PM urges people to buy Khadi products to mark Gandhi Jayanti with great fervour

New Delhi, Sept. 26

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressing the nation in his 'Mann Ki Baat' programme on All India Radio today, touching on the topic of cleanliness said, it was Mahatma Gandhi who turned cleanliness into a mass movement. Production of Khadi and handloom has increased multiple times as well as its demand. There were many times when the Khadi India showroom in Delhi did business of more than crore rupees. Shri Modi said people should aim to create another record on this 2nd of October, which is the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. He said doing so would also be a push for 'Vocal for Local'.

A campaign to disseminate the untold stories of freedom is also going on during Amrit Mahotsav. Upcoming young writers were called upon for the

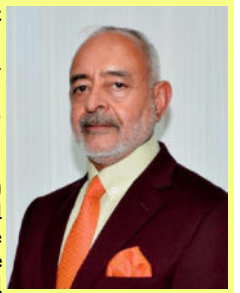

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Mangosteen (Garcinia mangostana): Future crop for the islands

Mangosteen is one of the most popular fruits in the South East Asia. It is commonly referred to as the 'finest fruit of the world' and the 'Queen of tropical fruits' owing to its superior taste, delicate aroma and exotic appearance. It is found growing in the Tropical Asian countries including Thailand, Indonesia, Vietnam, Sri Lanka and parts of Australia. The climate of Andaman and Nicobar islands being similar to the area of commercial production of mangosteen, there is ample scope for its cultivation in the Islands. In fact a theory suggested that mangosteen was developed as a natural cross between two wild species, one being from the islands. Mangosteen grows well in coconut plantations as intercrop and hence, it could be a viable option for the island farmers. Under island conditions, harvesting period is generally observed during May to August. The plant requires proper care during early stages of growth in the form of nutrient, water and shade management. Mangosteen in most of the Asian countries is pooled from backyard farms and marketed globally. Similarly, systematic cultivation of mangosteen in our islands and pooling of produce could pave way for its transportation to mainland markets. Andaman Islands, being a popular tourist destination, marketing of this exotic fruit would not be difficult.

Benefit: Diversification of island agriculture through crops such as mangosteen would improve the profitability of the sector in long run.

FM asks IBA to digitize location-wise mapping of all bank branches

New Delhi, Sept. 26 Finance Minister, Smti Nirmala Sitaraman has asked Indian Banks Association to do digitized location-wise mapping of all bank branches for every district of the nation. She asked IBA to decide where banks should have a physical presence and where we can serve customers even without physical branch. She was addressing the 74th Annual General Meeting of Indian Banks Association in Mumbai.

She said, through a rationalized approach and optimal utilization of digital technologies, we need to improve access of banking in every district. Finance Minister appreciated bankers for ensuring the amalgamation did not create inconvenience customers. She said, India needs four or five more SBIs, we need to scale up banking to meet changing requirements in light of shifting recent realities of economy and industry.

Finance Minister said, Eastern region of this country has more than adequate CASA, (Current Account Saving Account) but there are no takers for credit. She asked bankers to address this issue and see how you can lend in those regions, in states such as Bihar, Odisha etc. Finance Minister started her address by paying humble homage to all in banking industry who lost their lives serving the nation through the COVID19 pandemic. She said, in the payment world today, Indian UPI has actually made a very big impression. Rupay Card is now accepted in so many different parts of the world, symbolic of India's futuristic digital payment intentions. She praised IBA for the coming together of eight banks to form the Account Aggregator Framework. This will give tailor-made portfolios for people to choose from; people will be encouraged to voluntarily share their data. This will improve credit outreach going forward.
