In Gujarat bridge collapse, HC seeks report from state within a week

The Gujarat High Court has taken a suo motu cognizance of the Morbi bridge collapse incident, issuing a notice to the state government officials including the Home Department, Urban Housing department, the Morbi Municipality, and the State Human Rights

Commission. The high court has sought a report from the state, within a week, on the accident in Morbi that claimed more than 130 lives. Among those who had died were more than 40 children.

The disaster was one of the worst in the recent past

that the country has seen. Prime Minister Narendra Modi was in his home state when the accident took place. He visited the site of the incident two days later and met all those who were injured. The court observed

North Korea vows 'overwhelming' response to US-South Korea war games



The North Korean military said its response to US-South Korean war drills would be "resolute and overwhelming", state media reported Monday. The warning came after a spate of North Korean

weapons tests last week -- including an intercontinental ballistic missile -- as the United States and South Korea conducted their biggest-ever air force exercise. The United States and South Korea have

warned that such missile launches could culminate in a nuclear test by North Korea.

The North Korean military, formally known as the Korean People's Army (KPA), said it was responding to Vigilant Storm -- the US-South Korean exercise -- describing it as "an open provocation", according to the official Korean Central News Agency (KCNA). Vigilant Storm was "aimed at intentionally escalating the tension in the region and a dangerous war drill of very high aggressive nature directly targeting" North Korea, the KPA

said. North Korea will respond to all "anti-DPRK war drills" with "sustained, resolute and overwhelming" measures, it said. The United States has dismissed criticism of the exercise as North Korean propaganda, saying it posed no threat to other nations.

The KPA said it conducted operations, including the launch of tactical ballistic missiles that simulated attacks on air force bases, and practised shooting down enemy aircraft. One ballistic missile was launched to test "a special functional war-

head paralyzing the operation command system of the enemy", the KPA said, without providing any further details about that weapon. The North Korean air force also conducted a "large-scale all-out combat sortie operation", involving 500 planes, according to KCNA. That mobilisation prompted South Korea to scramble fighter jets on Friday. Images of North Korean military operations released on Monday by KCNA showed missiles being fired from various undisclosed locations, including some from mobile launchers.

two minutes' silence on Monday as a mark of respect to the departed souls who lost their lives in the October 30 tragedy. A division bench of Chief Justice Aravind Kumar and Justice Ashutosh Shastri said the report should be submitted to the court by November 14 when the next date of hearing has been fixed. Chief Justice Kumar said that the court has taken the suo motu (on its own) cognisance of the incident on the basis of a news-

paper report published on October 31. The bridge had reopened on May 26 after repaired. On the day of the tragedy, it came crashing down within moments when weekenders had gathered to soak in the festive vibes. Several people, including those from the firm responsible for maintenance - Oreva Group - have been arrested. The manufacturing group is rather known for clocks it manufactures.

Meanwhile, the Su-

preme Court has also agreed to hear a public interest litigation (PIL), demanding a court-monitored judicial inquiry. The top court would hear the plea on November 14. The incident and the loss of lives has triggered huge outrage ahead of the Gujarat polls with the opposition blaming the BJP, which has been ruling the state for nearly 27 years. Gujarat is set to vote in two phases on December 1 and December 5; results would be announced on December 8.

the remote pockets in the area are facing nightmarish experiences due to the poor road conditions for a 07-kilometre stretch, they lamented. Talking to Andaman Sheekha Mrs. Rita Dhali, Pradhan, Gram Panchayat Kishorinagar as well as Mrs. Aparna Roy, Zilla Parishad Member of Paschimsagar constituency said that they

have requested the concerned officials of the APWD and the Administration several times, but her pleas fell into deaf years so far.

Urging the Administration they both again implored the concerned authorities to take initiatives for the improvement of the existing roads in rundown condition and also to construct new roads on priority for the larger interests of the residents especially the school-going children in the area.
