A&N Islands achieves 100% second dose COVID-19 vaccination coverage target braving challenges

Chief Secretary appreciates all on behalf of Lt Governor

Trained manpower, effective communication & commitment of all stakeholders encapsulate this feat



Port Blair, Dec. 18

The Andaman & Nicobar Administration has responded to the COVID-19 pandemic in a prompt & proactive manner to prevent the spread of the virus in A&N Islands. The concerted effort has yielded result with A&N Islands achieving 100% second dose COVID-19 vaccination coverage target despite the topographical challenges. Besides maintaining continued focus on specific interventions to contain the disease, continued delivery of non-COVID essential health services was also ensured. On 17.12.2021, the UT achieved its feat by completing 286000 second doses of vaccine.

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain has

appreciated all on behalf of Lt Governor, A&N Islands, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) for the remarkable achievement.

Braving challenges in terms of the Islands' topography and other logistic constraints, due to its physical distance from mainland India, the Andaman & Nicobar Administration's persistent effort in ensuring the safety of the citizens is a laudable feat.

The safety of the Islanders is the foremost priority of the Administration, especially during this pandemic time. To shield its citizens from the corona virus, the vaccination of eligible beneficiaries was initiated by the Administration in different parts of the Islands. Accordingly, the vaccination began with

administering of COVISHIELD vaccine for Health Care Workers followed by frontline workers and vulnerable population with co-morbidities. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years.

It may be recalled that under the guidance of Chief Secretary, Shri Jitendra Narain various measures to encourage people to get themselves vaccinated proved beneficial in containment of the virus as well as achieving 100 % vaccination coverage in a record time. Prominent initiative includes the campaign launched in the initial stage of the drive viz. "I got vaccinated, when will you" to achieving saturation with "I am fully vaccinated". The COVID team from Directorate of Health Services and District

Administration of all three Districts ensured that the target set is achieved in time and their efforts have fructified.

Trained manpower is the most important factor to carry out vaccination at ground level and the UT Administration took this step in a well planned manner before the roll out of the vaccine in the UT. All the Health Care professionals were trained through Virtual Meetings, One-on-One interaction on every aspect of COVID-19 vaccine in terms of doses administration; data uploading in portal, AEFI case management are few to mention.

Once the vaccine was received from the company, the same was sent to peripheral Health Institutions by road,

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Towards making A&N Islands plastic free PBMC warns stakeholders to refrain from using/selling single use plastic products

Port Blair, Dec. 18

The A&N Administration is committed towards making these Islands a plastic free. To arrest the use of plastic in these pristine Islands, the Administration has banned the sale/use of single use plastics in different forms. Despite the imposition of ban on single use plastic products, it has come to the notice of the Port Blair Municipal Council that these products are being used and sold by users/commercial stakeholders respectively in the form

of plates, glasses, cups, parcel paper, carry bags etc. besides aluminium bottles, foils, wrapper and carry bags have been introduced in the market which are even more dangerous than plastic.

In this regard, PBMC has requested stakeholders not to store, use or sell such products. If any person is found using such single use plastic, fine will be imposed as per PBMC, SWM (Handling Rules 2017) and commercial establishment will be

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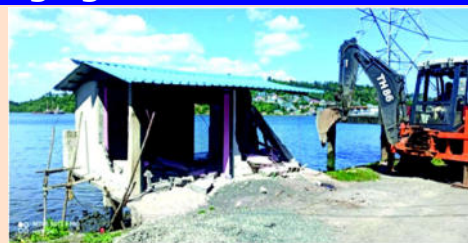
District Administration conducts eviction drive along seashore area of Dairy Farm

DC (SA) appeals general public to refrain from indulging in such activities

Port Blair, Dec. 18

The District Administration in continuation with its drive against encroachments on Govt. revenue land in South Andaman District, carried out a mass eviction drive along the seaside area of Dairy Farm and removed RCC and temporary structures constructed upon Govt. land.

Shri Suneel Anchipaka, Deputy Commissioner (SA) cautioned the general public to refrain from indulging in such illegal



activities and reiterated that drive against such illegal encroachments shall be continued by the Revenue Department to protect the Govt. land from encroachments and strict action as per law shall be initiated against defaulters. He further urged the general public

to come forward to pass on information of any such illegal activities to the District Control Room over the numbers 03192-240127/1077 or 9 5 3 1 8 8 8 4 4 (WhatsApp), a press release received from Deputy Commissioner (SA) said.

One positive case detected during test conducted on inter-island bound passengers

Port Blair, Dec. 18

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 359 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 12 flights with 2133 passengers & 5 infants arrived, out of which, 1723 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 410 passengers (includes

28 international travellers) and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 74 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 69 passengers and one positive case has been detected. At Phoenix

Bay Jetty, 71 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. During RAT conducted on 6 passengers at Helipad, no positive case has been detected.

Today, till 3 pm, 306 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 289 were in the age group of 18-44, a press release from the Directorate of IP&T said.

Mass vaccination prog. for foot and mouth disease in cattle from Dec. 20

Farmers advised to ensure vaccination of their animals

Port Blair, Dec. 18

The second round of the foot-and-mouth disease (FMD) vaccination campaign will start from Dec. 20 under the National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP) by the Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, A&N Administration.

The 26th Round of mass vaccination programme for Foot and Mouth Disease will be conducted in all the cattle of South

Andaman w.e.f Dec. 20. This vaccination is important for providing immunity against the selected strains of FMD virus which can cause significant morbidity and production losses in the animals, along with the ulcerations and high fever. All the services involved in the vaccination programme are available free of cost for the farmers.

