### Malayalam cinema 1980

The 1980s and 90s were a fertile period for the Malayalam film industry. A new crop of directors and scriptwriters who were willing to experiment with new narrative styles and a middle-class audience had emerged. John Paul, 72, who passed away last week in Kochi, was an important voice of this school of cinema. Paul wrote close to a hundred screenplays in a four-decade long career, which were directed by a new generation of directors who made their mark in the 1980s and thereafter — Bharathan, Mohan, I V Sasi, Balu Mahendra, Satyan Anthikad, Sibi Malayil, Kamal. A majority of these — among them Chamaram, Marmaram, Ormmakkayi, Palangal, Athirathram, Revathikkoru Pavakkutty, Yatra, Oru Minnaminunginte Nuringuvettam, Unnikale Oru Kathaparamayam and Chamayam — were both critical successes and box-office hits. Along with M T Vasudevan Nair and Padmarajan, script writer-directors, Paul wrote some of the best remembered roles in Malayalam cinema in the 1980s — Gopi in Revathikkoru Pavakkutty and Sandhya Mayangum Neram, Nedumudi Venu in Ormmakkayi and Vidaparam Munpe, Murali in Chamayam, Mammootty in Yatra, Zarina Wahab in Chamaram, Mohan Lal in Unnikale Oru Kathaparamayam. A banker by profession, passionate about literature and active in the film society movement, Paul had become a scriptwriter in 1980 by accident. Most of his scripts had a tender love story as their core. They resonated with the moral world of middle-class Malayalis, who embraced these films. In the last few years, Paul had few films and he had turned to writing and TV talks. The world of 1980s Malayalam cinema comes alive in the dozen or so books he wrote. Like most of the heroes he created, Paul was a much loved person in the industry who walked into the sunset with few complaints. - Source : Indianexpress.com

# PRASHANT KISHOR HAS NO ASSOCIATION WITH I-PAC: K.T. RAMA RAO

The suspense over some Congress leaders as the Prashant Kishor's future role in the Congress has been continuing. On Sunday, the saga saw a twist after it emerged Kishor had held talks with TRS president and Telangana Chief Minister K. Chandrasekhar Rao. On Monday, news emerged the TRS had entered into a tie-up with Kishor's political consultancy, Indian Political Action Committee (I-PAC).

The news of the I-PAC deal with TRS had caused concern among



Since Monday, K.T. Rama Rao, the son of K. Chandrasekhar Rao, has been giving statements seeking to differentiate between Kishor and I-PAC. Rama Rao, who is a minister in his father's government, is considered one of the most influential leaders of the TRS.

K.T. Rama Rao told ANI the Congress was a "redundant institution". He told ANI "The people of India gave them a chance to rule for more than 50 years in the last 75 years. The country has been let down by Congress and the BJP. Congress particularly is a party that has been tried, tested and dusted. I don't see any future in

Congress."

When asked whether Kishor would facilitate an alliance between the TRS and Congress, Rama Rao said "I believe that Congress does not have a future. That party was part of history and will remain history. It has no future. If it has no future, then how can I say that we would work with them? What happens in the future, we will see."

K.T. Rama Rao told Republic TV that his party had tied up with I-PAC, and not Kishor. "If you look at the entire political spectrum, every single political party in the country has aligned with one agency or the other. And we have chosen to ally with I-PAC. Now Prashant Kishor and what he chooses to do as an individual in the political

landscape, that's his personal decision. But in my humble opinion, at this point in time, the political institution, which he is purportedly joining which I am not aware of is certainly a sinking ship, so I don't know," Rama Rao told Republic TV.

Rama Rao declared there was no "conflict of interest" in tying up with I-PAC. He told Republic TV "This is not the first time we have had discussions with Prashant Kishor. We have met several times during the last several years. Myself, the honourable Chief Minister, we have met him several times. So, it is nothing new for us. And secondly, we have chosen now to work with an agency that he has no association with. Where is the conflict of interest?" - Source : Theweek

