Healthcare in disarray at GB Pant Hospital

Sans CT Scan, appropriate treatment; 25 yr old loses life after fall from 4th floor of flat at Dollygunj

claims, delivery of effective health services remains far from ensured at the lone referral hospital here. In another glaring instance of deficient service at the hospital, a 25 year service at the nospital, a 25 year old youth lost his life after a fatal fall from the fourth floor of a building at Shiv Colony in Dollyguny. The deceased, a native of Madhupur, Diglipur in North Andaman, was allegedly not provided timely medical attention by the health officials at the GB Pant Hospital after the incident that occurred on December 1, 2021

The deceased, Mithun Das, accidenty fell from the fourth floor of his residence at around 8 am on Dec 1. He was immediately shifted to GB Pant Hospital for treatment. In the absence of a Radiologist, CT

doctors attending the patient recommended an X-Ray to ascertain the extent of injuries sustained in the mishap. Official procedures such a record entry of procedures such a record entry of the patient was done on a mobile phone and the preliminary treatment of the patient started. Subsequently on Dec 2, the patient was referred to Amrita Hospital for a CT Scan where family members were charged Rs 8000/-forthe scan. The CT Scan report w as forwarded to the GB Pant Hospital, but the patient slipped into comaon the next day. The condition of the patient showed some improvement and family members are prepared to airlift the patient to mainland for specialized medical care. Unfortunately the patient succumbed to injuries on the

Lack of technical staff a defunct equipments is taking a tol on patients at the lone referra hospital. Ev en basic facilities like CT Scan is not available in the hospital. My brother was deprived of CT Scan and doctors carried out of CT Scan and doctors carried out treatment on the basis of X-Ray. After the CT Scandone from Amrita Hospital, my brother slipped into coma. His condition improv ed to some extent, but delay in completion of official formalities completion or official formalities prevented us from shifting him to mainland. New Delhi, 7th Dec, 2021: After the two recent cases of the Omicron variant of Cov id-19 reported in Mumbai on Monday, the tally ofthe new coronavirus variant has reached to 23 in the country. Omicron Covid variant reportedly reached India as two cases were reported in Karnataka first The third case was reported in Jamnagar of Gujarat and another in

Later, 7 cases were reported in Maharashtra, of which six belonged to the same family. These include a Nigerian woman, 44, of Indian origin, and her two daughters

arriving in Pune from Lagos, and another man who recently paid visito Finland. Also, the 45-year old brother of the 44-year old woman and his two children were infected and tested positive for Omicron, and all sev en are under treatment at a

hospital.

Ahmedabad fire

At least 60 persons were burnt to death in a blaze that gutted a jute and wooden replica of the Himalayas set up for a religious exhibition outside the Neelkantha Mahadev to a religious exhaultar outside the reternation management that exhaults management to the labour suburb of Asarwa. According to police sources, the victims include 14 women, 17 men and 14 children. The blaze, believed to have been caused by a short circuit, trapped nearly 200 people inside the exhibition and reduced to ashes the entire 60-ft high structure in less than seven minutes. Chief Minister Madhavsinh Solanki and Home Minister Prabodh Raval visited the site. The state government has ordered a magisterial inquiry into the fire, the worst witnessed in the city

The Reserve Bank of India's Monetary Policy Committee began its bi-monthly meeting on Monday. This meeting comes at a time the world is on edge after the discovery of a new variant of COVID-19. Equity markets have been rattled by the Omicron variantand the impactit could have on eeconomy.

They have further pulled out Rs 11,079 crore in the first seven day s of December. For the full y ear 2021, FPIs are still net buyers to the tune of Rs 68.712 crore, although lower than the Rs 1.03 lakh crore they investedin 2020.

growth has picked up in the last few months. But, while retail credit growth is strong, corporate/investment credit remains tenid Consumer em and is picking up but is patchy; wo-wheeler sales, for instance, have been lacklustre. Violating crypto rules in India could lead to arrest without warrant: Report

cryptocurrency regulation bill could resultin hefty penalties forviolators:
