

Civil Aviation Minister lauds Andaman & Nicobar Islands & Uttarakhand for lowering VAT on ATF

It helps to increase volume of connectivity, says Minister

New Delhi, Sept. 30

Minister for Civil Aviation, Shri Jyotiraditya Scindia on Thursday thanked the Governments of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Uttarakhand for lowering VAT (Value-Added Tax) on aviation turbine fuel. Uttarakhand has brought down the VAT to 2%, while Andaman and Nicobar Islands have brought it down to 1%, Shri Scindia said.

"My heartfelt thanks to both these Governments because it is only by decreasing the volume of taxes that you are going to increase the volume of



connectivity going into those States. Considering that fuel is 37.5% of operational costs of an airline, it is very important that we put an impetus on greater

connectivity by bringing down the cost structure [of fuel]," said the Minister at an event organized by the PHD Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

Last month, Shri Scindia had written to 22 States and Union Territories appealing to them to reduce VAT to 1% to 4%. Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Sikkim and Telangana are some of the States that have already lowered it.

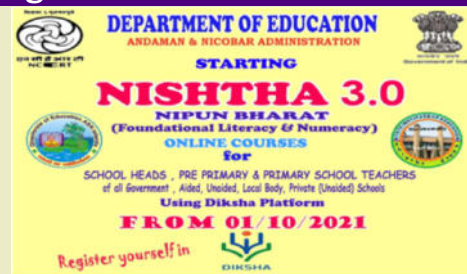

Shri Subhash Kumar Kar, Hon'ble Sessions Judge, Andaman & Nicobar Islands convicted one accused named Peter for the offence punishable under section 302 of IPC in Sessions Case No. 27 of 2015. The brief fact of the prosecution case was that on 01.03.2015 at about 6 am, one Phaneel, S/o Shri Herold, R/o Perka village while sleeping in Tsunami Shelter No. 26 of Perka village alongwith his father heard the

screaming of his relative Annie who was shouting 'Bachao Bachao Jaan Se Marta Hai'. Upon hearing such screaming they rushed to the bedroom and found their relative Peter sitting over Annie and cutting her throat with a dao. A complaint was made before P.S Car Nicobar and upon recording farbayon of Shri Phaneel an FIR bearing No. 05/2015 dated 01.03.2015 was registered at P.S. Car Nicobar U/s 302 IPC. The investigation was taken up and upon

conclusion charge sheet was submitted against the accused Peter for the offence punishable U/s 302 of IPC.

The prosecution had examined as many as 12 witnesses who were examined, cross-examined and discharged. The accused was examined under section 313 of Cr. P.C which is denial of prosecution allegations simplicitor and plea of innocence. Upon considering the

Court of Special Judge POCSO awards punishment for twenty years in POCSO Case

Port Blair, Sept. 30

The Court of Special Judge POCSO at Port Blair, Shri Raja Chatterjee yesterday convicted one person namely Mohd. Javed resident of Bambooflat village and sentenced him to suffer rigorous imprisonment for 20 years and to pay fine of Rs. 5000/- in default to suffer rigorous imprisonment for 5 months for the offence punishable u/s 6 of the

POCSO Act. He also has to suffer rigorous imprisonment for 1 year and to pay Rs. 1000/- only in default to suffer rigorous imprisonment for 1 month for the offence punishable u/s 323 of the IPC and to suffer rigorous imprisonment for 7 years and to pay fine of Rs. 2,000/- only in default, to suffer rigorous imprisonment for 3 months for the offence punishable u/s 506 of the

IPC. If the fine is paid by the convict, the fine amount shall be paid to the victim girl/survivor to meet her medical expenses and rehabilitation of such victim as per provision of section 6(2) of the POCSO Act.

The case originated on the basis of statement dated 08/02/2021 by the aunt of victim (Maasi)

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

The Nicobarese mangosteen (Garcinia celebica) for nutrition and aesthetics

Nicobarese mangosteen is a term used for a group of closely related botanical species, which are locally known as seashore mangosteen, ghatkau, payuh and kalakau in the Andaman and Nicobar islands. As some types are found growing naturally near seashore and hence, the name seashore mangosteen. It bears pitcher shaped fruits, which turn red to dark purple during ripening and hence, the other names. Fruiting season varies from April to July in different islands.



The fruits are generally small and generally contain four to eight segments. Pulp is white and is relished by both settlers and Nicobarese tribals. Pulp is known to have delicate aroma and is known to have higher protein content than commercially cultivated mangosteen. Our surveys have indicated presence of both sweet and sour types in it. The peel is inedible as that in case of mangosteen; however, it is thinner and softer. Being one of the native species, it needs conservation and popularization in the islands. Plant grows faster and starts bearing fruits within 4-6 years of planting as compared to many other related species found in the islands. Being a tree with attractive, dark green, dense canopy, it could be a potential plant for use in landscape gardening and agro-ecotourism sites. A couple of plants could be accommodated in the backyards, which could serve as a source of relishing fruits for family and friends.

Benefit: Incorporation of Nicobarese mangosteen in the gardens would not only provide nutritious fruits but would also improve the aesthetic look of the area.

reporting a weekly positivity between five per cent to 10 per cent.

Director-General of Indian Council of Medical Research, Dr. Balram Bhargava said, it will be prudent to avoid non-essential travel and observe festivity but at low-key at least this year. He also said, dengue vaccine is an important agenda. He added that there are certain dengue strains which have been licensed to some companies in India and many of these companies have done their phase one trials abroad. He said, Government is planning to do more rigorous trials. He also said the call of the hour is to give the full vaccination covering the entire adult population and talk of booster dose is not pertinent at the moment.

In all, 69 per cent of the population over 18 years of age have got their first dose of the COVID vaccine while 25 per cent have got both doses. (Source:india.gov.in)

namely Florida Preeti Toppo who lodged a complaint against the accused Mohd. Javed who caused aggravated sexual assault upon a minor girl who was aged about 9 years repeatedly in his house. The victim used to address her aunt and the accused namely Mohd. Javed as Mummy and Papa. The victim stated that she used to reside at Child Care Institution and during lockdown, her aunt brought the victim girl to reside with her in her house. On one fine day, when her aunt (Maasi) returned from work she noticed that the victim girl was traumatized and her son (Maasi son) informed that the accused Mohd. Javed committed some mischief and assaulted the victim girl. On being asked, the victim girl disclosed to her aunt that since the past few months, the accused was repeatedly committing mischief, as a result she sustained bleeding injury and severe swelling on her private parts. The accused threatened the victim girl not to disclose the incident to anyone. He had also caused physical assault upon her as there was injuries present in various parts of her body which was duly proved by the Doctor who examined her. The investigation was taken up by the Investigating Officer, Smti. Shilpa Dutta. The Prosecution examined all witnesses and was able to successfully prove the case beyond reasonable doubt. It is pertinent to mention that the case was registered on 08/02/2021 and the judgment was delivered within a span of 7 months.

The Hon'ble Special Court observed in the order that since the victim girl resides in child care institution as her biological mother is no more in the world and her biological father is in judicial custody in connection with some other criminal proceedings, the series of incidents involved in the case has caused physical trauma and thus her rehabilitation is of prime importance. So, taking into account all these factors, the victim girl has been awarded compensation amounting to Rs. 4,00,000/- which is to be paid by A&N Administration within a period of 30 days. The case was conducted by Special Public Prosecutor, Miss.A. S. Zinu, a press release received here said.