### CS directs Labour ...

Veer Savarkar International Airport and Harbours in order to verify the workers arriving in the Islands. With the commencement of the process, more than 150 workers have been verified and registered in three days time. The entire process is being carried out by the Labour Department in collaboration with the DC Office and Police Department. The A&N Islands are witnessing huge developmental projects and sufficient local labour force is not available in the Islands. Under such situation, the labour force has to come from rest of India for taking up the developmental works. With an aim to secure the Islands while getting labourers, it is important to register & verify each workers and tenants. The Islanders are requested to be cautious while engaging any unverified tenant or workers in their Residences or Establishment. This is very important for the future of the Islands, which is going to be the centre of growth in South East Asia. In this regard, the first exercise of verification and registration has been started on April 23, 2022. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration noted that the Village Register System of 1999 has fallen into complete disuse. The aim is not to restrict outsider, but the aim is to regulate, reorganise, re-orient them and at the same time labourers shall be getting various benefits under Labour Acts. Benefits of Registration & Skill

Development will be honed through continuous training and will be extended welfare schemes of the Department. A lot of effort in this regard has been done by Shri Hari Kalikatt, Secretary (Labour) and Shri R.L. Rishi, Labour Commissioner with the help of Police Personnel and the Airport Authority of India. The ITF Ground will be presently used for this purpose until a new building has been setup for this purpose. On an average 50-100 migrant Labourers are arriving in the Islands every day. The Principal Employers/Contractors whether in civil or defence must act responsibly and shall keep a vigil on every workers. It is seen that since 2004, people before elections come through contractors and post completion of work, these workers are dumped and the workers stay back in the lookout for other jobs. These workers have Aadhaar and other ID proofs from various parts of Bengal and this being a serious issue, all Islanders shall co-operate, co-ordinate in verifying every workers and every tenant which is compulsory and not a choice. Meanwhile, a meeting has been convened by the Labour Department with all Principal Employers/Construction agencies wherein it was directed that all Principal Employers including those in Central Sphere as well as Defence Establishments must remit Cess deducted on time to Labour Department, A&N Administration, failing which,

Penalty Provision as laid down under Section 12 of Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Cess Act, 1996 shall be invoked which provides for imprisonment which may extend upto 06 months or fine of Rs. 1000/- or with both. The Principal Employer is also responsible for obtaining necessary Registration and Licenses under Inter State Migrant Workers Act, 1979 wherever applicable. The Section 6 of Inter State Migrant Workers Act, 1979 stipulates that "No Principal employer of establishment to which this Act applies shall employ Inter-State Migrant Workmen in the establishment unless a certificate of registration in respect of such establishment issued under this Act is in force".

In case of non-compliance, the penalty provision under Sec-25 of Inter State Migrant Workers Act, 1979 which provides for imprisonment of 01 (one) year or fine of Rs. 1000/- or with both shall be invoked against Principal Employer. It was directed that all Principal Employers/Contractors should obtain necessary registration and licenses under respective labour laws in order to ensure welfare and safety of migrant worker and also register their workers with Labour Deptt., A&N Administration. All Principal Employers have been asked to submit details of all ongoing works including details of workers engaged for the purpose before the Labour Commissioner, A&N Islands.

## CBSE EXAM FOR CLASS XII & CLASS X

### 4793 students to appear in Class XII while 5780 students

Port Blair, April 26: The Education Department has made all arrangements to monitor and ensure smooth conduct of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) examinations for Class XII and X through offline mode in A&N Islands. The AISSCE (Class XII) will commence with Beauty & Wellness as first paper on April 26. However, the first major paper for Class 12 is Hindi which is scheduled to be held on May 2. The students of

AISSCE (Class X) will have English paper on April 27. The Class XII exam ends on June 15 with subject Psychology while Class X exam ends on May, 24, 2022 with subject Information Technology. This year, the number of regular candidates likely to appear in AISSCE (Class XII) is 4793, while in AISSCE (Class X) 5780 students will take AISSCE Board exam as regular candidates. Altogether, 52 Examination Centres have been identified to facilitate

students of AISSCE and AISCSE appearing from this UT including the private candidates. **CIRCULAR**

**WHEREAS**, vide Office Order No. 2388 dated 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2021 of the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, the competency of authorities for sanction of leave/duty cum tour as also leave of all type to Mainland and inter-islands is prescribed.

**WHEREAS**, it has been observed that that in the Panchayati Raj Institutions, there has been a practice of according of leave and station leaving permission by the respective PRI heads such as Pradhan, Pramukh and Adhykash for the officers/officials working under their respective establishment. The instance is followed for the staffs of other departments devolved to the each tier of PRIs.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Secretary (RD/Panchayat) in accordance to the above order of the administration hereby issues the following instructions for strict adherence by all concerned.

