Dr. ASOKE KUMAR DAS

First Officer-in-Charge
Zoological Survey of India, Port Blair

We are saddened by the sudden demise of our beloved Dr. Asoke Kumar Das in the evening 3.00 pm on 25.12.21, at the age of 80. Dr. Asoke Kumar Das, Scientist-E, was educated at the University of Calcutta and awarded Ph.D. Degree for his outstanding contribution in the field of Taxonomy and Cytochemistry on Termite Flagellates. He joined in April, 1964 in Zoological Survey of India and superannuated on April, 2001.

Early of the 1977, he has been transferred to Andaman & Nicobar Islands for set up a new Regional Centre of ZSI at Port Blair and headed that station for six years. He came to Port Blair and established the first station of ZSI in a rented municipality building at Delanipur. He then started recruitment from the local people through employment exchange to run the office. In Andaman & Nicobar Islands, he started to study on the mangrove fauna with special reference to wood boring Mollusca. He was also the President of the Andaman Bangiyo Sahitya Samskriti Parishad for 3 years. He was President (Founder) of SEBA from July, 2004 to Sept., 2017.

After that he has been transferred to Headquarter and served in the Protozoology Section as an Officer In-Charge. He also acted as Head of Office at ZSI Headquarter. He was the co-author of the two books on Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Glimpses of A&N Islands and Seashore Animals of A & N Islands), which are the first consolidated documentation on Fauna of Andaman & Nicobar Islands. Beside this, he published and authors of several scientific research papers, books chapters, occasional papers, books, and special publication. As a Ph.D. Guide, a good number of students did work under him. In this tragic moment, entire family of Zoological Survey of India and specially the Officers and Staff of Andaman & Nicobar Regional Centre stands together in offering our heartfelt condolences to Dr. Das's family.

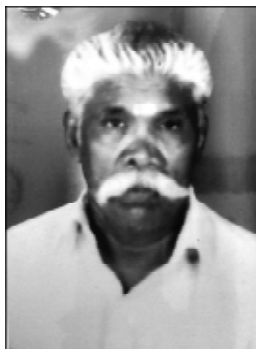

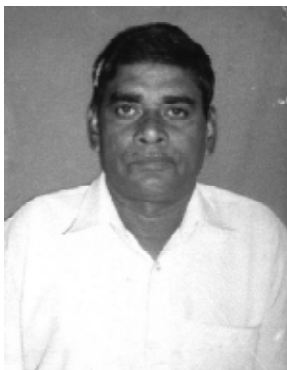

their vehicles checked for PUC certificates. Considering the long queues of the vehicles at the 'Pollution Testing Centres' and request of motor vehicle owners, it has been decided by the Competent Authority to grant 15 days relaxation to all the vehicle owners to get their vehicles checked for PUC Certificates. Accordingly, all vehicles shall get their vehicles checked for pollution level before Jan.11, 2022 and carry a valid 'Pollution Under Control' Certificate while plying on the roads. Beyond the specified date, if any vehicle is found plying without having a valid PUC Certificate and flouting the pollution norms, stringent penal action will be taken as per Section 190 of Motor Vehicle Act, 1988. However, the 'Catch the Polluter' drive against polluting vehicles shall continue and, if any, vehicle is found polluting, then such violators shall be penalized as per rules, a communication from Directorate of Transport received here said.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub
Malabar tamarind (Garcinia gummi-gutta): A potential commercial crop for the islands

Malabar tamarind is a multipurpose species native to the Western Ghats. To study the performance of crop under island condition, ICAR-CIARI introduced and evaluated it for past 13 years. Results have suggested that the crop could be profitably grown under island conditions, provided scientific crop production and postharvest management is adopted. Malabar tamarind has been valued for the medicinal value of its rind, anti-obesity being the major one. Grafted plants start yielding within 3-4 years of planting and could be planted at a spacing of 6 m x 6 m with suitable canopy management practices. It could also be incorporated as an intercrop in coconut plantations. A well grown plant may yield about 50-70 kg fruits per year. Flowering occurs during February-March, while fruiting occurs during July-August under island conditions. Some early types have been identified at ICAR-CIARI, which start fruiting from May onwards. Fruits could be harvested every 4-5 days during fruiting season. At home or cottage scale, fruit peel could be sun dried or smoke dried for future consumption. Considering the coincidence of fruiting season with rains in the islands, use of mechanical driers is desirable for commercial scale processing. From 100 kg of fruits, about 10-15 kg dry produce could be obtained depending upon the drying method used. Under island condition, no major pest or disease incidence was reported in the experimental fields of the Institute. **Benefit:** Cultivation of Malabar tamarind, solely or as an intercrop coupled with processing through mechanical means could not only diversify the island agriculture but would also enhance the income of the stakeholders involved. **Contact person with Name, Designation e-mail and phone no: Dr.Pooja Bohra, Scientist (Fruit Science), Division of Horticulture and Forestry, ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair.
