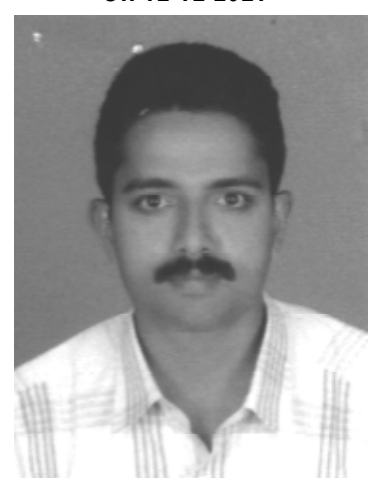

**Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub**  
**Value added fishery by-products**

Protein rich foods, like seafood are gaining wide acceptability among the common public since recent past due to its easy digestibility and numerous other health benefits. Product development and value addition, functions by understanding the science behind each food and hence convert it efficiently into a new product form. This has resulted in formulation of diversified products in the global markets. Capture fisheries of Andaman and Nicobar Islands is diversified with rich resources of fish species belonging to pelagic, demersal and oceanic fishery. The fish landings in the Islands are generally utilized in fresh form for consumption whereas there are no much effort undertaken to add value to these fisheries in the form of value addition and by product development for better income and diversified fishery practices. Particularly, the women communities in the Islands can benefit from the fishery based value addition to promote their livelihood and income generation prospects. With this background information focus was laid on certain low value fishes of the island and which could be suitable for purpose of value addition. Diversified products were developed from these fisheries training and capacity building programmes initiated for entrepreneurship development. Further, women stakeholders of the islands have been identified as the potential entrepreneurs for the value addition process considering the interest and can serve as an alternative source of livelihood.



**Benefit:** The technology will help the women stakeholders of the islands in earning an alternative source of livelihood. During the fishing ban periods and off seasons, value added products will gain visibility among the common public.

## India successfully tests extended range version of multi barrel rocket launcher system, Pinaka-ER

New Delhi, Dec. 11

The Pinaka-ER Multi Barrel Rocket Launcher System was successfully tested at Pokharan range. Successful tests of Pinaka Extended Range (Pinaka-ER), Area Denial Munitions (ADM) and indigenously developed fuzes have been carried out at various test ranges. The system is jointly designed by laboratories of Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) - Armament Research and Development Establishment (ARDE), Pune and High Energy Materials Research Laboratory (HEMRL), Pune.

The Pinaka - ER is the upgraded version of the earlier version of Pinaka which has been in service with the Indian Army for the last decade. The system has been designed in the light of emerging requirements with a d v a n c e d technologies enhancing the range. A number of 24 rockets were fired for different ranges and warhead capabilities to meet the objectives of accuracy and consistency. With this, the initial phase of technology absorption of Pinaka-ER by the Industry Partner has successfully been completed making the Industry Partner ready for series production of the rocket system. 2021, 1489.80 MT of Di Ammonium Phosphate (DAP) were received and is being sold to the farmers. It is to mention that 700 MT of Murate of Potash (MOP) will be reaching Port Blair shortly and the same will be distributed to the farmers from the Sub-depots.

Murate of Potash (MOP) contains 60% Potash which is essential for plant growth and quality. It plays a vital role in the production of proteins and sugars. It also protects against drought by maintaining plants water content which is beneficial for photosynthesis as leaves maintain their shape and vigour.

Farmers may access the nearest Sub-depot of the Department of Agriculture located in respective zones, a press release from Directorate of Agriculture said.

cover maximum number of eligible beneficiaries by vaccinating them through its designated vaccination centres spread over the Islands to keep the corona virus at bay. As per data available, the cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with first dose so far is 2,98,065 (104.22%) while cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with second dose so far is 2,76,325(92.71%). In order to restrict the entry of COVID virus in isles, the passengers coming from mainland are screened at Airport. The total number of incoming passengers screened at VSI Airport from May 25, 2020 to Dec. 11, 2021 stood at 434087 while the number of outgoing passengers was 433226 during the same period.

1298 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 101 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 220 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 8 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 12 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District. A total of 1,76,740 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date.
