

PM addresses post-budget webinar on vision of 'Gati Shakti'

New Delhi, Feb. 28 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed a webinar on the vision of Gati Shakti and its convergence with Union Budget 2022, today. This is sixth webinar in the series of post budget webinars addressed by the Prime Minister. The Prime Minister said that this year's budget has set the pace (Gati Shakti) of India's development in 21st century. This direction of 'Infrastructure-based development' will lead to extraordinary increase in the strength of our economy, creating many new possibilities of employment, he said.

The Prime Minister underlined the lack of coordination among the stakeholders in the traditional ways of completing projects. This was due to lack of clear information among the various concerned Departments. "Due to PM Gati Shakti, now everyone will be able to make their plan with

complete information. This will also lead to optimum utilization of the country's resources", he added.

The Prime Minister stressed the need of PM Gati Shakti by emphasizing the scale at which the Government is undertaking infrastructure development. "In the year 2013-14, the direct capital expenditure of the Government of India was about 1.75



lakh crore rupees, which has increased to seven and a half lakh crore rupees in the year 2022-23", the Prime Minister informed. "Infrastructure Planning, Implementation and Monitoring will get a new direction from PM Gati-Shakti. This will also bring down the time and cost overrun of the projects", he said.

The Prime Minister informed that in PM Gati-Shakti National Master Plan, more than 400 data layers are available now, informing not just the existing and proposed infrastructure but also information about the forest land and available industrial estate. He suggested that the private sector should use it more and more for their planning and all important information regarding the National Master Plan is now available on the single platform. "Due to which it will be possible to get project alignment and various types of clearances at the DPR stage itself. This will also be helpful in reducing your Compliance Burden", he said. The Prime Minister also asked the State Government's to make PM Gati-Shakti National Master Plan base for their projects and Economic Zones.

Chief Secretary, A & N Administration pleads for uninterrupted flight operations at Port Blair Airport

Port Blair, Feb. 28

In the wake of Andaman & Nicobar Command's decision to shut down the flying operations at Port Blair airport for weekly four days w.e.f 01.03.2022 for a period of three months, the Union Home Secretary took a VC meeting today to discuss and find out solutions to ensure uninterrupted air-connectivity to A & N Islands.

The meeting was attended by the Defence Secretary, Govt. of India, the Secretary, Ministry of Civil Aviation, Sr. Officers of Ministry of Defence, Chief of Staff, A & N Command, Member (Plg), Airports Authority of India and from the A & N Administration, the meeting was attended by the Chief Secretary, Shri Jitendra Narain and Senior Officers of Civil Aviation Department.

At the very outset, the Chief Secretary pointed out that in the 80 odd years of the history of the Airport where resurfacing is being done every few years, the work was always executed at night and such complete closure for 4 days in a week for executing resurfacing works of



Runway has never happened before.

During the meeting, the Chief Secretary apprised that Port Blair airport being the crucial entry and exit point to A & N Islands is very important from connectivity point of view and the decision to shut down the flight operations at Port Blair airport for 4 consecutive days/ week (Tuesday to Friday) for a period of 3 months (March, April & May, 2022) would totally disconnect the Andaman & Nicobar Islands from rest of the world and put the Islanders in this geographically isolated Islands 1300 KMs from the mainland at a great difficulty and this would also badly impact the lifestyle, subsistence and the economy of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, especially during the recovery phase of COVID-19 Pandemic.

It was also apprised by the Chief Secretary that due to non-availability of Super Speciality Hospitals in Andaman & Nicobar Islands, the local residents are totally dependent on Super Speciality Hospitals located

at Chennai, Kolkata & Delhi etc., for tertiary medical care and emergency medical treatment and surgeries. Suspension of flight operations continuously for a period of four days every week would put the lives of critically ill and patients who experience sudden deterioration of health viz., heart attack, brain stroke etc., at the risk of imminent likelihood of loss of life due to inability to access specialized Medical care due to disruption of regular Air Connectivity.

Therefore, considering the plight of the people of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, A & N Administration had been requesting review on the proposal of restricting the flight operations.

