Northeast hustle

The Election Commission yesterday officially kicked off the election schedule for the year. While Tripura will vote on February 16, Nagaland and Meghalaya will go to polls on February 27. Counting for all will be held on March 2. With BJP president JP Nadda recently declaring the party's intention to go all out in each of the nine assembly polls this year, keen contests await the Northeast.

Of the poll-bound states, BJP is leading the state government in Tripura and is part of governing alliances in Meghalaya and Nagaland. BJP's success lies in the combination of promoting a development narrative for the region coupled with clever coalition building. But two challenges also confront the party. First, it finds itself increasingly tangled in Northeast's inter-state border disputes. For a region that still relies heavily on natural resources and continues to harbour strong ethnic identities, this is a sensitive issue pitting one BJP government against another, which rival parties are likely to exploit for political gains.

Second, there is also a growing sense among BJP's regional partners that the party is trying to expand at their own expense. For example, there are signs of strain in NPP's relations with BJP since the two parties fought the Manipur polls separately last year. With NPP now declaring candidates for 58 out of 60 seats in Meghalaya, it could open up space for a party like TMC at the expense of BJP. True, BJP deserves credit for revoking the draconian AFSPA in significant parts of the Northeast last year. But full normalcy and end to regional insurgency that are crucial for economic growth hinge on concluding grand deals like the Naga Peace Accord. Meanwhile, BJP's Hindi-heartland nationalist sentiments often elicit countervailing political mobilisation in the Northeast. In short, BJP's aim of sweeping the poll-bound Northeast states to build political momentum for the rest of 2023 won't be easy.

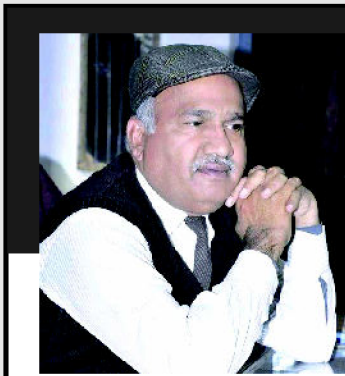

tehsil of North & Middle Andaman district in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. It is situated 18km away from Rangat. For reaching Bongaon one has to depend on the Dingi provided by the Gram Panchayat Bakultala which regularly conduct ferry service from Shyamkund Jetty to Bongaon Jetty to cover a distance of about 1.5 Km and about 2 Km walk through the jungle. Ferry is provided in the morning and evening for the villagers, students and patients. Bakultala is the gram panchayat of Bongaon village. The total geographical area of village is 81.83 hectares. Bongaon has a total population of 67 peoples, out of which male population is 37 while the female population is 30. The literacy rate of bongaon village is 59.70% out of which 62.16% males and 56.67% females are literate, as per 1981

census. There are about 15 houses in bangaon village and presently only about 25 people live there and they earn their livelihood by farming, fishing and crab hunting at the mangrove back waters and marshy land. There is no mobile tower and internet facility, electricity is provided from 5 Pm to 11 pm by a genset provided by electricity Dept. The medical team conducted the general health screening and recorded Blood pressure, Random Blood Glucose, Dental examination and vision checkup. The team gave appropriate Homoeo and Modern Medicines. Yoga demonstrated to the villagers. About 11 patients were screened and few patients who needed further detailed investigation have been asked to visit CHC Rangat. One of the demands placed before the team by

villagers is they need a priority whenever they visit CHC Rangat for treatment due to ferry timing, so that they can return home in time. The camp was organised on the request of Shri. Tapas Mondal a social worker a resident of the village, who made all arrangements, Shri. R. Kannan Up Pradhan Gram Panchayat Bakultala also accompanied the team. The 7 member medical Team from CHC Rangat was led by Dr. B. Bindu Kumar, Medical Officer (Homoeo) and the other members of the team are Shri. Robert Banarjee, Pharmacist, Shri. Ajit Kumar Das, Yoga Instructor, Shri. KV Nareesh Nair, Ophthalmist, Shri. Sameer Mohammed Dental Technician, Shri. Dhiman Ch Roy, MHW, and Smt. Sagorika Howlader, ASHA. The Up Pradhan, Shri. R. Motorists, residents bewail..