1. All leave/station leaving permission of Officers/Officials attached to Panchayati Raj Institutions shall be governed by the Order No. 2388 dated 02<sup>nd</sup> November, 2021 and amendment made to thereunder.
2. The leave/station leaving permission in respect of devolved/sub-ordinate officials of the Gram Panchayat viz. VLW, GRS, MTS etc. shall be duly forwarded to the Directorate of RD, PRIs and ULBs by the Panchayat Secretary.
3. The monthly attendance statement of the officials as mentioned at S.No. 02 shall be duly signed by the Panchayat Secretary and submitted to the Block Development Officer.
4. The leave/station leaving permission in respect of Panchayat Secretary shall be duly forwarded to the Directorate of RD, PRIs and ULBs by the Block Development Officer concerned.
5. The monthly attendance statement of the officials as mentioned of Panchayat Secretaries shall be duly signed by the Block Development Officer and be submitted to the Directorate.
6. All leave applications is required to be submitted in advance as per the administration circular.
7. The duty cum tour of the Officials shall be only made as per the approval of Directorate of RD, PRIs and ULBs.

Further, no extension/removal/appointment of staffs on Daily rated basis will be made by the Panchayati Raj Institutions without the approval of the competent authority.

## Future uncertain, says Twitter CEO Agrawal after Musk acquires company

Twitter CEO Parag Agrawal told employees of Twitter that the future of the social media firm is uncertain after the deal to be taken private under billionaire Elon Musk closes, reported Reuters. "Once the deal closes, we don't know which direction the platform will go," Agrawal said at a town hall.

Musk has reached an agreement to acquire Twitter for approximately \$44 billion.

The outspoken Tesla CEO, the world's wealthiest person, has said he wants to buy Twitter because he thinks it's not living up to its potential as a platform for

"free speech." He says it needs to be transformed as a private company in order to build trust with users and do better at serving what he calls the "societal imperative" of free speech.

Twitter said it will become a privately held company after the deal is closed.

"Twitter has a purpose and relevance that impacts the entire world," Agrawal said in a tweet. "Deeply proud of our teams and inspired by the work that has never been more important."

# How to control invasive rats and mice at home without harming native wildlife

As I write this article, a furry blur of a rodent has just scampered across the room and under the couch. It's autumn in Australia and, as air temperatures plunge outside, rodents start seeking the warmth and plentiful food inside our houses.

This is a familiar experience for many of us, whether it's a mouse in your house, or rats invading your chicken cage or eating the fruit from your trees.

In fact, a study last year found rodents have cost the global economy up to US\$35.53 billion between 1930 and 2018, largely due to the damage they inflict on farms.

Farmers along Australia's east coast know this all too well. The rodent problem can amplify to plague proportions following wet years and warmer than average minimum temperatures.

Having personally experienced a mouse plague while staying on the Nullarbor, I can attest that these are horrible experiences. The economic losses are huge and the unrelenting waves of mice day and night are horrifying for those who have to live with them, sometimes for months.

Last year's plague resulted in a proposal to drop the poison bromadiolone over large parts of eastern Australia. Had it been successful, it would have significantly harmed non-target species of native wildlife such as owls, goannas and quolls, which our research has shown are highly vulnerable to a range of rodenticides as they travel up the food chain.

Indeed, I'm often asked by people grappling with invasive rodents how best to manage them without harming native wildlife. So, here's some advice.

## Mechanical traps

Use them indoors only

Sometimes old-fashioned is best. The snap traps you might remember from your childhood are still a highly effective way of removing pesky rodents from your home. Just keep them away from the exploring toes of children and pets! Some newer plastic traps with pivoting jaws that close on the mouse are, in my experience, less effective and can risk injuring but not killing the mouse. I've had several experiences of traps being dragged away by a mouse caught only by a leg.

A new entry to the Australian market is a type of mechanical trap, the A24. It's self-resetting with a scent-based lure and can kill 24 mice or rats on one canister. These, however, are not suitable for use outside in areas with native wildlife. I recently had an horrific experience of a native quenda (bandicoot) killed by one of these traps set on my bush property. I was devastated and, after

deploying a monitoring camera on the deactivated trap, I found possums at grave risk from this type of trap, too.

