done online starting from registration in National Scholarship Portal (NSP) to disbursement of payment directly to the bank account of beneficiary through Public Financial Management System (PFMS).

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Jan. 17

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 109 passengers who arrived here yesterday, 32 positive cases have been detected. Today, 8 flights with 478 passengers arrived, out of which, 377 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on

95 passengers (1 foreign traveller) and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 28 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, 2 positive cases have been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 39

passengers, one positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 20 passengers were tested with RAT and no positive case has been detected. Till 3 pm, 210 eligible persons were vaccinated, out of which, 61 were in the age group of 15-18, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Jan. 17

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,01,524 beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands. Similarly, 18,344 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18

years against the target beneficiaries of 23,000. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 2992.

A total of 1089 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 719 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District,

out of which, 130 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years while 133 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years.

206 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 39 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years while 29

healthcare workers and scientific community across the country in protecting the people against the COVID pandemic. Speaking on the occasion, Dr Mandaviya said, India has encountered various challenges along the journey but it is the resolve and dedication of more than 135 crore people that we could overcome every challenge. He said, the world is amazed by India's vaccination drive. The Minister said, 93 per cent of people above 18 years have been vaccinated with 1st dose and 70 per cent of the population is fully vaccinated. (Source: india.gov.in)

Govt issues new clinical guidance for management of adult COVID patients

New Delhi, Jan. 17 Health and Family Welfare Ministry has issued new clinical guidance for management of adult COVID-19 patients in the country. Under the new guidance, active tuberculosis has been added in the high risk disease for COVID-19. People above the age of 60, people having cardiovascular disease, hypertension, diabetes, HIV, chronic lung, kidney,

liver disease, cerebrovascular disease and obesity are in the high risk category. The new clinical guidance states that anti inflammatory or immunomodulatory therapy such as steroids can have risk of secondary infection such as mucormycosis when used too early, at higher dose or for longer than required. Health and Family Welfare Ministry has advised that remdesivir not to be used in patients who are not on oxygen support or in home settings. It said, remdesivir may be considered only in patients having moderate to severe disease of COVID-19 requiring supplemental oxygen. The guidance further states that Tocilizumab may be considered when rapidly progressing COVID-19 requires oxygen supplementation. (Source: india.gov.in)

Short Title and Commencement :- (i) These rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration (Superintending Engineer of Electricity Department) Recruitment Rules,2018. (ii) This shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette. 2. Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of Pay :- The Number of Posts, its Classification and the Scale of Pay attached thereto, shall be as specified at Sl.No.2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed thereto. 3. Method of Recruitment, Age limit, Qualifications :- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified at Sl.No.5 to 13 of the said Schedule. 4. Disqualifications :- No Person – (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, <div>or</div> (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person(s) shall be eligible for appointment to the said post: Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), A&N Islands, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage or there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule. 5. Powers to Relax : Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), A&N Islands, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons. 6. Savings : Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit, and other concessions required to be provided for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Duties and Responsibilities of Superintending Engineer
A Circle Office is under the charge of Superintending Engineer and is the Head of the Department and Controlling Officer for all the Officers and Staff of this Department. The Superintending Engineer coordinates and supervises the activities of Seven Divisions employed in generation and distribution of electricity. He/She is responsible for Administration and Establishment matters, formulation of all schemes implemented by the department, fixing of targets and achieving them. He/She makes arrangements for creation of new post and filling of vacant post. He/She is responsible for getting funds for the Capital and Revenues. He/She has to exercise the powers of Head of Department as per the GFR and the powers delegated by A&N Administration thereof for purchase of stores and sanction of estimate. He/She has to furnish replies/reports to Government, Regulatory Commission and/or any other agency as and when requested. He/She has to furnish replies/reports to Parliament Questions/PAC Reports and Audit Paras. 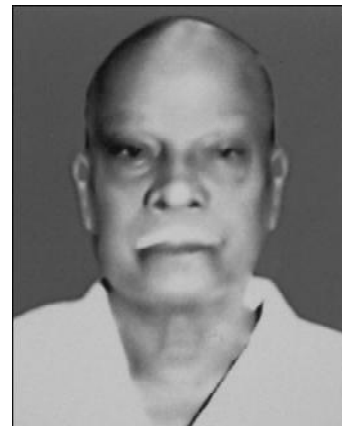