Farmers have been advised to take utmost care in ensuring that their animal is

vaccinated and no animal is left unvaccinated. Even if the farmers have vaccinated their animals in the last round, they are again advised to participate in the program. All the farmers have been advised to fully cooperate for vaccination to be carried out by the officials of the Directorate of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, a press release from Director (AH&VS) said.

helicopter and ship even to the remotest part of the Island which was covered by special boat and out boats. On 16.01.2021, Hon'ble Prime Minister kick started the COVID-19 vaccination campaign across India. The Health Care Workers followed by Frontline Workers were vaccinated first. The first site was made at School of Nursing and AYUSH Hospital at Port Blair.

The phase wise vaccination continued for all age groups above 18 years of age. Once the vaccination supply improved, the registration was allowed offline and camps were organized by the DHS, District Administration and the NGOs. As the UT was hitting the edge of completion of the first dose, the vaccination pace slowed down due to poor response from the left over population. Hence, House to House campaign was flagged off and the process of vaccination was augmented. On 19.9.2021, the UT achieved 100% first dose of vaccination with a target of 286000 doses.

During the entire process, the teams travelled to various places and Islands by road, ship and helicopter. Special boats were arranged for smaller Islands exclusively for vaccination drive. Out boats was the boon for Nancowry, Campbell Bay and few places in N&M Andaman for conducting the vaccination drive.

The health staff also walked kms in jungle to reach the hamlets crossing flooded river and wooden log pool and over crocodile infested rivers and backwaters.

Apart from this, the vaccination of PVTGs was undertaken with utmost planning and care. Specialised teams including Specialists with emergency equipment was shifted to other Islands and in remote forest to vaccinate them. And with the vaccination of the Jarawa tribe, it got a very positive response therefore others were vaccinated simultaneously.

The Shompen community received their first ever vaccination and it was a success.

On 03.11.2021, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, started 'Har Ghar Dastak' programme which was already ongoing in the UT was augmented and the UT could achieve more than 28% increase in second dose coverage by the campaign which added to the completion of second dose.

During the entire process of vaccination, the wastage rate of vaccine was kept minimum near zero, a press release from DHS said.

Curbing carbon footprints in Isles General public advised to reduce vehicular smoke emission & get their emission level checked

Port Blair, Dec. 18

The number of Motor vehicles in Andaman & Nicobar Islands has drastically increased in the past few years and these motor vehicles emit various kinds of pollutants including gases and solid matter. In order to protect the environment of these emerald islands, there is a need to control vehicle emissions.

The vehicle owners have been advised to reduce smoke emission by adopting walking, riding instead of driving for going to short

distances and are also encouraged to use public transport instead of the private transport. Further, they can opt for carpool to reduce the carbon footprint.

They have also been advised to switch off the engine, when waiting at the junctions. General public have been advised to get the vehicular smoke emissions level checked and obtain PUC (Pollution Under Control Certificate).

Vehicles emitting excess smoke and failure to produce

PUC will attract penalty as per M.V (A) Act, 2019.

Further, they have also been advised to renew all vehicle related documents such as road tax, insurance etc. and additional documents of permit, fitness etc. for commercial vehicles and to carry them either in original or in Digitalocker/mParivahan app. Driving vehicles without valid documents will also attract penalty as per M.V (A) Act, 2019, a press release from SP (Traffic) said.

India successfully test fires new generation nuclear capable ballistic missile 'Agni P' off Odisha coast

Bhubaneswar, Dec. 18

Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) today successfully tested the new generation nuclear-capable ballistic missile 'Agni P' from Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Island off the coast of Odisha. Agni P is a two-stage canisterised solid-propellant ballistic missile with dual redundant navigation and guidance system.

This second flight test has proven the reliable performance of all the advanced technologies integrated into the system. Defence Ministry in a press release, said, various telemetry, radar, electro-optical stations and downrange ships positioned along the eastern coast tracked and monitored the missile trajectory and parameters.

The missile followed the text book trajectory, meeting all mission



objectives with high level of accuracy. Defence Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh congratulated DRDO for the successful flight test and expressed his happiness for the excellent performance of the system.

DRDO Chairman Dr. G Satheesh Reddy appreciated the efforts of the team for conducting the second development flight trial with many additional features and congratulated for the consecutive success within the same calendar year. (Source:india.gov.in)

Vaccination- shield against the virus 5,85,860 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Dec. 18

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 5,85,860 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,86,600 (approx.).

A total of 1877 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 1803 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 82 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 74 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 3 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. A total of 1,77,221 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Quality seed

Crop production can be augmented through improved varieties complemented with quality seed and good agricultural practices. Use of farmers-saved seeds



from cultivation is one of the main reasons for the low productivity of crop in the Island. High yielding varieties and their quality seed play a very significant role in agriculture. It has been estimated that improved varieties with good quality seed and proper management practices contribute 36-54% to crop production. About 80% of farmers are found using farm-saved seed. To enhance the seed production, seed chain should be strengthened, which not only increases the productivity but also lead to seed quality control. CIARI being a research institute hold the responsibility of providing breeder or foundation seed of developed improved varieties of crop viz. rice, mung, urd, brinjal etc to interested parties. Participatory seed production could be a better approach in quality seed production for which farmers can be trained for establishing seed villages and community seed banks.

Benefit: More yield per unit area, uniform crop stand, less infestation of insect and pests, good germination of seed and less seed required for sowing.
