Minimum Wages across A&N Islands revised All Establishments asked to ensure payment of Minimum Wages to workers Port Blair, July 29

The Andaman & Nicobar Administration has revised the Minimum Wages across Andaman & Nicobar Islands w.e.f 1st July, 2022. As per the revised rate, for Unskilled category it will be Rs. 517 per day, for Semi-Skilled/Unskilled Supervisory category, Rs. 574, Skilled/Clerical category, it will be Rs. 659 and for Highly/Skilled category, it will be Rs. 717 per day.

The Labour Department, under the guidance of Secretary (Labour), Shri Hari Kallikkat is playing a proactive role for the betterment of the workers. The Department has settled 22 cases of Non-Payment of Wages in 2022 wherein an amount of Rs. 11,43,200 has been released to the workers. 9 Employee's Compensation Cases were settled in 2022 and an amount of Rs. 76,32,086 has been released to workmen/dependents. Regular camps for PM-SYM & e-Shram are also being conducted to create awareness. 
