## COVID-19 status in A & N Islands

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 215 incoming flight passengers who arrived here yesterday, six positive cases have been detected. Today, 12 flights with 1782 passengers arrived, out of which, 1539 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 211 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 44

passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, one positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 65 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 46 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus and no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

New Delhi, June 23

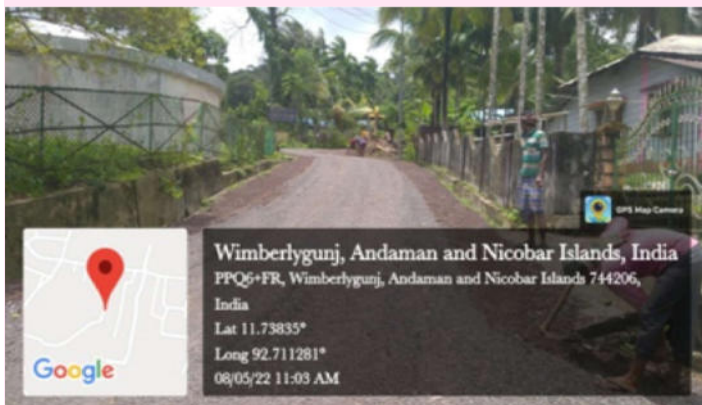

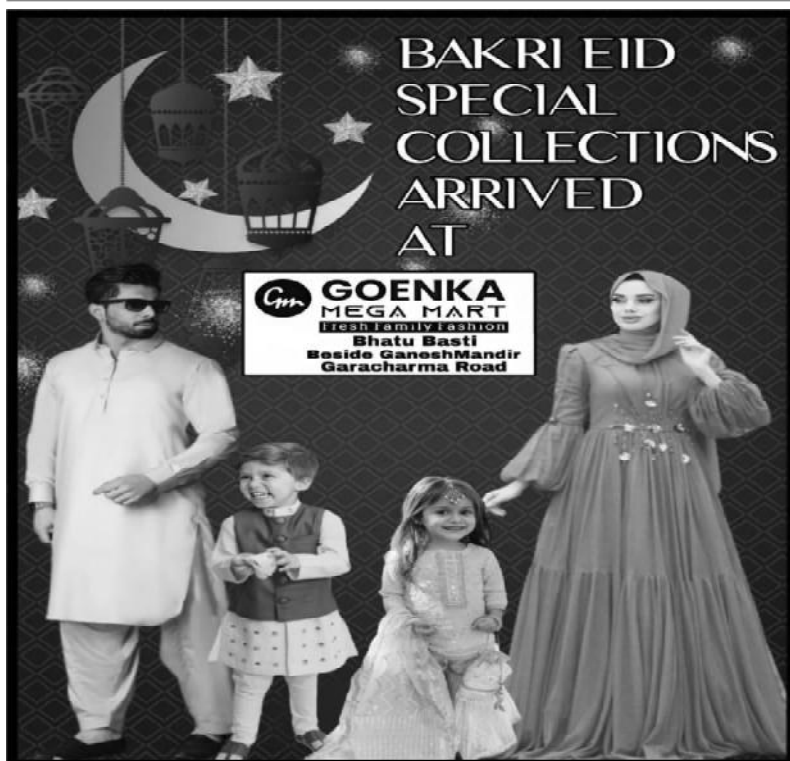
