Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 6,03,609 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far

Port Blair, Jan. 27

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,03,609 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far in A&N Islands. Similarly, 21,944 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years against the target beneficiaries of 23,000. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of

vaccine so far stood at 4999.

A total of 424 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 371 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 18 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years, 20 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 209.

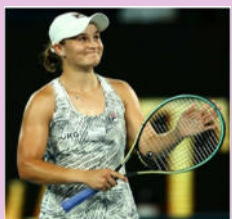

Ash Barty reaches Australian Open Women's final

Canberra, Jan. 27

In Tennis, Ash Barty reached the Australian Open Women's final with a 6-1, 6-3 win over unseeded Madison Keys. Barty is the first Australian woman to reach the singles final of her home Grand Slam tournament since Wendy Turnbull in 1980. No Australian has won the title since Chris O'Neil in 1978. The top-ranked Barty conceded only 17 games on her way to the semifinals and continued her strong form with another dominating performance against 2017 U.S. Open runner-up Keys. In the other semifinal American Danielle Collins beat 7th seed Iga Swiatek in straight sets 6-4, 6-1 and advance to her maiden Grand Slam final.