These traps don't seem to discriminate invasive rodents from native wildlife and are known to kill native birds, rabbits and hedgehogs in New Zealand. Governments need to reconsider the ethics and conservation implications of such traps in Australia. It is my view that no mechanical traps should be set outside the home or shed where there's risk to native wildlife.

The Conversation asked Goodnature, which manufactures A24 traps, whether it is taking steps to address this issue.

Goodnature co-founder and industrial designer Craig Bond said the traps' threat to



native animals is ideally mitigated by the overall benefit to nature. He said the company is working on preventative measures such as warning users, through various means, about reducing risks to native wildlife. Bond went on: "We can and do put processes in place to mitigate and hopefully empower our trappers. And we have employed staff with the requisite expertise to do that. However [I] we can be more proactive in our warnings regarding the risk to non-target species. The issue in the past has not been widespread but [we] understand that Australia is a particularly vulnerable environment."

Bond said Goodnature was keen to learn more about reducing the risks its traps might pose to native Australian wildlife.

## Electric traps

Effective and humane

These are battery-powered rat and mouse traps that work by delivering a fatal shock to rodents once they make contact with the two plates in the trap.

These are highly effective and very humane because upon touching two plates, a fatal electric shock is administered, instantly stopping the heart. Though not cheap, I swear by these traps as they catch and kill quickly using a bait of your choice, such as peanut butter. There is minimal risk of impacts to non-

target animals in the home.

But again they definitely should not be used where native wildlife could enter the trap. The traps are usually labelled as being not for outdoor use and this advice should be followed.

Some live traps are inhumane, such as glue traps, which comprise sticky boards to capture rodents that walk over them. These traps are not recommended under any circumstances. Glue traps are not only cruel as it can take days for the animal to die, but they do not discriminate. Unless contained and used carefully, they have a high risk of catching reptiles, birds or other non-target species.

## Poisoned baits

Best for industrial and broadscale use

Despite the risk to non-target animals, baits will always be needed for large scale rodent problems, such as mouse plagues. However, they are not humane as animals die slowly by blood loss over an average of 7.2 days and have the most potential for poisoning other species.

In Australia, it's almost always unnecessary to use so-called second-generation baits such as brodifacoum. These baits are made in response to rodents developing resistance to some chemical formulations, and require only one feed to be fatal.

The active ingredients in second generation baits have a very long persistence time in the liver of animals that eat them, resulting in widespread secondary poisoning along the food chain.

It's also important to remember that baits must be deployed according to manufacturer's instructions. Too often I hear stories of people throwing wax baits or grain baits into their gardens.

This is horrifying given the direct access this provides to possums, bandicoots, birds, small children and pets. Most baits should be deployed in bait holders that prevent exposure to non-target species.

## Pest management is holistic

We should recognise that pest management is a holistic activity. Relying on any one technique is unlikely to be sufficient. Rodent-proofing your house, shed or grain silos as much as possible is essential in the war against pests. This might include sealing water and power inlets, holes in skirting boards and gaps or holes in grain storage facilities.

On a commercial scale, investing in modern vermin-proof facilities such as sealed grain silos and blocking all possible gaps, may well balance out the long-term expense of baiting. They certainly come with a much reduced risk to native wildlife.

## Covaxin, Corbevax, ZyCoV-D Get DCGI Green Signal for Kids

New Delhi, 26<sup>th</sup> Apr, 2022: In the wake of schools reporting a spike in coronavirus cases among children, the Drugs Controller General of India (DCGI) has approved the restricted emergency use of three vaccines for different age groups of children - Bharat Biotech's Covaxin, Biological E's Corbevax and Zydus Cadila's ZyCoV-D. Covaxin has received the emergency use authorisation (EUA) for the age group of 6 to

12 years olds, while for Corbevax it is the 5 to 12 years old age group. ZyCoV-D, meanwhile, has received the nod to vaccinated children aged above 12. India, at present, is administering two vaccines to children above the age of 12 groups of children - Covaxin and Bharat Biotech's Covaxin. The first phase of vaccination for children, aged 15 to 18, started on January 3. The vaccination was later extended to children aged above 12 on March 16.



# Khelo India Youth Games 2021 to be held from June 4 to June 13

CHANDIGARH: Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar on Tuesday said the Khelo India Youth Games 2021, which were postponed multiple times due to the Covid-19 pandemic, will be organised in the state from June 4 to June 13.
