The approved scheme of Govt. of India 'Up-scaling Aapda Mitra Scheme' is at a total cost of Rs. 369.41 crore and will be funded from Preparedness and Capacity Building Funding Window of National Disaster



Response Fund. The scheme will be implemented by National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) in partnership with State/UT Governments and State Disaster Management Authorities. The scheme focuses on training of 1,00,000 community

Diglipur, Sept. 19

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS arrived at Diglipur this morning on a four-day visit to North & Middle Andaman District. On arrival at the V.S Pally Helipad, the Chief Secretary was accorded a warm welcome by the Deputy Commissioner, N&M Andaman, Dr. Satyendra Singh Dursawat, IAS. The Adhyaksha, Zilla Parishad, North & Middle Andaman, Ms Elizabeth, Up-Prumukh, Shri Mahadev Gain, PRI members, senior officers of A&N Administration, Heads of Department of North & Middle Andaman and others were also present.

Soon after arrival, the Chief Secretary held a meeting with the public representatives and Heads of Office in the conference hall of APWD guest house. The public representatives put forth their issues and aspirations related to sectors such as road, water, education, agriculture, revenue, civil aviation, electricity, shipping, rural



development etc.

The Chief Secretary gave a patient hearing to the grievances and allowed all the PRI members present in the conference hall to put forth their grievances one by one and also emphasized the need for participatory management.

Responding to the grievances regarding poor condition of roads in Diglipur area, the Chief Secretary, at the outset, expressed his concern over the condition of roads in

Diglipur. He instructed the senior officers of APWD to hold a meeting with PRIs today itself and prepare an exhaustive list of roads to be repaired with tentative timelines in consultation with elected representatives. He also directed to follow up all the pending approvals and kick start all the repair works.

The Chief Secretary urged the officers to give patient hearing to the grievances of the PRIs and resolve their



genuine demands to the maximum possible. He instructed the Heads of Department to make regular field visits to understand the problems of the people. He instructed the DC N&M to conduct monthly interaction and review meeting about the progress of the projects so that people at large are benefitted. Water supply & distribution issues raised by the PRIs were also discussed in detail and the senior officers of APWD were asked to

prepare a comprehensive list in consultation with the PRIs and submit an action plan.

Responding to the demands to renovate the dilapidated school buildings, the Chief Secretary instructed the Director of Education to visit schools and prepare a list of the school which needs urgent repair so that improvement of school building can be taken up immediately. The Chief Secretary

Islands, targeting to train 300 community volunteers under the scheme. The training will be imparted by the Directorate of Disaster Management, Indian Coast Guard (A&N) and National Disaster Response Force, 4th Btl. Arakkonam Tamil Nadu stationed at Port Blair.

In his inaugural address, Shri Nikhil Kumar, IAS, Commissioner-cum-Secretary (DM&RR) who was the chief guest explained about the vulnerability profile of A&N Islands towards Earthquake and Cyclone prone area and other hazards and stressed upon the active participation of the voluntary task force in the training, so as to prepare themselves to fight with any disaster situation as first responders in the community level. He informed that after the enactment of Disaster Management Act, 2005, the A&N Administration created a statutory body of UT Disaster Management Authority, UT Disaster Management Executive Committee, District Disaster Management Authorities, State Emergency Operation Centre, Emergency Operation Centres and Control Rooms of line Departments in different Islands with state of art communication facilities towards disaster preparedness and management in ANI. The A&N Administration in coordination of National Disaster Management Authority prepared the State Disaster Management Plan, District Disaster Management Plans in accordance with the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Standard Operating Procedures of each line Departments, he said and all the SEOC and EOCs are functioning round the clock. He also urged all participants to actively participate in the training programme and remarked that a trained and prepared mind will only save lives professionally and effectively.

Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Secretary (DM&RR), A&N Administration welcoming the gathering briefed about the Aapda Mitra Scheme and its implementation in A&N Islands. He said that, the scheme aims to provide community volunteers with the basic skills, they will require for responding to their community's immediate needs during and in the aftermath of a disaster. These trained volunteers can assist in saving lives using the basic techniques of disaster response, coordination and management. He also sought the cooperation and participation of all stakeholders in making this training a successful one. The inaugural session concluded with vote of thanks proposed by Shri Gyan Singh, Asst. Director (Logistics), DDM.

This was followed by a technical session during which Shri TKS. Ajayan Asst. Director (Ops), DDM briefed about self-preparedness, basic concept of Disaster Management, vulnerability profile, mitigation process towards Natural and Hydro-meteorological disaster and tips to save themselves and others in the community. Shri Deen Mohammed, Safety Officer touched upon Disaster Phases and nature of resilient community disaster preparedness measures, preparedness plan and early warning system in ANI. 10MT and Containerized Ice Plant of 5 MT is under construction at FLC, Junglighat. Ms Iti Agarwal, Director of Fisheries inspected the site of both the projects to take first hand information on the progress of the project. The pre-fab cold storage unit has already been installed and trial test by the supplier is in progress. Similarly, the package unit for Containerized Ice Plant has been brought from mainland and the process of installation is in progress. Both the projects are expected to be operational soon and this would facilitate availability of ice and storage facility for the fishermen operating their fishing crafts from Fish Landing Centre, Junglighat.

The Director also directed the officials for regulating movement of general public and vehicles by deploying security guards. To maintain hygiene and cleanliness in the campus, it was also decided that no parking of vehicles should be allowed inside the Fish Landing Centre. The vehicles entering the campus with ice and other materials should leave the fish landing jetty immediately after offloading. She also directed that the fishermen and vendors should be asked to stack the unserviceable items like ice boxes, damaged nets, engines etc in designated place only, a press release from Fisheries Department said.

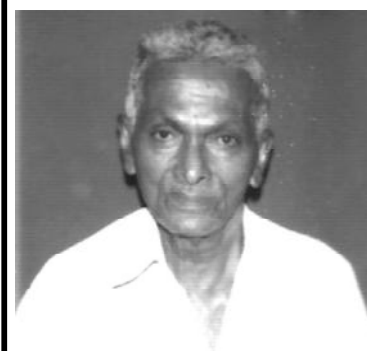

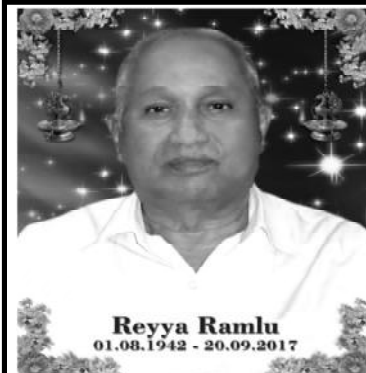
