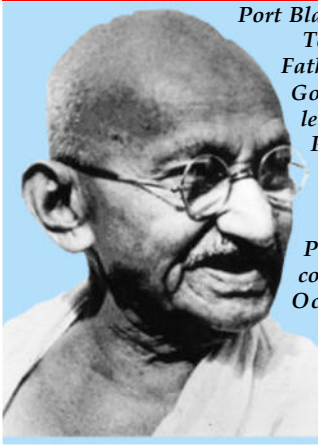


152nd birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi to be celebrated today

Together with the rest of the country, the 152nd birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, the Father of the Nation will also be celebrated in A&N Islands tomorrow (October 2). The Lt Governor, A&N Islands, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) will lead the Islanders by offering floral tributes at the statue of Mahatma Gandhi at Gandhi Park at 8.20 am. It will be followed by presentation of 'Vaishnav Jan to tene kahiye je' Ramdhuns by teachers of Education Department. A two minutes' silence will be observed on the occasion.

Departments, Institutions, Autonomous bodies, Corporation, Panchayat Pradhans, Voluntary Organizations and villagers have been requested to create community assets by Shramdaan and conduct special drive for cleanliness in the month of October under the 'Swacchta Hi Seva' Campaign by following COVID appropriate behaviours.

Further, the general public have been requested to refrain from slaughtering of animals, killing of birds, fish catching and consuming liquor on this auspicious day.

Chief Secretary issues order to ensure compliance to Prompt & Effective Containment Measures for COVID-19 as per MoHFW advisory in the whole of A&N Islands

Port Blair, Oct. 1

Considering the need to prevent any potential rise in number of cases in view of the upcoming festive season in the country, MoHFW has issued an advisory to all States and Union Territories (UTs), for a continued focus on 'Prompt & Effective Containment Measures' as well as 'Acceleration in the Pace and Coverage of COVID Vaccination'. In exercise of

the powers conferred under section 10 (2) (1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Union Home Secretary and Chairman, National Executive Committee (NEC) directs vide order of Ministry of Home Affairs, dated 28th Sept, 2021 to consider implementation of Prompt & Effective Containment Measures, as conveyed vide MoHFW advisory dated 21st September, 2021 and the

National Directives for COVID-19 Management shall continue to be strictly followed and will remain in force up to 31st October, 2021.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 24 (1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain in the

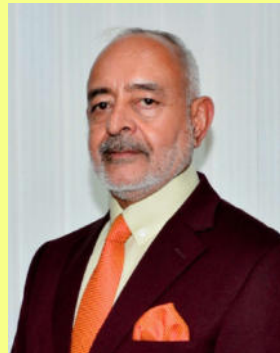
Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav MESSAGE

Jal Jeevan Mission scheme is being implemented in the country to extend 100% FHTC coverage to rural households. At present, the country as a whole has achieved coverage to 5 Cr. rural families. 5 States/UTs have already achieved 100% FHTC coverage in the country including A&N Islands. A&N

Media briefed on COVID-19

No positive cases detected during test conducted on incoming flight & inter-island bound passengers : Secretary (IP&T)

Port Blair, Oct. 1

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 499 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 1208 passengers arrived, out of which 574 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on remaining

passengers and the reports are awaited.

The Secretary further mentioned that RAT was conducted on 206 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all were found negative. Apart from this, RAT was conducted on 77 passengers travelling to & fro to Shaheed/Swaraj Dweep were tested at Phoenix Bay Jetty and all were found negative. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was

Jayanthi in different places in the country.

Special Gram Sabhas are also being organised in all Panchayats in A&N Islands. Further, Gram Sabha shall also discuss Village Action Plan (VAP) to ensure long term sustainability of village water supply and formation of Village Water and Sanitation Committee in each of 266 'Har Ghar Jal' village.

In addition to this, to encourage testing of water sample among public, a month long programme for testing of water samples from different sources and public places have been planned. Under this programme, public specially women from each village shall be trained in testing of water sample from Functional Household Tap Connection (FHTC), Anganwadi, Schools and uploading test report on WQIMIS web portal through mobile application.

The programme will also be launched in all the three districts simultaneously. Training will be imparted to schools children and youth during month long programme. Further, to ensure conservation, preservation of water sources, Sanitary Survey of the sources shall be carried out and reported in IMIS of MoJS. During sanitary survey, all sources shall be inspected for any source of pollution and contamination by representatives from villages, water supply agency/NGO. They shall also suggest remedial measures to be taken up to ensure prevention of pollution.

It is expected that this shall improve Water Quality in the villages as well as act as a catalyst in encouraging public in testing of water sample. It shall improve water quality in different places in the villages besides sanitation and hygiene, so that villages can achieve the status of 'WASH Prabudh Gaon', a press release from ANSWSM said.

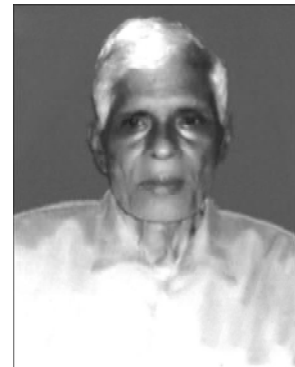
