e-KYC mandatory for smooth transfer of benefits to beneficiaries of PM-KISAN

Eligible registered farmers asked to update their KYC by July 31

Port Blair, June 12

The Government with a view to augment the income of the farmers, launched the Central Sector Scheme-'Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN)' during the financial year of 2018-19 which is 100% funded by Govt. of India. Under the Scheme, eligible farmer families receive financial benefits of Rs. 6000/- per year

payable in 3 equal installments of Rs. 2000/- each on every four months.

The Govt. of India has decided to undertake e-KYC verification of all the eligible registered beneficiaries of PM-KISAN Scheme for smooth transfer of benefits. Accordingly, eKYC is mandatory for PM-KISAN registered farmers. It is therefore informed to all eligible

registered farmers of PM-KISAN scheme to update their KYC. The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries can be done by both e-KYC OTP mode as well as e-KYC biometric mode. The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries through OTP mode can be done on PM-KISAN portal free of cost by the beneficiaries or State

DHS issues advisory on Dengue & its prevention

Port Blair, June 12

Dengue fever is a disease caused by the bite of mosquitoes. It can be identified as high grade fever, headache, vomiting, muscle and joint pains, and a characteristic skin itching and skin rash in few cases. It is caused by the bite of Aedes Aegypti mosquito which grows in peri domestic area. The mosquitoes grow mostly in shady places where there is collection of water for more than 7 days. Dengue is spread by several species of female mosquitoes of the Aedes genus, principally Aedes Aegypti. Aedes mosquitoes are visually distinctive because they have noticeable black and white markings on their bodies and legs, characteristically called as Tiger

Moquito. Unlike most other mosquitoes, they are active and bite only during the daytime. The peak biting periods are early in the morning and in the evening before dusk.

Recovery of dengue generally takes two to seven days, however few may land into complications such as seizures, blood clots, damage to liver and kidney, damage to heart muscles even death in 2-5% of person suffering from dengue. A small proportion of cases develops into a more severe dengue hemorrhagic fever, resulting in bleeding, low levels of blood platelets and blood plasma leakage, or into dengue shock syndrome, where dangerously low blood pressure occurs. The general public

have been advised to ensure the following measures:

- **Detection & elimination of mosquito breeding sources.**
- **Maintain fly screens on windows, doors, vents and chimneys.**
- **Remove stagnant water around the house so that mosquitoes cannot breed.**
- **Change pet drinking bowls, bird baths and vase waters at least once a week.**
- **Check and maintain rainwater tanks and water storage vessels.**
- **Use mosquito repellent creams, liquids, coils, mats etc.**
- **Wear full sleeve shirts and full pants with socks.**
- **Use bednets for sleeping infants and young children during day time to prevent mosquito bite.**
- **Ensure proper management of rooftops, porticos and sunshades.**
- **Proper covering of stored water.**
- **Reliable water supply.**
- **Observation of weekly dry day is suggested during which, all the water sources around 100 meters of the house must be emptied.**
- **Many people think, presence of worm in water is normal, but, it is the larva of mosquito. Therefore, take necessary action to remove water containing any worms at the earliest to prevent mosquito growth.**
- **If you have symptoms of Dengue, visit your nearest Health Institution and avoid self-medication, especially pain killer should not be taken by the patients. Keep yourself and your family safe by following appropriate measures. (Source: DHS)**

asked to furnish their Life Certificates in the format which is available with all Anganwadi Workers, Office of the Child Development Project Officers of Urban (Dollygunj), Ferrargunj, Rangat, Diglipur and Car Nicobar. The beneficiaries are further informed to submit Life Certificate duly signed in presence of the nearby Anganwadi Worker and handover to the Anganwadi Worker for onward submission to CDPO Office through Mukhya Sevika of concerned area. Hence, the beneficiaries are not required to visit any of the offices other than the nearby Anganwadi Centre for submission of self signed Life Certificate along with the format.

The Caregivers / Guardians of those who are bed-ridden or unable to visit the Anganwadi Centre due to locomotor disabilities may inform the same to Anganwadi Worker so that the representative of Department can visit the home of such persons to collect Life Certificate.

The last date for submission of Life Certificate to Anganwadi Worker by the beneficiary is June 15, 2022. Thereafter, the pension benefit will be kept on hold those beneficiaries failed to submit Life Certificate, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.
