4,01,429 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far

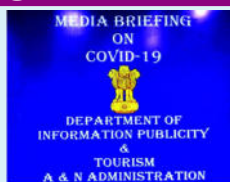
Port Blair, Sept. 16

As per data available, a total of 4,01,429 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603 (approx.). Media briefed on COVID-19 Two positive cases detected during RT-PCR test conducted on incoming flight passengers: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Sept. 16

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening disclosed that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 1070 passengers who arrived here yesterday, two positive cases have been detected. He further disclosed that RAT was conducted on 179 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all were found negative. Today, seven flights with 1059 passengers arrived at Port Blair and were retested by RT-PCR and the reports are awaited. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, 207



passengers were tested and no positive case has been detected. Apart from this, 229 passengers travelling to different

destinations were tested at Phoenix Bay Jetty and all were found negative. In addition to this, RT-PCR test was conducted on 14 crew members of MV Rangat and the reports are awaited. At helipad, 8 passengers were tested and all were found negative. (Contd. on last page)

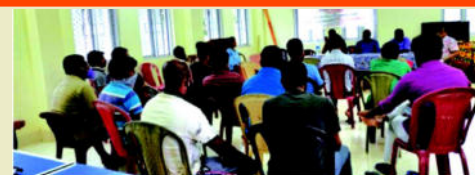

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

CARI Omkar- A promising coconut Variety

The variety was developed through selection from exotic accession IND 102 introduced by ICAR-CPCRI from American Samoa as NiuOma Yellow Dwarf and conserved at World Coconut Germplasm Centre at Sipighat farm, ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair. The palms of this variety take about 3-4 years for first flowering. It is recommended by Group Meeting of All India Coordinated Research Projects on Palms during 2013 for cultivation in coconut growing tracts of Andaman and Nicobar Islands ecosystems. The palms are Dwarf with slender stem, shorterdrooping leaves, stem without boleat the base. The fruits are yellow, smallsize, pear shape, average fruit weight of over 432g with copra content of over 74 g having oil content of about 64.5%. The palms take about 44 months for first flowering after planting. The tender nut water content is 117ml. Unlike, most other dwarf varieties, this variety performs well under rainfed conditions also. It recorded an average of 113 nuts per palm per year under rainfed conditions with copra yield of about 8.31kg per palm per year. The potential yield was estimated to be over 170 nuts per palm per year with copra yield of over 12.50kg per palm per year. Owing to the compact canopy it could be planted at closer spacing of 6 x 6 m also. The variety has not recorded any major pests under field conditions but moderately susceptible to scales and inflorescence moth.

Benefit: The variety has attractive cluster bearing bunches and hence preferred for planting in house compounds and for ornamental painting also.

South Andaman Police traces missing minor boy within 36 hours

Port Blair, Sept. 16 A case was registered at PS Aberdeen on Sept. 14 under relevant section of kidnapping and due to the extensive efforts of the Investigating Officer, SI Regan Isaac under the direction of Insp. K. Joju, SHO PS Aberdeen, the minor boy has been recovered within 36 hours of time after registration of FIR, from a closed lodge at Aberdeen Bazaar. On Sept.13 the minor boy went to Aberdeen Bazaar but he did not return home till late night. Accordingly, as per the statement of the local guardian of the missing minor boy, a case vide FIR No. 120/21 dated 14/09/2021, U/s 363 IPC was registered at PS Aberdeen and the investigation was entrusted to SI Regan. Acting swiftly, the Investigating Officer made extensive efforts to recover the minor boy by analyzing various CCTV footages and examining the witnesses. Due to timely and prompt action, the minor boy was recovered on 15/09/2021 from a lodge at Aberdeen Bazaar, which was closed since the lockdown. The minor boy had isolated himself in the said lodge due to personal issues. Further investigation is going on. 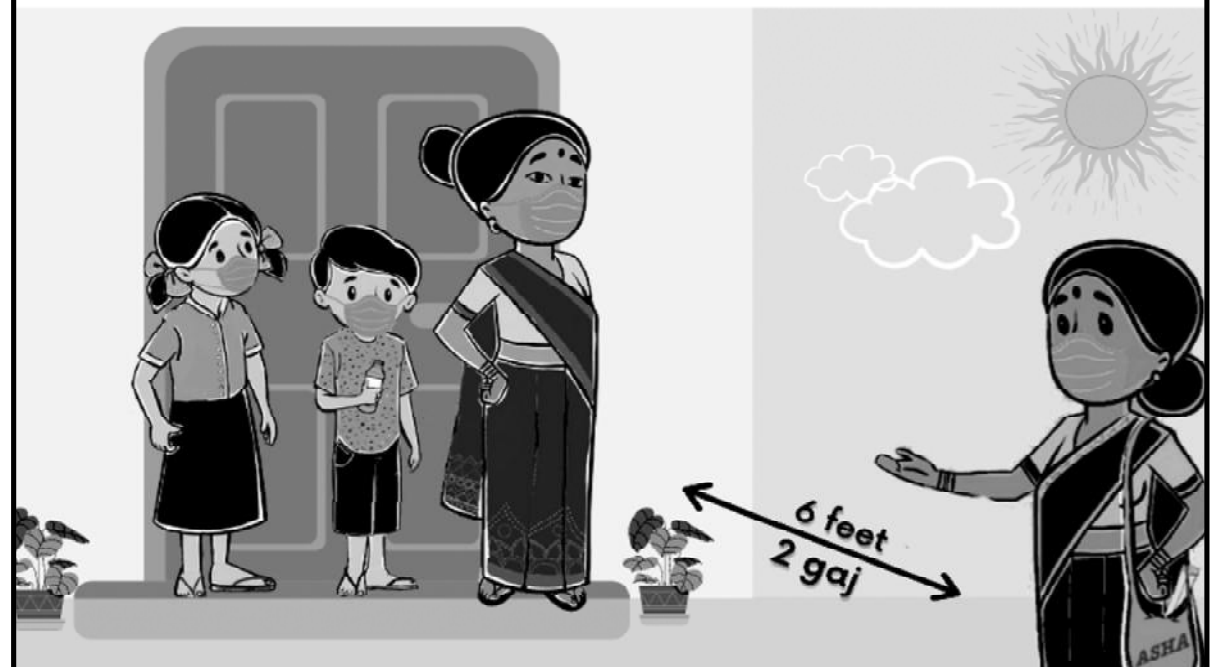

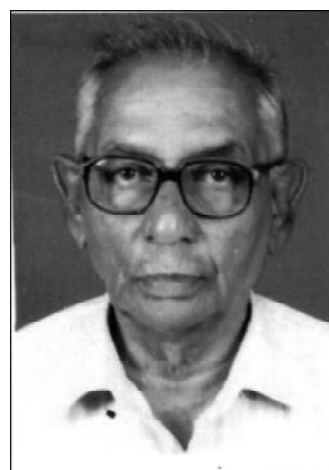
