

PWM Rules 2016 (as amended) prohibits production, stocking, distribution, sale & use of single use plastic items; to come into effect from July 1

- ❖ Plastic flags, ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, candy sticks, ice cream sticks, polystyrene (Thermocol) for decoration, plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers will be prohibited from July 1.
- ❖ Selling as well as display/advertisement of Single Use Plastic (SUP) items on all E-Commerce website will also be prohibited with effect from June 30, 2022

Port Blair, April 3

The Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change has issued notification G. S. R No.571 (E) dated 12th August, 2021 as Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rules-2021. As per Rule 4(2) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended), the manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of following single use plastic (SUP), including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities shall be prohibited with effect from 1st July, 2022. The items prohibited include ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice cream



sticks, polystyrene [Thermocol] for decoration. Plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC

banners less than 100 micron, stirrers will also be prohibited.

As per Rule 4(1) of PWM rules, 2016 (as amended), carry bag made of virgin or recycled plastic shall not be less than seventy-five (75) microns in thickness with

effect from 30th September, 2021 and one hundred twenty (120) microns in thickness with effect from 31st December, 2022.

Further, as per the A&N Administration vide Notification No.186 dated 05.09.2019, the manufacture, storage, use, import, transportation, distribution and sale of single use plastic items has been banned in A&N Islands viz. PET Bottles-Water & Beverages, including alcohol, <2L (Less than 2 litres), plastic bodied cigarette lighters, sachets (shampoo, conditioners

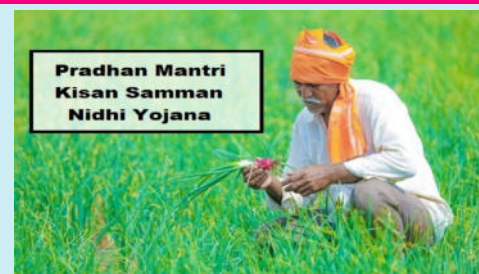

Today, 17 flights with 2517 passengers arrived, out of which, 2204 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 229 passengers and the reports are awaited.

Around 96 percent of Post Offices brought under CBS to implement 'Anytime-Anywhere Post Office Savings' Service

New Delhi, April 3

The Government has said that it is in the process of setting up Anytime-Anywhere Post Office Savings scheme, which will allow online transfer of funds between postal and bank accounts. Around 96 percent of Post Offices across the country have been brought under the Core Banking System (CBS), in order to implement the "Anytime-Anywhere Post Office Savings"

service. There are a total of 1,58,526 Post Offices in India, out of which 1,52,514 Post Offices, or 96 percent of them have already been brought under the CBS. This will not only help the existing Post Office savings account holders but also encourage new individuals to open up a savings account with ease.

The Government is also working towards providing national electronic funds transfer (NEFT) and

real-time gross settlement (RTGS) facilities for online transfer of funds from Post Office accounts to bank accounts and vice versa.

In addition to this, the Government is also taking steps to provide connectivity via intermediate data rate (IDR) connectivity, virtual private network (VPN) connection, and very small aperture terminal (VSAT) connectivity. (Source: india.gov.in)

10th instalment of the scheme on 1st January, 2022 directly to the bank accounts of the PM KISAN beneficiaries. The 11th instalment is expected to be released soon for the period April 2022 to July 2022.

In this regard, the Govt. of India has decided to undertake e-KYC verification of all the eligible registered farmer-beneficiaries of PM-KISAN Scheme for smooth transfer of benefits. The verification is to be completed by 31st May, 2022.

It is therefore informed to all eligible registered farmers of PM-KISAN scheme to update their KYC before the schedule date. The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries can be done by both e-KYC OTP mode as well as e-KYC biometric mode. The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries through OTP mode can be done on PM-KISAN portal free of cost by the beneficiaries or State functionaries and for e-KYC biometric authentication facility, the beneficiary may visit the nearest CSC center. The CSC will charge for bio-metric authentication from each beneficiary. For any query/doubt related to e-KYC, the beneficiaries can also contact the concerned Zonal Agriculture Office/ Field Extension functionaries of Agriculture Department.

The farmers have been advised to use only the official website of PM-KISAN portal and not to download any other App for e-KYC authentication, a press release from Agriculture Department said.

and similar personal care items, mouth-fresheners, pickle/jam/sauces, spices, condiments, etc.), <15 mL (or equivalent in weight) and single-use, plastic bodied use & throw pens.

Similarly, as per the A&N Administration vide Notification No.225 dated 24.09.2019, the use, manufacture and sale of plastic carry bags irrespective of its thickness, size, color and nature is banned in A&N Islands.

All Producers, Stockiest, Retailers, Shopkeepers, E-commerce Companies, Street Vendors, Commercial Establishments (Malls/ Marketplace/ Shopping Centers/ Cinema Houses/ Tourist Locations/ Schools/ Colleges/ Office Complexes/ Hospitals & other Institutions) and general public have been informed to stop production, stocking, distribution, sale and usage of identified SUP items as per the timelines specified in the said MoEF&CC Notification. Further, necessary action is to be taken by the concerned entities to ensure zero inventories of the aforementioned SUP items by June 30, 2022.

Selling as well as display/advertisement of Single Use Plastic (SUP) items on all E-Commerce website will also be prohibited with effect from June 30, 2022.

Action, as deemed fit under Environment Protection Act, 1986 including seizure of goods, closure of operations of Industries/Commercial Establishments and in case of non-compliance of above Environmental Compensation as per the Guidelines issued by Central Pollution Control Board of Rs.5,000/- per ton shall be levied against the violators of the said Notification, a press release from Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee said.
