Citizens above 18 years of age to be given booster doses free of cost from July 15 till next 75 days

New Delhi, July 13 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has expressed the hope that decision for free COVID-19 Precaution Dose for all the citizens above 18 years of age at Government vaccination centres, from 15th July 2022 till the next 75 days will further India's vaccination coverage and create a healthier nation. The decision was taken at today's Cabinet meeting as part of #AzadiKaAmritMahotsav celebrations.

The Prime Minister tweeted in response to a tweet by the Union Health Minister Dr Mansukh Mandaviya: "Vaccination is an effective means to fight COVID-19. Today's Cabinet decision will further India's vaccination coverage and create a healthier nation."

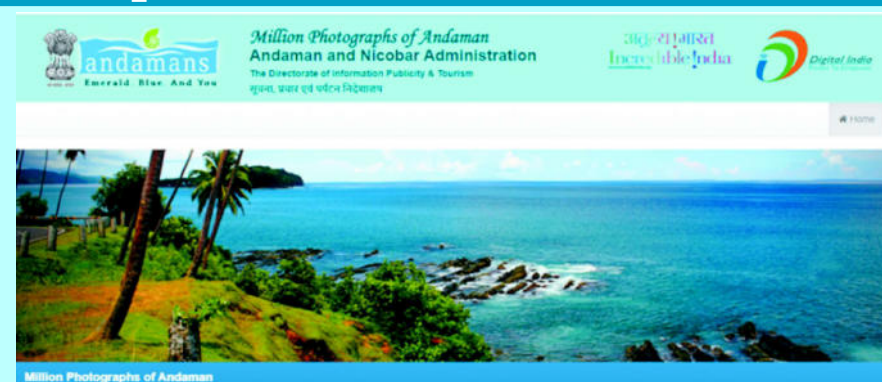

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,84,239 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,596 beneficiaries have been

vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years. 24,713 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years have been administered both doses of vaccine. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 28,405.

A total of 187 eligible

beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 74 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 13 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 18 to 44 and the number of

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, July 13

Nine positive cases have been detected today in A&N Islands, of which, 5 were from incoming flight passengers who arrived here yesterday. Today, 7 flights with 1021 passengers arrived, out of which, 860 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 101 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 13 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case was detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 12 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case was detected. RAT was conducted on 9 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus, one positive case was detected. At Helipad one person was tested with RAT and the report was negative, a press release from DHS said.

Mehuli and Tushar outsmarted the Hungarian pair of Eszter Meszaros and Istvan	Pen 17-13 in an evenly poised match-up. The Indian pair of Palak and Shiva Narwal bagged bronze today in the 10m Air Pistol mixed event, after clinching the third-place play-off. Palak and Shiva thrashed Kazakhstan's Irina Loktionova and Valeriy Rakhimzhan 16-0, in what turned out to be a one-sided clash. This is Tushar's maiden gold for India at	the senior level while Mehuli bagged her second yellow metal, having won her first at the 2019 South Asian Games in Kathmandu. With the impressive results today, India has now climbed up to the second position behind leaders Serbia, with two gold and 1 bronze medal. Earlier, India's Arjun Babuta had won his first gold medal in men's air rifle on Monday.
