PM holds review meeting with districts having ... (Contd. from page 1) the country. He gave an account of balance vaccine dose availability in the States, and also talked about special vaccination campaigns being run in the States to further improve vaccination coverage.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister thanked the Chief Ministers present and said that their attention will encourage the district to work with more determination. Shri Modi said in this biggest pandemic of the century, the country faced many challenges. He said "one special thing in the country's fight against Corona was that we found new solutions and tried innovative methods". He urged the administrators to work more on new innovative ways to increase vaccination in their districts. He conveyed that even the better performing districts had similar challenges but they were met with determination and innovation. He asked the officials to develop micro strategies, keeping in mind the experience so far to go for saturation of vaccination by addressing the gaps at local level. The Prime Minister asked the district officials to make different strategies for each village, each town in the districts, if need be. He suggested this can be done by forming a team of 20-25 people depending on the region. He also suggested trying to have a healthy competition in the teams that you have formed. Exhorting the officials to prepare region-wise timetables for local goals, the Prime Minister said "You will have to do your best to take your districts nearer the national

The Prime Minister touched upon the issue of rumours and misunderstanding about vaccination. He suggested awareness is the only solution for this and asked the state officials to take help from the religious leaders. The Prime Minister noted that religious leaders are very enthusiastic about the vaccination campaign. Shri Modi recalled his meeting with Pope Francis at the Vatican, a few days ago. He urged for a special emphasis on taking the message of religious leaders on vaccines to the public.

The Prime Minister asked the officials to change gears from arrangements made for taking people to the vaccination center and for safe vaccination to administering vaccines from door to door. He urged the health workers to reach every house with passion 'har ghar tika, ghar ghar tika' - Vaccine at every doorstep. He also asked to go in the spirit of 'Har Ghar Dastak' knocking on every doorstep to ensure full vaccination. "Now we are preparing to take the vaccination campaign to each household. With the mantra of 'Har Ghar Dastak', knock on every door, every household lacking the security net of a double dose of vaccine will be approached", he said.

Govt reduces excise duty on Diesel by Rs 10, Petrol by Rs 5

New Delhi, Nov. 3

Government has taken a significant decision of reducing Central Excise Duty on Petrol by five rupees and Diesel by ten rupees from tomorrow. Finance Ministry said, the prices of petrol and diesel will come down accordingly.

Media briefed on COVID-19 No positive case detected during tests conducted on incoming flight and interisland bound passengers

Port Blair, Nov. 3

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar addressing the media briefing on COVID-19 held in the conference hall of IP&T here today stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 649 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 11 flights with 1932 passengers arrived, out of which, 1144 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 788 passengers and the reports are awaited. RAT was conducted on 173 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 154 passengers and all were found negative. At Helipad, RAT was conducted on 8 passengers and all were found negative. The Director further stated that today till 3 pm, 298 persons were vaccinated, out of which 267 were in the age group of 18-44 years.

The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De informed that two patients are undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator(s) and fine shall also be imposed as per Order issued by this office from time to time. This order has come into effect from Nov. 3, 2021 and shall remain in force till further orders.

Chaudhary in separate orders issued on Nov. 3 have stated that they have reasons to believe that circumstances exists where such use of fire crackers may seriously endanger life and property of the citizens and maintenance of peace and law & order in the jurisdiction of South Andaman and Nicobar Districts and therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 144 of the Criminal Procedure code, 1973 (No. 2 of 1947), have issued orders prohibiting use of fire crackers (carrying barium or other banned chemicals or mislabelled) except for green crackers permitted by PESO (Petroleum & Explosives Safety Organisation) on religious occasions, in the jurisdiction of South Andaman and Nicobar Districts. As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the orders have been passed ex-parte.

Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of these orders and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to be vigilant in the matter. Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action in accordance with the prohibition order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and U/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, the orders to this effect issued by DM (SA)/DM (Nicobar) added.
