

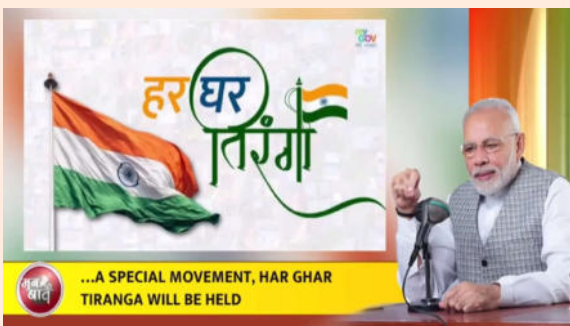
Mann Ki Baat: PM calls upon people to take part in 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign from 13th to 15th August

New Delhi, July 31

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today expressed happiness that 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' has taken the form of a mass movement. Addressing the nation in his 'Mann Ki Baat' programme on All India Radio, Shri Modi highlighted that people from all walks of life and every section of the society are participating in different programs connected with it. He said this 91st episode of 'Mann Ki Baat' is very special as India will soon complete 75 years of her independence.

The Prime Minister called the listeners lucky as they were born in a free India. He added that this present day would have been unimaginable had people been born in the era of slavery. He said, people who had lived through those times must have yearned for freedom from slavery and subjugation. He said, millions of countrymen fought against it and made sacrifices for the sake of freedom.

The Prime Minister spoke about the 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign which is being held under the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'. He asked listeners to become a part of this movement, and

hoist the Tricolour or adorn their homes with it from 13th to 15th August. He said the Tricolour connects and inspires people to do something for the country. He also suggested that people can use the Tricolour as social media profile picture from the 2nd of August to the 15th of August. He said the 2nd of August has a special connection with the Indian Flag. This day is the birth anniversary of Pingali Venkaiah who designed the National Flag.

He also remembered the great revolutionary Bhikaji Cama whose role in shaping the Tricolour has been very important.

The Prime Minister stated that the biggest message of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav is that everyone should follow their duty with full devotion. He said, Amrit Kaal of the next 25 years is also Kartavyakaal, a period of duty for every countryman.

Jeremy clinches India's second Gold medal for weightlifting at CWG 2022 after India's first Gold won by weightlifter Mirabai Chanu



New Delhi, July 31 (PIB)

Jeremy Lalrinnunga, the 19-year-old from Mizoram, bagged India's second gold in the 67 kg category of weightlifting at the Commonwealth Games on Sunday. Jeremy lifted a total of 300kg (140kg in Snatch + 160kg in C&J) at the Games, which is a CWG record. It is the fifth medal for India in the competition and the second Gold. President Smt. Droupadi Murmu, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, Union Sports Minister Shri Anurag Thakur and Indians from all corner of the country have congratulated Jeremy for his achievement.

Earlier, Mirabai Chanu won India's first Gold medal at Commonwealth Games 2022 by lifting a total of 201 KG in women's 49

KG weightlifting event. Sanket Sargar bagged silver in the men's 55kg weightlifting event. Bindyarani Devi won a Silver Medal in Women's 55 kg Weightlifting and Gururaja Poojary secured Bronze in Men's 61kg weightlifting category.

Earlier, the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi congratulated weightlifter Mirabai Chanu on winning Gold Medal at Commonwealth Games 2022 in Birmingham. In a tweet, the Prime Minister said; "The exceptional Mirabai Chanu makes India proud once again! Subsidy for acquisition of 'Deep Sea fishing vessels for traditional fishermen' under PMMSY

Applications invited from fishermen, Societies, Associations, SHGs & FFPOs of N&M Andaman

Port Blair, July 31

Applications have been invited from traditional/artisanal fishermen and their Societies/Associations/SHGs/FFPOs of North and Middle Andaman towards the activity 'Support for acquisition of Deep Sea Fishing Vessels for traditional Fishermen' under PMMSY. The pattern of assistance of subsidy

under the scheme is 40% for general and 60 % for SC/ST/Women beneficiary with a maximum ceiling of Rs. 48 Lakhs and Rs. 72 Lakhs respectively.

The eligibility criteria and terms and condition as per the PMMSY Guidelines are:

➤ Beneficiary should possess valid ownership certificate,

Registration certificate under the ReAL Craft, fishing license and Biometric ID cards of fishers/QR coded Aadhar card.

➤ The governmental assistance is restricted to (a) 1 unit per individual beneficiary, (b) 2 units per group/society (of at least 10 members) in case of Groups of traditional/artisanal

The sale of flags has commenced through the active participation & involvement of concerned Ward Councillors of PBMC.

The general public have been appealed once again to purchase the Indian Flags and hoist the same in their homes/premises and submit a photograph on PBMC's social media accounts, a press release from PBMC said.

fishermen i.e. traditional/artisanal fishermen SHGs/Joint Liability Groups (JLGs)/traditional/artisanal Fisher Cooperatives etc. or those undertaken in a cluster/area approach. However, a cluster/area may have multiple groups/societies. As far as FFPOs/Cs are concerned, the modalities of implementation and upper ceiling on the total units eligible for support would be decided by the CAC.

> The vessel should have onboard machineries/fishing equipment including refrigerated storage facilities for undertaking deep sea tuna long lining and gill netting.

> Appropriate communication systems, AIS/transponders and other navigational equipment for safe navigation etc., as per the relevant regulations/guidelines are mandatory onboard the vessels.

> Deep sea fishing vessel should be considered as an alternative for replacement of the existing bottom trawler and the State/UT shall ensure suitable disposal of old fishing boat (against which new one is replaced).

> Beneficiaries will submit Self Contained Proposal (SCP) with relevant techno-financial details of the vessel.

> Installation of Bio-toilet shall be mandatory within the project cost.

> The Beneficiaries will submit the detailed voyage report including voyage period from-to-time, species-wise catch details, the price realized (if exported) as per the prescribed proforma.

The application form for the scheme can be collected from the Zonal Fisheries Office, Mayabunder and Fisheries Sub -Stations at Diglipur/ Billiground/ Rangat/ Kadamtala, a press release from Fisheries Zonal Office, N&M Andaman said.
