## In a historic initiative, PM to lay foundation stone for redevelopment of 508 railway stations across the country on 6<sup>th</sup> August

New Delhi, Aug 4 (PIB)

In a historic initiative, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi will lay the foundation stone for redevelopment of 508 railway stations across the length and breadth of the country on 6th August at 11 AM via video conferencing. Prime Minister has often laid stress on provision of state-of-the-art public transport. Noting that railways is the preferred mode of transport of people



across the country, he has emphasised on the importance of providing world class amenities at railway stations. Guided by this vision, the Amrit Bharat Station Scheme was launched to redevelop 1309 stations across the country.

As part of this scheme, the foundation stone for redevelopment of 508 stations is being laid by the Prime Minister. These stations will be redeveloped at a cost of more than Rs 24,470 crores. Master Plans are being

prepared for development of these stations as 'City Centres', with proper integration of both sides of the city. This integrated approach is driven by the holistic vision of overall urban development of the city, centred around the railway station. These 508 stations are spread across 27 states and union territories, including 55 each in Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan, 49 in Bihar, 44 in Maharashtra, 37 in West Bengal, 34 in

The Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah chaired the 38th meeting of the Committee of Parliament on Official Language in New Delhi today. During the meeting, 12th volume of the report of the Committee of Parliament on Official Language was also approved which will be presented to the President.

In his address, Union Home Minister said that in the year of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, Prime



Minister Shri Narendra Modi has kept "Panch Pran" in front of the country, out of which two Pran are-respect of heritage and erasing the signs of slavery. Shri Shah said that for 100% implementation of these two Pran, all the Indian languages and the official language will have to show

their strength. He said that respect of heritage is incomplete without respect of language and acceptance of official language will come only when we give respect to local languages. Shri Shah said that Hindi is not in competition with local languages, the nation will be

empowered only by promoting all Indian languages. He said that there is a need to develop acceptance for the official language without any kind of opposition, even if its pace is slow.

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation said that Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has taken the initiative to start engineering and medical courses in 10 languages and soon these courses will be available in all Indian languages and that moment will mark the beginning of the rise

The Regional Director of Central Ground Water Board, Eastern Region, Kolkata, Dr. Anadi Gayen called on the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS, today and presented the report on 'National Compilation on Dynamic Ground Water Resources of India-2022'. The Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Smt. Nandini Paliwal, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, Smt. Veditha Reddy and the Secretary, APWD, Shri Arjun Sharma were also present on the occasion. The report gives an overview of periodical assessment of Dynamic Ground Water Resources which provides an idea of Annual Ground Water Recharge vis-a-vis Annual Ground Water Extraction of a given assessment unit (mostly Administrative units like Block/District/ State). However, considering unique geography of the Islands, assessment unit adopted for dynamic ground water assessment is based on separate Islands for more realistic assessment. A&N Islands has been divided into 37 assessment blocks for this purpose.

## Advanced minimally invasive biliary tract surgery performed at ANIIMS/G.B Pant Hospital

Port Blair, Aug. 4

A 65 year old gentle man was admitted in the surgical department of ANIIMS with complaints of recurrent upper abdominal pain and jaundice for the last 6- 12 months. He was investigated with blood, urine, USG abdomen and contrast CT scan abdomen and MRCP which revealed a large type-1 Choledochal cyst. He was prepared pre- operatively and pre-anesthetic checkup was done and fitness for surgery was taken.



On July 17, 2023 the patient was taken up for elective major advanced minimal access surgery by a team of Doctors headed by Dr. Saji Vargheese & Anesthetist Dr. Saras Sahoo & Dr. Saran & staff and performed Laparoscopic excision of Choledochal cyst and Roux-en-Y Hepatico-jejunostomy, a 4 hours surgery through 5 key holes in which the abnormally dilated biliary tree was excised and the continuity of the biliary tree was restored by doing anastomosis between the common hepatic duct and small intestine. Post-operatively the patient was shifted to Surgical ICU and mobilized from the bed 1st post-operative day and started oral feeds on 3rd post-operative day. The patient recovered very well and was discharged on 7th post-operative day.
