Direct recruitment to all Group 'C' posts by Departments

Hon'ble Lt. Governor grants relaxation of upper age limit by two years over and above upper age limit prescribed in relevant RRs as a one-time measure

Relaxation shall be applicable for first direct recruitment to be made for each cadre by Departments concerned after issue of the order or it will be in force until 31.12.2023 whichever is earlier

Port Blair, Sept. 1
The direct recruitments proposed to be conducted by various Departments of Andaman and Nicobar Administration could not be conducted in the recent past due to COVID-19 pandemic. In the meantime, many aspiring candidates have

become over aged and they could not apply for direct recruitments notified and to be notified in near future. Hence, there have been requests from various quarters to relax the upper age limit for direct recruitments notified and to be notified in near

future by the various Departments.
After careful consideration of the requests, the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, UT Andaman and Nicobar Islands is pleased to grant relaxation of upper age limit by two years over and above the upper age limit

prescribed in the relevant Recruitment Rules, as a one-time measure, for the direct recruitment of all the Group 'C' posts to be notified by the Departments concerned. The relaxation shall be applicable for the first direct recruitment to be made for each cadre

by the Departments concerned after issue of the order or it will be in force until 31.12.2023, whichever is earlier. The Departments have to follow the other conditions prescribed by the Finance Department before notifying the vacancies with the onetime relaxation.

The age relaxation available to various categories shall also be applicable over and above the relaxation now given, an order to this effect issued with the approval of Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, UT, A & N Islands by Assistant Secretary (Personal) said.

'Pradhan Mantri Jan-Dhan Yojana'- providing platform for channeling all social security schemes

60692 accounts opened under PMJDY in Isles so far

Port Blair, Sept. 1
'Pradhan Mantri Jan-Dhan Yojana' (PMJDY) has provided a platform for channeling all the social security schemes such as Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY), Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY), Atal Pension Yojana (APY), Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), Micro Units Development & Refinance Agency Bank (MUDRA) scheme and pushing the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) scheme of the Central Government. In A&N Islands, a total of 60692 accounts have been opened under 'Pradhan Mantri Jan-Dhan Yojana' (PMJDY) so far. The scheme ensures access to financial services, namely savings and deposit accounts, remittance, credit, insurance and pension in an affordable manner to the country's poor and marginalized section of the society.



'Pradhan Mantri Jan-Dhan Yojana' also provides an overdraft facility- a financial facility or instrument that enables an account holder to withdraw money from his/her bank account (savings or current), even if they do not have any account balance. Like any other credit facility, the bank levies an interest rate when an account holder avails the overdraft facility. Overdraft facility is usually offered for the withdrawal of a limited amount of money. The Centre's scheme allows the Jan Dhan account holders to withdraw money upto Rs.10,000 in the form of a short-term loan. This limit was earlier Rs.5,000 which was doubled last year. The owner of a PMJDY account, who wants to avail the overdraft facility, must have been satisfactorily operating it for at least six months. Only one member of a particular family can avail the overdraft facility. Usually female members are favoured for this. For overdraft of upto Rs. 2,000, no guarantee is needed under PMJDY. The Government has also increased the upper age limit for overdraft from 60 to 65 years.

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Sept. 1
Two COVID positive cases have been detected today in A&N Islands. These two cases were detected during the screening of incoming flight passengers who arrived here yesterday. Today, 10 flights with 1402 passengers arrived, out of which, 1248 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 107 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 10 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 10 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 2 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus and no positive case has been detected, a press release from IP&T said.

Nearly 90 per cent of airspace available for drone flying due to liberalization of drone policy: Govt.

New Delhi, Sept. 1
Minister of State for Civil Aviation, General V K Singh (Retd.) has said that the Government has liberalised the Drone Policy to give a fillip to those who want to manufacture or set up the Drone industry. He said, now nearly 90 per cent of the airspace is available

for drone flying. He added that the Government has also brought up the Production Linked Incentive scheme to promote the growth of drone manufacturing by private companies. implementing the second submarine OF cable connectivity to mainland ie from Diglipur to Puri, Odisha for having redundancy to the existing CANI connectivity, along with it he advised to plan to include the left out islands like Shaheed Dweep, Katchal, Teressa, Champin & Little Nicobar on the second submarine OF cable link.

The Chairman, TAC appreciated the efforts made by CGM, BSNL and team for upgrading 2G mobile BTSs in A&N Islands at North & Middle Andaman, Little Andaman, Teressa, Katchal and Great Nicobar and for the recent launch of FTTH services at Shaheed Deep and Katchal. He stated that the commissioning of the CANI OF Submarine cable connectivity has brought about sufficient speed in mobile and data services. He stated that the mobile connectivity project of GoI '4G saturation project' which is planned to cover 256 uncovered villages in A&N Islands with 4G mobile services will be a boon to the Islanders and would bridge the digital divide. He assured that TAC will take up the issue at appropriate level with GoI and DOT, New Delhi for any support in early completion of the project. Further, Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma also suggested that all BSNL mobile Towers need to be provided with power backup facilities so that in the event of failure of power supply by the electricity department, the mobile Towers continue to provide uninterrupted internet/ broadband service to the intended locations. In this regard, the Chief General Manager responded that action for procurement of batteries as backup facilities has already been initiated which are expected to be delivered within 6 months, this will bring about an appreciable improvement in providing uninterrupted Mobile Internet services in entire A&N Islands.

Earlier, the CGM, A&N Telecom Circle, Shri. G. Raja Ram Mohan in his address gave a brief of the ongoing Telecom projects, future plans of telecommunication & ICT services being undertaken by BSNL in A&N Islands. additions to its flight and fight capabilities. Tejas 2.0 will be equipped with more powerful GE- F414 engines in the 98 Kilonewton thrust class, which will allow it to extend its flight range and carry additional payload and weapons as compared to the existing version. The payload capacity of the Tejas Mark-2 jet will be four tonnes as compared to three tonnes of the existing version.

In addition to this, the new jet will also be equipped with an indigenously developed Active Electronically Scanned Array (AESA) radar, which will be a major upgrade from the existing ELTA's EL/M-2032 multi-mode radar. (Source: india.gov.in)

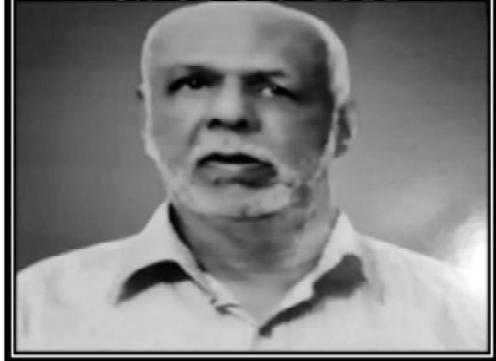

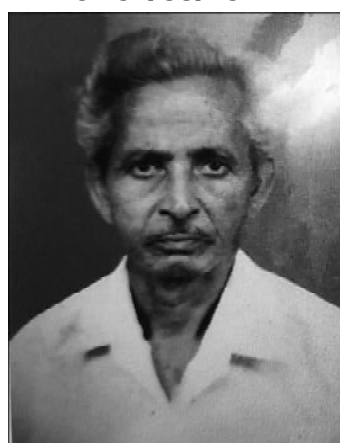

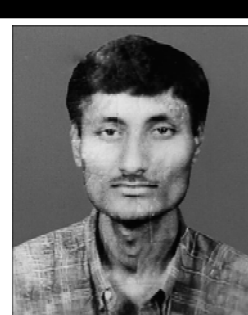
