further need to invoke the provisions of DM Act for COVID containment measures after expiry of the existing order issued dated 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2022. However, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) advisories on COVID containment measures, including on the use of face masks and hand hygiene, will continue to guide the overall national response to the pandemic. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain in the early hours today visited villages in South Andaman to take stock of the developments taking place in the area and interacted with the people. Villagers in large number were overjoyed to see the Chief Secretary amidst them early in the morning, listening to their grievances and giving on the spot direction for its redressal. During the visit, the Chief Secretary, who was accompanied by Adhyaksha, Zilla Parishad, South Andaman, Smti. Pramila Kumari, PRI members and team of Officers of A&N Administration visited Sippighat, Dhanikhari, Murdakhadi, Guptapara, Manglutan and Manjery

The Chief Secretary categorically stated that the flagship schemes/programmes being implemented by the Central Government for their upliftment should reach the beneficiaries. He asked the authorities to solve the grievances of the general public in rural areas on priority basis. He appealed to the villagers and PRIs to plant flowering and fruit bearing trees in the area to make it more attractive and beautiful. The Chief Secretary also directed to remove encroachments from main junctions of different villages. The Chief Secretary started his visit from Sippighat

Junction, wherein he directed the Officers to widen the Junction area without disturbing the private land. Thereafter, he visited Dhanikhari and directed the concerned authorities to make the Dhanikhari Junction more appealing. He suggested that along road side areas, monoculture should be promoted for facade development by involving local residents. The Chief Secretary stated that 5000 musaenda flowering plants should be raised along the road side for its beautification, starting from one stretch. Panchayats have been directed to take up the planting of vegetables and fruit bearing trees. He also directed

for renovating the bus stop at Dhanikhari Junction. He directed to ensure proper cattle management in rural areas for better tourism façade. At Murdakhadi Junction, he directed the concerned authorities to upkeep and improve the facilities at the graveyard.

Thereafter, the Chief Secretary visited Guptapara and directed the Deputy Commissioner to remove the encroachment and land set apart for developing a Market Complex at Guptapara Junction. Noticing a lot of unused Govt. buildings, the Chief Secretary asked the concerned to look into it. Expressing his displeasure over

the scattered garbage at Guptapara Junction, the Chief Secretary ordered to clean and beautify the area by involving SHGs. The Chief Secretary appreciated the houses beautified with flowers in the area and urged the PRI members present there to encourage others also to emulate the same. On the request of the residents, the Chief Secretary directed the concerned for constructing a concrete pathway for the 40-50 households residing in the area. He asked the officials of the Electricity Department to look into the delay in setting up of 'Electricity Substation' at Guptapara Rubber Plantation area.

While interacting with the Chief Secretary, the residents brought to his notice about non-availability of ANMs at Sub-Centre Guptapara and upon this, the Chief Secretary directed the DHS to check the working time of all ANMs and their performance. He said absence of ANMs will not be tolerated and stern action needs to be taken against the erring officials.

On his visit to Manglutan, the Chief Secretary while noting the historical importance of the School building at Manglutan, directed the Education Department to upgrade the School. He also asked the concerned authorities to explore the possibility of creating an Anganwadi Centre near Manglutan School. Regarding widening of the road to PHC Manglutan and West Bengal

Voluntary Health Association, the Chief Secretary said the widening of road shall be taken up after analysing the density of population and traffic. Villagers also requested for starting a mini bus service with minimum two trips per day for the convenience of the people residing in the area.