NHIDCL has fixed December as the target date for completion of the two bridges. The reason behind the delay is said to be delay in grant of permission and support from several government departments of the administration. While the NHIDCL has allegedly blamed the contractor VIJ Engineering & Consultant Pvt Ltd for the delay in completion of the bridge work, the contractor on his part allegedly blames the unpredictable weather condition and government departments for delay in granting various permissions. Motorists are facing great difficulties in crossing to the other side in the old narrow road bridge. The under-construction bridges have not only been bothering the commuters but the shopkeepers in the surrounding area have also been complaining about dust-related health

problems leading to breathing ailments. The bridge project was started around two years ago as part of NH-4 road construction. It was supposed to be finished by December this year to be opened to the public. However, like the NH-4 road work, the bridge construction has also been marked by delayed construction. Residents have been complaining that the construction of the bridges has been going on at a snail's pace. A shopkeeper at Jodakalan said that motorists take a lot of time to pass through this stretch. Work at the site has been going on very slowly. "The shopkeepers like us have been getting health problems as dust is present in the area round the clock. Traffic jams in these areas have become a daily affair," he added. As per sources, the private construction firm tasked to complete these bridges by

NHIDCL has been given a deadline to complete the bridge work by December 2022. However, they have to face a slew of problems from various fronts. The two main factors are incessant rain and uncooperative attitude of various departments like APWD, District Administration and Electricity Department. These departments are not coming forward to give timely approval. Delay by 4-5 months for every task is common. Be it seeking permission to earth filling, electricity connection on the spot the permissions are not forthcoming. Besides, unpredictable weather conditions have added to the problems. The said delay is attributed to various reasons the most important being that the approval of the administration is always delayed. It is expected that the two bridges are likely to be completed.

03 local residents of N&M Andaman arrested for providing logistical support, obtaining return gratifications from Myanmarese poachers

Port Blair, Jan 22: On 24th December 2022, Indian Coast Guard apprehended 46 Myanmarese Poachers along with 04 Engine Dinghies near East Island and a case under Maritime Zone of India Act, 1981 and Foreigners Act 1946 was registered against them at PS Central Crime Station and is being investigated by Dy.SP (CID) Kumar Abhishek. During sustained interrogation, the Myanmarese Poachers revealed that some local residents of Hara Tikrey Village under PS Kalighat Jurisdiction met them several times last year at Hiran Tikrey, Kishori Nagar and provided the poachers various logistical

support. In return the poachers had provided these local residents Mobile phones, Solar Panel, Batteries, underwater Torches, watch etc. for providing them logistical support. From the investigations carried out till now, various articles provided by Myanmarese poachers have been recovered from local residents namely Sanju Toppo, Paulus Gari & Rajender Singh from the jungles of Hara Tikrey by a team comprising of SI Parvash, HC S. Baroi, PC Amos George, PC Bijoy Das and these local residents have been arrested in the case. Investigation of the case is under progress and a few other local residents of North &

Middle Andaman are also suspected to be involved in the nexus with foreign poachers. General Public of Andaman & Nicobar Islands are requested not to interact or aid the Foreign Poachers in the Indian Territorial Waters. Foreign Poachers not only plunder our precious marine wealth but also pose serious national security threats. Hence, General public is hereby informed that whenever any foreign intruder/poachers is seen either at sea or in land, immediately information may be passed on to the nearest police station or to Police Control Room (03192- 232100) or the Coast Guard authorities.



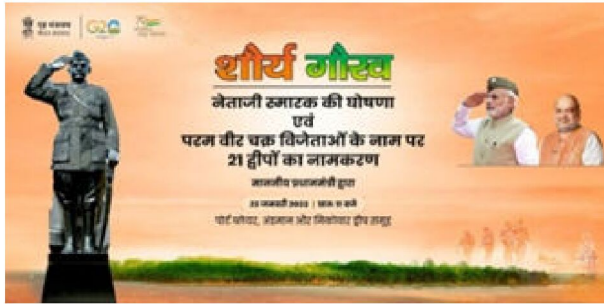
