

Union Minister for Health & Family Welfare launches i-Drone, ICMR's drone-based vaccine delivery model

First time in South Asia, a 'Make in India' drone used to transport COVID-19 vaccines

"Drones can be used in delivering important life-saving medicines, collecting blood samples in critical situations and in tough geographical areas": Minister

New Delhi, Oct. 4 (PIB) In a landmark event that epitomizes the Government's commitment to 'Antyodaya' in health; making healthcare accessible to the last citizen of the country, Shri Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare launched ICMR's Drone Response and Outreach in North East (i-Drone). This is a delivery model to make sure that life-saving vaccines reach everyone.

Thanking the

visionary leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, the Union Health Minister said, "Under his leadership, the Nation is progressing at a great pace. Today is a historic day, which showed us how technology is making life easier and bringing social change."

Congratulating the people of the country on this innovative step, Shri Mansukh Mandaviya said, "This is for the first time that a 'Make in India' drone has been used in South Asia to transport COVID vaccine over an aerial

distance of 15 kms in 12-15 mins from the Bishnupur district hospital to Loktak lake, Karang island in Manipur for administration at the PHC. The actual road distance between these locations is 26 km. Today, 10 beneficiaries received their first dose and 8 received their second dose at the PHC."

He further added, "India is a home to geographical diversities and drones can be used to deliver essentials to the last mile. We can use drones in delivering important life-saving

medicines, collecting blood samples. This technology can also be used in critical situations. This technology may prove a game changer in addressing the challenges in health care delivery, particularly health supplies in difficult areas."

Launching the initiative which would facilitate vaccine delivery to tough and hard-to-reach terrains of India, the Union Health Minister said, "Our immunization program for COVID-19 have

already exceeded all expectations. I strongly believe that this initiative will further help us achieve the highest possible immunization coverage for COVID-19. Incorporating such drone technologies into the national programs would help deliver other vaccines and medical supplies as quickly as possible."

Despite the effective and safe vaccine administration in the States and Union Territories, the vaccine delivery among tough

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 621 passengers who arrived here yesterday, one positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 1306 passengers arrived, out of which, 602 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on remaining 704 passengers and the reports are awaited.

and hard-to-reach terrains of India is still challenging. This i-Drone has been designed to overcome these challenges by deploying Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV)/drones to remote areas and hard to reach terrains. Currently, the drone based delivery project has been granted permission for implementation in Manipur and Nagaland, as well as union territory of Andaman and Nicobar Island.

ICMR conducted an initial study in collaboration with Indian Institute of Technology, Kanpur to test the capacity of drones to carry and transfer vaccines safely. The study was conducted in Manipur, Nagaland and Andaman and Nicobar. These studies provided promising results on the basis of which the Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA), Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) and other regulatory authorities have granted permission to fly drones beyond the Visual Line Of Sight.

Shri Mandaviya expressed his confidence in the initiative and noted that this initiative can be helpful in delivering not only the vaccines but also other medical supplies. This will help in overcoming the gaps in current vaccine delivery mechanisms. He thanked the Ministry of Civil Aviation, DGCA and Airport Authority of India for their support towards this endeavour and congratulated ICMR, health workers and all associated with this landmark initiative.

In order to comply with the Act in letter and spirit, the penalty /fine amount for various violations will be levied on street vendors violating the Act. For vending without Certificate of Vending (CoV) / Vending at 'No vending Zone', fine amounting to Rs. 2,000/- will be levied; Vending at different location (Not as per the CoV issued) Rs. 1,500/-; Extension/ additional space occupied in vending site by the Vendors, Rs. 1,000 /-; Vending with other persons/ letting the space to others (other than his/her family members) Rs. 1,000/-; Not up-keeping public health and hygiene, Rs. 500 /-; Non-compliance of other instructions of the CoV/ instructions of Town Vending Committee, Rs. 500/-.
