It seems like yesterday when, as most working people suffered salary losses and professional precarity, and tried to thread the needle of "work-life balance" while being to thread the needle of "work-life balance" while being trapped at home, tech companies across the world were celebrating "the new normal". Now, the biggest IT giants in the world — who saw their profits soar in the last two years as the demand for digital products and services soared — are facing a bit of an HR problem. It turns out that there is no normal any more when it comes to workfalces. And since Silicon Valley set the template for work-from-home during the early days of the Covid-19 pandemic, how it locals with the time to effice. during the early days of the Covid-19 pandemic, how it deals with return-to-office will be closely watched. #### Vaccination drive continuing smoothly in A & N Islands



# CHANDRAYAAN-2 ORBITER PAYLOADS MADE DISCOVERY-CLASS FINDINGS, SAYS ISRO

Chandravaan-2 orbiter payloads have Chandrayaan-2 crotter payloads rave yielded discovery-class findings, according to the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO). There were eight scientific payloads hosted on theorbite-arcaft. They are: Chandrayaan-Zlarge Area Soft X-ray Spectrometer (71 SSS) Selor Yeau Monitor (SMI)

(CLASS), Solar X-ray Monitor (XSM), CHandra's Atmospheric CHandra's Atmospheric Compositional Explorer 2 (CHACE 2), Dual Frequency Synthetic Aperture Radar (DFSAR), Imaging Infra-Red Spectrometer (IRS), Terrah Mapping Camera (TMC 2), Orbiter High Resolution Camera (DHRC), and Dual Frequency Radio Science (DFRS)

The observations of microflares of the Sun, during the quiet-Sun period, which provide important clues on the coronal heating problem of the Sun, were made by the YSM applied. the XSM payload.

The first-ever unambiguous detection of the hydration features of detection of the hydration features of the Moon was achieved by Chandrayaan-2 with its infra-red spectrometer payload IIRS, which captured clear signatures of Hydroxyl and water-ice on the lunar surface, ISRO said.

The DFSAR instrument could study the subsurface features of the Moon, detected signatures of the subsurface water-ice, and achieved high resolution mapping of the lunar

morphological features in the polar regions, it was stated.

"The observations "The observations (of Chandrayaan-Zorther paybads) have been yielding intriguing scientific results, which are being published in peer-reviewed journals and presented in international meetings." Svan said. Chandrayaan-2, ISRO said, has

The TMC 2 of Chandrayaan-2, which is conducting imaging of the Moon at a global scale, has found interesting geologic signatures of lunar crustal shortening, and identification of volcanic domes, the ISROsaid.

The DFRS experiment onboard The DFRS experiment onboard Chandrayaan-2 has studied the ionosphere of the Moon, which is generated by the sadarphoto-brisation of the neutral species of the lunar tenuous exosphere, It was noted. The science data archived in Indian Seas Science Data Contra

Indian Space Science Data Centre (ISSDC) at Byalalu, near here, are being disseminated to public through its disseminated to public through its 'PRADAN' portal. The questions received from the academia, institutes and students were addressed by the ISRO scientists during the two-day deliberation. A part dispussion deliberations. A panel discussion provided the opportunity to academia. institutes and students to interact with the ISRO scientists on lunar science and Chandrayaan-2, ISRO said. Chandrayaan-2 is the second

exploration satellites. It comprised an orbiter, lander named Vikram and rove orbiter, lander named Vikram and rover named Pragyan to explore the unexplored South Polar region of the Moon. It was launched on July 22, 2019 from the Sriharikota spaceport by GSLV Mk-III. It was inserted into a lunar orbit on August 20, 2019, with firing of thrusters on the orbiter.

The orbiter and lander modules

In e orbiter and lander modules were separated as two independent satelites on September 2, 2019.

Later, Vikram lander's descent was as planned and normal performance was observed up to an altitude of 2.1 km from Lunar surface. on September seven, 2019, Subsequently, communication from Subsequently, communication from the lander (with the six-wheeled Prayyan rover accommodatedinside it) was lost and the lander had a hard landing on the lumar surface. A successful soft-landing would have made India the fourth country after the erstwhile Soviet Union, the Initiad States and China to dis so.

United States, and China to do so, according to ISRO officials.

The orbiter, placed in its intended orbit around the Moon, will enrich our understanding of the Moon's evolution and mapping of minerals and water molecules in polar regions, using its eight advanced scientific instruments, according to ISRO. The precise launch and optimised mission management have ensured a long life of almost seven years for the orbiter instead of the planned one year, it said.

Petronet LNG Ltd, India's largest gas importer, is looking to reclaim the lost opportunities of the past decade as it seeks afrest foray into the petrochemical business and plans to set upan LNG import tacility on the east coast.

Oilsecretary Tarun Kapocr, who is also the chairman of Petronet, in the firm's latest annual report said the company is looking at settingup a 1 bating terminal of Copalur port in Odisha and "is embanking upon a major diversification/dive lobradatese its business activity and is exploring to have an ethane/propare import facility at Dabej terminal".

Petronet had some years back planned to setup a terminal of Cangavaram inAndra Pradesh for import of supercooled gas in ships. The company management stopped pursuing that terminal in 2015-16 on grounds that there isn't enough demand to justify a 5 million tonnes/year import facility.

Gangavaram would have been the first terminal on the east coast as Petronet owns and operates facilities at Dahej in Oujarat and Kochi in Kerai.

Soonafler that, Adari Group began work to set up a 5 million tonnes/year import terminal at Dhamra port in Odsha.

Petronet now sees that there is demand forgas in the eastem region and despite the

Similarly, the company is trying to recapture the lost opportunity in the petrochemical sector.
Petronet's lorg-term contract for import of liquefied natural gas (LNG) from Qatar provided for supply of 5 milliontonnes a year of rich gas or gas containing ethane and propane, compounds used to make

petrochemicals.
That rich gas was supplied to Oil and
Natural Gas Corp (ONGC), which, after

strippingil of elfane and propane, re-supplies to Petronet for onward sale to power plants, fertilizer units and other customers.
The source said ONEC uses the rich gas at its petrochemical plant to make value-added chemicals.
Now, Petronet is looking to use the same model

model.

Petronel "has also planned for setting up of a petrochemical complex based on imported propane at Dahej I.NG Teminial", Kapoor said in the annual report. "The foray into petrochemicals would be a forward integration of our strategy as the same planned to get synchronised with our upcomingthrig letty project and available land bank at Dahej."

He, however, did not give details of the

He, however, dd not give detals of the planned petrochemical complex including investment and size of the plant.

Petrochemicals—made using cruck and natural gas as feedstock—form raw material for pikstics, packaging material and personal care products. In terms of volume, the petrochemical market in India stood at 42.50 million tonnes and sestimated reach 49.62 million tonnes by 2025, expanding at a compound annual growth net (CAGR) of 6.14 per cent between FY 2021 and FY 2025.

Petronet, he said, Thas signed MoU memorandum of understanding) with Gopplau Ports Litand is in discussion with them to finalise the key technical and commercial terms of the agreements."

Without giving investment details or timelines for the project implementation, he said the lim is in process of obtaining the final investment decisind for the project.
