## AB-PMJAY providing cashless treatment worth Rs 5 lakh per family for secondary & tertiary care hospitalization expenses



### 'Ayushman Bharat Pakhwara' to be observed from Sept.15 to 30

Port Blair, Sept. 14

Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) is a flagship scheme of the Government of India noted as the world's largest health assurance programme under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GoI. This scheme was launched on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2018 with an aim to provide cashless treatment worth Rs 5 lakh per family per year for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization expenses. PMJAY Card issued to the eligible beneficiaries empowers the beneficiary



to avail treatment in the empanelled Public and Private Hospitals across the country.

On September 23, 2022, AB-PMJAY will be completing 4 years of its implementation. To mark

the occasion the 'Ayushman Bharat Pakhwara' will be observed from Sept.15 to 30, 2022 in this UT. This will include activities to create awareness and educate the people of these

Islands about the scheme and benefits attached with it.

Presently, 12,622 families (40,118 members) have registered under the AB-PMJAY scheme in this UT and are entitled for cashless

treatment of 1,500 disease packages at more than 23,000 empanelled public and private hospitals across the country.

The eligible AB-PMJAY beneficiaries of these Islands are referred to empanelled hospitals at mainland for treatment of the specialties of Cardiothoracic surgery, Neurosurgery, Oncology etc. which are not available in these Islands. Till date, 943 patients have been referred to mainland for treatment under AB-PMJAY, a press release from Nodal Officer, AB-PMJAY said.

### COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Sept. 14

One COVID positive case has been detected today in A&N Islands from an incoming flight passenger, who arrived here yesterday. Today, 10 flights with 1633 passengers arrived, out of which, 1482 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 90 passengers and the reports are awaited.

Port Blair, Sept. 14

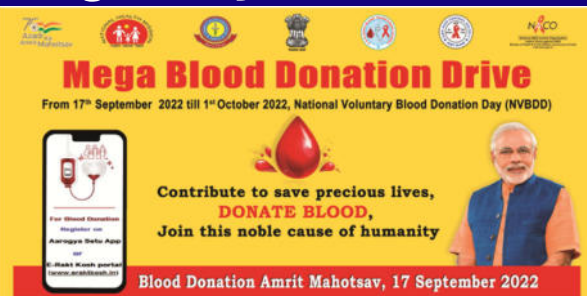
The Health Ministry has planned a nation-wide, mega voluntary blood donation drive called Raktdaan Amrit Mahotsav on September 17 on the occasion of Honourable Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi's birthday, with the aim to collect one lakh units of blood. The drive will continue for 15 days till October 1, which marks the National Voluntary Blood Donation Day (NVBDD).

The Directorate of Health Services, A & N Administration is organizing Raktdaan Amrit Mahotsav, a nation-wide mega voluntary blood donation drive in A & N Islands along with the rest of the nation. The inaugural function of the mega voluntary blood donation drive will be held on Sept. 17 from 9 am at JNRM. The Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS will grace the inaugural function as the chief guest. Other dignitaries and officials of A & N Administration will also be present on the occasion.

The event is being organized under 'Raktdaan Amrit Mahotsav'. The Ministry has launched a digital platform - E-Rakt Kosh portal, where people can register themselves to become a part of the donation drive. Additionally, Arogya Setu - the COVID 19 tracing app, is open for registration for the drive.

Besides collecting life saving blood for its blood banks, the drive also hopes to create a database of donors who can be called upon in times of emergency and replacement of blood donation can be minimized.

Any healthy person in the age group of 18 to 65, not less than 45 kg body weight can donate blood every three months.

## Crocodile rescued & released into its natural habitat by Quick Response Team of Middle Andaman

Kadamtala, Sept. 14

In its continuous zeal and endeavor towards protection and conservation of nature and wildlife resources in addition to protecting and safe guarding the interest of the public, the Middle Andaman Forest Division undertook the rescue operation of a salt water crocodile from Atterjig Nallah under Kadamtala Panchayat.

As per initial communication received from the Joint Patrolling

Team and the Beat Officer, Bajalungta regarding frequent sighting of a crocodile in the area and upon receiving a specific request from the Range Officer, Bajalungta for fixing a cage in the particular spot to rescue & translocate the crocodile to its natural habitat, a capturing permission was sought from the competent authority by the Divisional Forest Officer, Middle Andaman on August 29, 2022.

The permission was sought keeping in consideration the fact regarding mitigating the man-crocodile conflict in the area which in turn was also adversely affecting the daily livelihood concerns of local villagers & at the same time was also being requested by the PRIs on behalf of the villagers. The capturing permission was received from the competent authority on August 30 and the cage was fixed on

New Delhi, Sept. 14 (PIB)

Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology, Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh today launched exclusive "Swachhata" Portal for the Special Campaign 2.0, scheduled to begin on October 2.

Developed by the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG) in the Union Ministry of Personnel, the Portal-

scdpm22 is dedicated to Swachhata and reducing pendency of work in Government offices. The launch ceremony was attended by senior officers of 85 Ministries/Departments of Government of India, in the presence of Union Secretary, DARPG, Shri V. Srinivas.

Dr Jitendra Singh said, as per the directions of Prime Minister, the scope and mandate of Special Campaign 2.0 from 2<sup>nd</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2022 has been expended and all regional offices have been included in the campaign, apart from all Ministries/ Departments and all Attached/Subordinate

and Autonomous Bodies of Government of India. The Minister said, till date, more than 67,000 Sites have been identified by Ministries/ Departments of Government of India for conducting the cleanliness campaigns and it is likely to touch one lakh sites by 30<sup>th</sup> of September, while it was only 6,000 sites in the first special campaign undertaken in October, 2021.

Referring to Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi's very first speech from the ramparts of Red Fort on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2014, wherein he announced to launch Swachh Bharat Mission from 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2014, Dr Jitendra Singh said, the

mission on hygiene cleanliness became a Jan-Andolan and imbibed by the people as a Social Reform Movement. He said, it also demonstrated the intent of the Government that it will address the fundamental issues facing common-man in a mission mode.

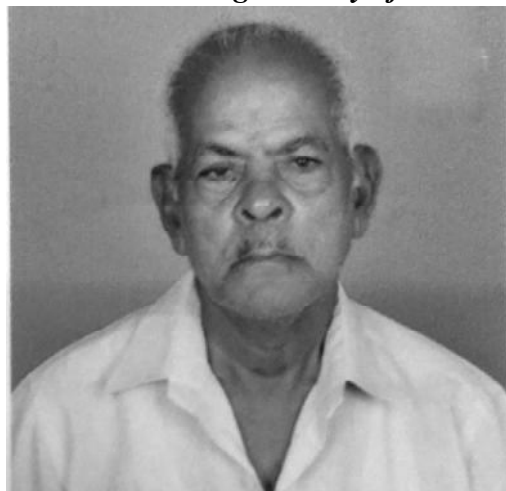



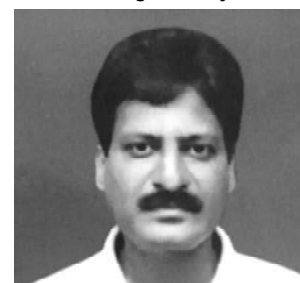
