

PM holds review meeting with districts having low vaccination coverage

"Develop micro strategies, keeping in mind the experience so far to go for saturation of vaccination by addressing the gaps at local level": PM

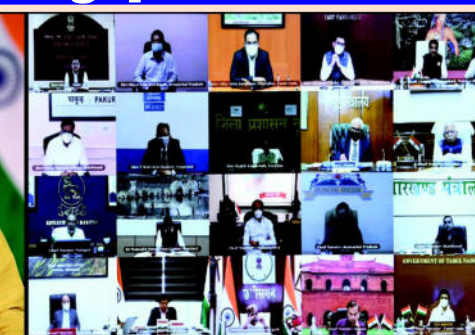
New Delhi, Nov. 3 (PIB)

Immediately after returning from his visit to Italy and Glasgow, the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi held a review meeting with districts having low vaccination coverage. The meeting included districts with less than 50% coverage of the first dose and low coverage of the second dose of Covid vaccine. The Prime Minister interacted with District Magistrates of over 40 districts in Jharkhand, Manipur, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, and other States with districts



having low vaccination coverage.

The District Magistrates gave an account of the issues and challenges being faced in their districts, which has resulted in low vaccination coverage. They highlighted issues like



rumours resulting in vaccine hesitancy, difficult terrain, challenges created due to prevailing weather conditions in recent months. They also presented an account of the steps that have been taken by them till now to overcome these

challenges. The DMs also shared good practises adopted by them which has led to increase in coverage. During the interaction, the Prime Minister discussed the issue of vaccine hesitancy and the local factors behind it in detail. He discussed

a wide array of ideas that can be implemented for ensuring 100% vaccination coverage in these districts. He spoke about maximising community engagement through religious and community leaders. He exhorted all officials to ensure that the country widens its vaccination coverage by the end of the year and enters the new year with renewed self belief and confidence.

The Union Health Secretary gave an overview of the vaccination coverage in

A total of 1211 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 962 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 81 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44

Chief Secretary, A&N Administration issues order to ensure compliance for Prompt & Effective Containment Measures for COVID-19 in A&N Islands in accordance with advisory issued by MoHFW

Port Blair, Nov. 3

An Order of Union Home Secretary was issued on 28th September, 2021 to ensure compliance with the Prompt & Effective Containment Measures for COVID-19 as conveyed by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) vide D.O. letter dated 21st Sept, 2021 which was extended for a period upto the 31st Oct, 2021 and in exercise of the powers conferred under section 10 (2) (1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Union Home Secretary and Chairman, National Executive Committee

(NEC) directs vide order of Ministry of Home Affairs, dated 28th Oct, 2021 to ensure compliance with the Prompt & Effective Containment Measures for COVID-19 as conveyed by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) vide D.O. letter 21st Sept, 2021 was further extended for a period upto 30th Nov, 2021.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 24 (1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Chief Secretary, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain in the

capacity as Chairperson, Union Territory Disaster Management Executive Committee, for the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands has ordered to ensure compliance for the Prompt & Effective Containment Measures for COVID-19 in accordance with the advisory issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) dated 21st September, 2021 shall continue to be strictly followed and shall remain in force up to 30th Nov, 2021 for the whole of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. In partial modification to Order No.1211 dt. 25th September 2021, in order to ensure containment measures of isolation and social distancing in the South Andaman District with continuous focus on the fivefold strategy for effective management of COVID-19 i.e., Test-Track-Treat-Vaccination and adherence to COVID appropriate behavior to control any surge of the cases of COVID-19

again and also to prevent any disturbance to the peace and tranquility and taking into consideration the request of the public representatives and general public, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, in exercise of the powers vested U/s 144 of Cr.P.C. has ordered that lockdown/restricted movement shall continue to be in force in the entire District of South Andaman and

Supreme Court takes strict cognizance on burning of firecrackers during Diwali & other festivals/occasions

DM (SA)/ DM Nicobar issue orders prohibiting use of fire crackers (carrying barium or other banned chemicals or mislabelled) except green crackers permitted by PESO

Port Blair, Nov. 3

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide W.P. (Civil) No. 728 of 2015 dated 23/10/2018 has taken strict cognizance on the issue of burning of firecrackers during Diwali and other festivals/occasion etc. The UT of Andaman and Nicobar Islands is facing air pollution and busting of fire crackers/fireworks has been identified as

one of the sources of air pollution and noise pollution and it may aggravate the situation and is harmful for senior citizens and small children.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has directed that green crackers permitted by PESO (Petroleum & Explosives Safety Organisation) are to be sold under valid

permission and any manufacturer, sale, purchase/possession or use of crackers (carrying barium or other banned chemicals or mislabelled) is completely prohibited.

