Chief Secretary directs Police & Labour Deptts. , DCs to formulate a proposal on verification of tenants & labourers

Police & Home Deptts. must provide self defence & arms training to citizens: CS

Port Blair, April 9

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain has directed the Police Department, Labour Department, Deputy Commissioners of all three Districts to formulate a proposal on verification of tenants and labourers coming into the Islands. He said, this is being done in the interest of safety & security of citizens and to prevent crime in the Islands. The proposal must be sent to the Home Department of A&N Administration within ten days.

The Police Department has been tasked by the Chief Secretary to carry out verification of tenants & labourers

while the Labour Department has been tasked with the responsibility to ensure that contractors bringing in labourers must provide details of labourers and also must look after their wellbeing. The Chief Secretary directed that the contractors must pay their cess. Contractors whether of Civil or Private or Defence must pay the dues as per the Labour Laws and must report about the labourers who are working under them.

The Chief Secretary reiterated that all citizens must report their tenants and all contractors must provide details on labourers working under them. This, he said is important for the security and not doing so, would call for serious penal

action. The Police will design a campaign to facilitate this, the Chief Secretary said adding that the welfare of the workers is of prime importance. The Chief Secretary also cautioned that there should not be any lapses in this regard whether deliberate or unintended.

For the safety and security of the people, the Chief Secretary has also directed the Police and Home Department to provide self defence and arms training to as many citizens as possible in a planned manner. All these proposals must reach the Chief Secretary's Office as per the broad direction by next week, the Chief Secretary said.

Persons above 18 years eligible to get Precaution dose of COVID-19 vaccines at private vaccination centres



New Delhi, April 9

The Government has decided to make precaution dose of COVID vaccines available to above 18 population group from tomorrow at private vaccination centres. The Union Health Ministry said, all those who are more than 18 years of age and have completed nine months after the administration of second dose, will be eligible for Precaution Dose.

The Ministry said, about 96 per cent of all above 15 population

in the country have received at least one COVID-19 vaccine dose so far, while about 83 per cent of above 15 population has received both the doses. More than two crore 40 lakh Precaution Doses have also been administered to Healthcare Workers, Frontline Workers and above 60 population group. The Ministry said, 45 per cent of 12 to 14 years age group have also received the first dose.


