

IMF lauds India's Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana programme which prevented extreme poverty in the country during COVID-19

New Delhi, April 6

International Monetary Fund (IMF) has lauded India's food subsidy programme which prevented the increased prevalence of extreme poverty in the country during COVID-19. In a report the IMF has said, the expansion of food transfers and subsidies make it an important instrument for poverty alleviation. Appreciating the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana, the report demonstrated that the programme provided insurance to the poor and prevented an increase in the prevalence of extreme



poverty in the country.

It stated that doubling of entitlements in 2020 during pandemic helped maintain extreme poverty at the low 0.8 percent level. It also said, without any food subsidies,

extreme poverty in the pandemic years would have increased by 1.05 per cent.

The report said that poverty in the country declined the fastest during the period 2014 to 2019. The report also stated that social safety net provided by the expansion of country's food subsidy programme absorbed a major part of the pandemic shock. This illustrates the robustness of India's social safety architecture as it withstood one of the world's biggest income shocks. (Source: india.gov.in)

Govt. intends to establish more research centres in the country to support the research of ISRO: Minister

New Delhi, April 6 (PIB) Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh today gave the details of the upcoming ISRO space missions planned in 2022 in a written reply to a question in the Lok Sabha as follows:

> 2 Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV) missions including 1 dedicated commercial mission and 1 mission for launching the EOS-06 Earth Observation Satellite.

> 2 developmental flights of ISRO's Small Satellite Launch Vehicle (SSLV).

> 1 Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle (GSLV) mission for launching NVS-01 navigation satellite for NavIC

> 1 communication satellite mission (GSAT-24) through procured launch for commercial customer

> 1 Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle - Mark III (GSLV Mk-III) mission, which is a dedicated commercial mission.

Dr Jitendra Singh also informed that Government intends to establish more Research Centres in the country to support the research of ISRO. He added that existing Space Technology Incubation Centre, Regional Academia Centre for Space will get a grant of Rs. 200 lakhs per year maximum and new proposed cells also will adopt the same guidelines.

India at number three in world in terms of unicorns; 99 unicorns registered so far in the country

New Delhi, April 6 (PIB) Minister of Science and Technology, Dr Jitendra Singh today said that the country is now at number three in the world in terms of unicorns. He said till yesterday there were 99 unicorns in the country. Replying to a question in the Lok Sabha Dr Jitendra Singh said that Government is reaching out to the startups in the country and doing startup hunt instead for waiting for them to approach the Ministry for funding. Dr Singh informed that the Government has funded 10600 startup projects in the last 8 years from 2014 to 2022. He said that since 2016 around 67 thousand startup projects have been registered with the Ministry. He informed the house that as part of Mission Technology innovation hubs have been established in reputed institutes across the country in advanced technologies. (Source: india.gov.in)

the prevalence of malnutrition and iron deficiency (anemia), providing knowledge, attitude and behaviour in relation to Sex and Reproductive Health (SRH), preventing substance misuse by increasing adolescent's awareness on the adverse effect of substance misuse and promoting behavioural change in adolescent to prevent non communicable diseases.

According to information received from the Directorate of Health Services, Weekly Iron and Folic Acid Supplementation (WIFS) Programme is being carried out regularly to meet the challenge of high prevalence and incidence of anemia amongst adolescent girls and boys. The programme involves distribution of one Iron and Folic Acid (IFA) tablet a week to all adolescent girls and boys (10 to 19 years of age), both in school and out of school along with biannual de-worming (February and August every year). The IFA and de-worming tablets are being distributed through the school for school going students and through field health functionaries for non-school going girls and boys on monthly basis. The weekly Iron and Folic Acid Supplementation is provided to school students. The total number of children who have benefitted from Rashtriya Kishor Swasthya Karyakram in A&N Island upto December 2021 is 52591.

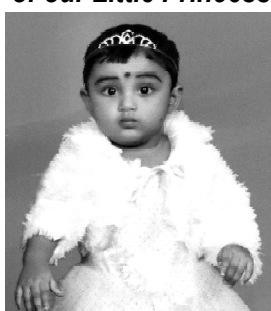

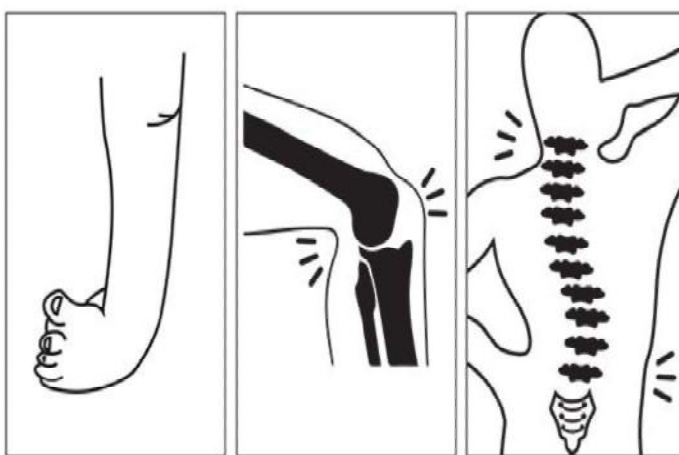