Summing up the discussion, the Administration requested the Ministry of Defence to consider to review the technical aspects and explore possibility to operate the airport with bare minimal disruption, in the larger interest of the people of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, while keeping the strategic needs in mind, a press release from Civil Aviation Department, A&N Administration said.

that "even today, the Logistic Cost in India is considered to be 13 to 14 percent of GDP. This is more than other countries. PM Gati-Shakti has a huge role in improving infrastructure efficiency". The Prime Minister talked about Unified Logistic Interface Platform- ULIP provided in this budget and which is being adapted by the various Government Departments as per their needs, leading to reduced logistics cost. "24 Digital Systems of 6 Ministries are being integrated through ULIP. This will create a National Single Window Logistics Portal which will help in reducing the logistics cost", he added.

Centre to send four Cabinet Ministers to coordinate evacuation mission to neighbouring countries of Ukraine

New Delhi, Feb. 28 Four Cabinet Ministers, Shri Hardeep Singh Puri, Shri Jyotiraditya Scindia, Shri Kiren Rijiju and Gen V K Singh to travel to neighbouring countries of Ukraine to coordinate the evacuation mission and help students. These Ministers will be going as Special Envoys of India. Shri Scindia will look at Romania and Moldova. Shri Rijiju will go to Slovakia. Shri Hardeep Singh Puri will go to Hungary and General V K Singh will be in Poland to manage the stranded Indians in Ukraine. Prime Minister held a high level meeting yesterday on the Ukraine issue and said that the Government will do whatever possible to bring back all the citizens stranded in Ukraine. COVID-19 status in A & N Islands No positive case detected during RT-PCR test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, Feb. 28 During the RT-PCR test conducted on 250 passengers who arrived here by flight yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 12 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, of which, 1858 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 194 passengers (20 foreign travellers) and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 19 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At helipad, 9 passengers were tested with RAT and no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 25 passengers and all the reports were found negative. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 23 passengers were tested with RAT and no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

Vaccination- shield against the virus 6,07,508 doses of vaccine administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far in Isles

Port Blair, Feb. 28 The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,07,508 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,183 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 8637. A total of 106 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands. 87 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 15-18 years, 4 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 4, a press release from DHS said.

The Director (Panchayat and Municipal Elections) visited Strong Room at both JNRM and Girls School, Returning Officers Room for counting of votes for Panchayats of Port Blair Tehsil at Girls School, Counting Hall of the Port Blair Zilla Parishad at Girls School and the Counting Centre and Strong Room at JNRM meant for storing polled materials of Port Blair Municipal Council.

Later in the day, the Director (Panchayat and Municipal Elections) held virtual meeting with all the Sector Officers, Sub-Divisional Magistrate (s), Assistant Commissioner (s), Tehsildar (s) of A & N Islands and deliberated that UT is entering the last phase before poll and it is imperative to have lots of MCC violations during this last week, all Sector Magistrates need to be more vigilant and prompt in disposing the cases related to MCC. He further directed to complete the physical verification of each polling station immediately and report thereof shortage of Assured Minimum Facilities, if any.

The DPME directed that all ROs should ensure that collection of postal ballots are timely ensured and had a brief discussion with all Nodal Officers of the three Districts on the plan chalked out for distribution of polling materials/ EVMs to polling parties.

Further, the Micro Observers appointed by the Director, Panchayat and Municipal Elections were imparted training at DBRAIT auditorium from 1700 hrs onwards on 28.02.2022, a press release from DPME said.

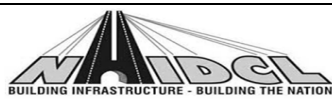

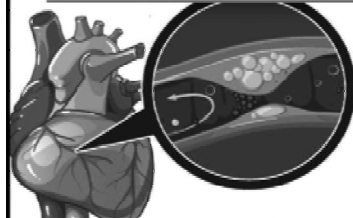

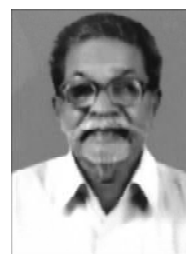
