

Requisite RFQ applications received for setting up Luxury Eco Resort at Aves Island

Project to kick start Eco Tourism based economy in North & Middle Andaman

Port Blair, Dec. 4

Request for Qualification (RFQ) for setting up of the luxury tents at Aves Island was invited by ANIIDCO and the last date for submission of RFQ application was on 29.11.2021. Requisite number of RFQ applications have been received which are being evaluated for next stage. Eligible RFQ applicants shall be issued Request for Proposal (RFP) for submission of financial bid after approval of Standing Finance Committee (SFC), Govt. of India.

Aves, a small uninhabited island with coconut grove, pristine beach, coral reef and a lighthouse is in the advanced stages of being



developed as a luxury glamping and camping tourist destination. The Islands Development Agency (IDA) in coordination with NITI Aayog had identified Aves Island as one of the islands in A&N Islands for holistic development. A land parcel measuring 2.75 hectares at Aves Island had been identified for setting up of a luxury tented

resort. The MoEF&CC has already granted CRZ and Forest Clearance for the project with certain conditions. The upcoming resort at Aves Island shall have a total of 50 rooms with an estimated project cost of Rs. 36 crores. The resort shall offer various activities like scuba diving, snorkelling, indoor & outdoor sports, nature trail &

treks, etc. besides offering world class service.

The construction material of the project will be eco-friendly and/or pre-cast/pre-fabricated concrete with minimal use of RCC. The concessionaire will be required to meet the latest development standards prescribed by GRIHA/LEED/Green Globe and star categorization by Ministry of Tourism, Govt. of India. This self sustainable project will also include development of trunk infrastructure like Desalination Plant, Rain Water Treatment Plant, Solar Power Plant, DG Set, STP, etc. by the concessionaire.

The Ministry of Labour & Employment, New Delhi has launched a registration module/portal i.e. e-SHRAM for creation of a comprehensive National Database of Unorganized Workers (NDUW) for all types of Unorganized Workers such as construction workers, migrant workers, domestic workers, agricultural labourers, MGNREGA workers, Gig workers, self-employed workers, street vendors, shop keepers, ASHA workers, anganwadi workers, fishermen, unorganized plantation workers, milkmen and similar other sub-group of Unorganized Workers to extend various Social Security benefits.

The Social Security benefits



provided are:

- e-SHRAM card received after registration will be accepted across the country.
- Accidental insurance coverage through PMSBY for a year.
- Rs. 2 lakhs in case of accidental death and permanent disability and Rs. 1 lakh in case of partial disability.
- Social Security benefits will be delivered through e-SHRAM Portal.
- Helpful for Central & State

Government while providing assistance during calamities/pandemic.

Any unorganized worker can get registered on e-SHRAM Portal by Self Registration or visiting nearest CSC.

The Labour Department has set up Facilitation Centre in the Office of Labour Commissioner, Supply Line so as to facilitate the unorganized workers to get them registered on e-SHRAM Portal.

In A & N Islands, as on Nov. 29, 2021, the total registration has crossed 8,050 and 59% are female workers while 20% workers belongs to construction sector, 17% workers belongs to agriculture sector and the remaining are domestic,

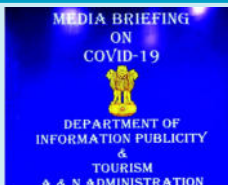
Media briefed on COVID-19

No positive case detected during RAT conducted on incoming flight & inter Island bound passengers: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Dec.4

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar while giving information on COVID-19 status stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 394 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected.

Today, 12 flights arrived, out of which, 1825 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted



conducted on 85 passengers and no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 68 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. At helipad, 9 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. Today, till 3 pm, 371 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 344 were in the age group of 18-44.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Small-scale aquaponic model for fish and plant production

Aquaculture diversification practices are the need of the hour towards the path of sustainability and resilience in the archipelago of Andaman and Nicobar. Commercial freshwater fish farming remains a niche area for development with a scope for better market and local demand. However, the sector is mostly relying on pond-based farming which in turn is already facing range of issues such as seed unavailability, improper feeding practices, water scarcity at times, etc. In this background a small-scale recirculatory aquaponic unit was developed and the unit basically functions as a zero-water exchange model which can be used a backyard farming model as well as for recreational purposes for culture of ornamental fishes in indoor conditions. The model basically employs the culture of candidate ornamental fishes such as silver barb, gold fishes and koi carps along with plants such as Broad dhaniya. The nutrient rich water from the rectangular FRP fish tanks is pumped and used as a natural fertilizer for plants and in turn the plants raised in gravels helps in filtering and purifying the water and recirculates the water back to the fish culture unit. The culture model can generate better income with the culture of candidate ornamental fishes such as Gold fish and Koi carps which has lucrative market demand in the Islands and are also highly preferred by aquarium hobbyist. The plants and fishes can be harvested seasonally and can be utilized for domestic purposes as well as sale in local market.

Benefit: The unit can be a recreational model as well as small-scale commercial model for production of ornamental fishes as well as plants. The system involves zero water exchange and can be best suited for Island conditions.

India vs NZ 2nd Test match: India leads by 332 runs

India 69/0 at stumps

Mumbai, Dec. 4

In the second and final Cricket Test match between India and New Zealand, in Mumbai, on day two, at stumps, India was 332 runs ahead of visitors. In the second innings hosts were 69, with opener Mayank Agarwal 38 and Cheteshwar Pujara 29 runs on the crease. Earlier, the visitors were all out on 62 runs in their first i n n i n g . R a v i c h a n d r a n Ashwin took four wickets. India were all out for 325 in their first innings on the



second day today. The hosts won the toss and opted to bat. Mayank Agarwal's magnificent century was the highlight of the Indian innings. He went on to contribute 150 runs. While, Ajaz Patel, took all ten wickets for the visitors. The 33-years old bowler became the third in the history of Test cricket to achieve this feat. English Pacer Jim Laker recorded the feat in 1956 and Indian Spinner Anil Kumble achieved the milestone in 1999.

Over 126 crore 53 lakh doses of COVID vaccines administered in country so far

New Delhi, Dec. 4

Over 126 crore 53 lakh doses of COVID vaccines have been administered in the country so far under the Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Union Health Ministry today said, more than 73 lakh 63 thousand vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours. The Ministry said, eight thousand 190 COVID patients recovered during the same period and the recovery rate stands at 98.35 percent. The country reported eight thousand 603 new COVID cases in the last 24 hours. Currently, India's active caseload is 99 thousand 974. (Source: india.gov.in)

New Delhi, Dec. 4

Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Minister, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar has said that the Government has taken a multi pronged approach to increase the farmer's income in the country. In a written reply in the Rajya Sabha yesterday, the Minister said, the G o v e r n m e n t announces Minimum Support Price (MSP) to ensure remunerative prices to the growers for their produce and encourage higher investment and production. He said, over 894 lakh metric tonnes of paddy procured on MSP for Kharif Marketing Season 2020-21 benefitting over 131 lakh farmers in the country. He said, over 433 lakh metric tonnes of wheat procured for Rabi Marketing Season 2021-22, benefitting over 49 Lakh farmers. He added that the Government through its nodal agencies has procured 8.37 lakh metric tonnes of Pulses and Oilseeds benefitting over five lakh farmers. Shri Tomar said, the Government has been implementing various schemes to increase the farmers' income. These schemes include Soil Health Card, Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi, Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana, e-NAM, Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana and Pradhan Mantri Annadata Aay Sanrakshan Abhiyan among others.
