disqualification of an athlete, the Indian athlete position was revised to 45th rank. Switzerland's Marco Odermatt won the Gold medal with 1:22.35 seconds in the first run at the Yanqing National Alpine Skiing Centre, 19.42s