The District Magistrate (South Andaman District), Shri Sunil Anchipaka and District Magistrate (Nicobar District), Shri Yash

the country. He gave an account of balance vaccine dose availability in the States, and also talked about special vaccination campaigns being run in the States to further improve vaccination coverage.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister thanked the Chief Ministers present and said that their attention will encourage the district to work with more determination. Shri Modi said in this biggest pandemic of the century, the country faced many challenges. He said "one special thing in the country's fight against Corona was that we found new solutions and tried innovative methods". He urged the administrators to work more on new innovative ways to increase vaccination in their districts. He conveyed that even the better performing districts had similar challenges but they were met with determination and innovation. He asked the officials to develop micro strategies, keeping in mind the experience so far to go for saturation of vaccination by addressing the gaps at local level. The Prime Minister asked the district officials to make different strategies for each village, each town in the districts, if need be. He suggested this can be done by forming a team of 20-25 people depending on the region. He also suggested trying to have a healthy competition in the teams that you have formed. Exhorting the officials to prepare region-wise timetables for local goals, the Prime Minister said "You will have to do your best to take your districts nearer the national average."

The Prime Minister touched upon the issue of rumours and misunderstanding about vaccination. He suggested awareness is the only solution for this and asked the state officials to take help from the religious leaders. The Prime Minister noted that religious leaders are very enthusiastic about the vaccination campaign. Shri Modi recalled his meeting with Pope Francis at the Vatican, a few days ago. He urged for a special emphasis on taking the message of religious leaders on vaccines to the public.

The Prime Minister asked the officials to change gears from arrangements made for taking people to the vaccination center and for safe vaccination to administering vaccines from door to door. He urged the health workers to reach every house with passion 'har ghar tika, ghar ghar tika' - Vaccine at every doorstep. He also asked to go in the spirit of 'Har Ghar Dastak' knocking on every doorstep to ensure full vaccination. "Now we are preparing to take the vaccination campaign to each household. With the mantra of 'Har Ghar Dastak', knock on every door, every household lacking the security net of a double dose of vaccine will be approached", he said.

DM (N&M Andaman) issues order prohibiting sale or use of fire crackers carrying barium or other banned chemicals/mislabelled crackers

Port Blair, Nov. 3

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has prohibited use/sale of compounds of antimony, lithium, mercury, arsenic and lead in the fireworks, as also the Barium salts vide its orders in WP (C) No.728 of 2015. The Hon'ble Court has permitted use/sale only of the crackers with reduced emission and green crackers permitted by PESO to be manufactured. Sale of joined fire crackers (laris) is also prohibited by the Hon'ble Court. The green crackers are permitted for sale and use only as single crackers, ground

chakkars, sparklers and red flower pots.

Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred u/s 144 Cr.P.C., Smti Anjali Sehrawat, District Magistrate, North & Middle Andaman has issued order in pursuance to the directions of Hon'ble Court, prohibiting sale and/or use of fire crackers carrying barium or other banned chemicals, mislabelled crackers, laris and rockets, in the jurisdiction of North and Middle Andaman district. This order shall remain in force for a period of 2 months from the date of its issuance. As the notice cannot

be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. This order shall be promulgated in the North and Middle Andaman district for information of the public. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrates/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to be vigilant in the matter.

Disobedience of the above order shall merit penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code (IPC) 1860.

Govt reduces excise duty on Diesel by Rs 10, Petrol by Rs 5

New Delhi, Nov. 3

Government has taken a significant decision of reducing Central Excise Duty on Petrol by five rupees and Diesel by ten rupees from tomorrow. Finance Ministry said, the prices of petrol and diesel will come down accordingly.

Media briefed on COVID-19 No positive case detected during tests conducted on incoming flight and interisland bound passengers

Port Blair, Nov. 3

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar addressing the media briefing on COVID-19 held in the conference hall of IP&T here today stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 649 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 11 flights with 1932 passengers arrived, out of which, 1144 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 788 passengers and the reports are awaited. RAT was conducted on 173 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 154 passengers and all were found negative. At Helipad, RAT was conducted on 8 passengers and all were found negative.

The Director further stated that today till 3 pm, 298 persons were vaccinated, out of which 267 were in the age group of 18-44 years.

The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De informed that two patients are undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital.

Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential services.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator(s) and fine shall also be imposed as per Order issued by this office from time to time. This order has come into effect from Nov. 3, 2021 and shall remain in force till further orders.

Chaudhary in separate orders issued on Nov. 3 have stated that they have reasons to believe that circumstances exists where such use of fire crackers may seriously endanger life and property of the citizens and maintenance of peace and law & order in the jurisdiction of South Andaman and Nicobar Districts and therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 144 of the Criminal Procedure code, 1973 (No. 2 of 1947), have issued orders prohibiting use of fire crackers (carrying barium or other banned chemicals or mislabelled) except for green crackers permitted by PESO (Petroleum & Explosives Safety Organisation) on religious occasions, in the jurisdiction of South Andaman and Nicobar Districts. As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the orders have been passed ex-parte.

Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of these orders and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to be vigilant in the matter. Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action in accordance with the prohibition order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and U/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, the orders to this effect issued by DM (SA)/DM (Nicobar) added.
