71 water sources identified, of which, 57 sites found to be feasible after joint survey

Chief Secretary inspects progress of pond development work near IAF Station Port Mout, Badmash Pahar at Chouldari & New Bimblitan

Port Blair, July 16

Due to poor rainfall during previous monsoon, severe drinking water shortages were felt in various places in A&N Islands, especially in South Andaman District. To mitigate the situation, an intensive exercise has been taken up by A&N Administration to identify the areas where water shortage was noticed during summer and augment water supply in those areas by developing local water sources in those areas itself.

Accordingly, potential water sources in those areas have been identified with the help of Hydro Geomorphic



Maps, Drainage Map of the area and in consultation with Officials of Central Ground Water Boards. It has been planned to develop these identified potential water resources and develop them before next summer, so that

future recurrence of such crisis can be prevented.

During this exercise, a total of 71 water sources were identified, of which, 57 sites were found to be feasible after joint survey by Revenue Officials, Panchayat Members and



Engineers of the respective areas. The water sources include 16 Ponds, 23 Bore Wells, 2 Wells, 12 Check Weirs and 4 Reservoirs. Progress of these works is being monitored by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration and himself on weekly

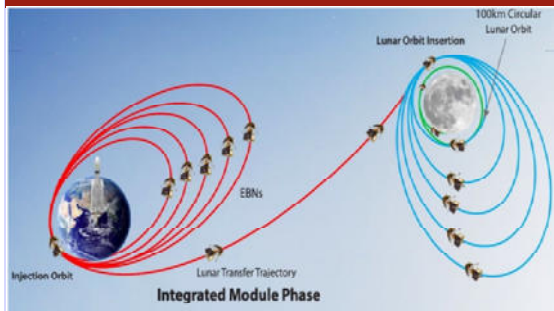
basis.

To keep tab on the progress of work, the Chief Secretary, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS, today inspected the progress of pond development work near IAF Station Port Mout, Badmash Pahar at Chouldari and New Bimblitan. At

IAF Station, an abandoned Pond is being revived and developed into a larger pond by desilting and widening it. The excavated earth from this site is being used to develop another pond at Badmash Pahar by reclaiming a submerged land of about 12000 Sqm. and developing it into a pond to store rain water for using it during summer. On completion, these Ponds shall yield about 3.08 lakh ltrs of water per day, which is about 50% of water demand of the area. Similarly, at New Bimblitan, work is under progress to develop an

Chandrayaan-3: First orbit-raising manoeuvre successfully performed, says ISRO



New Delhi, July 16

The Indian Space Research Organisation successfully raised the orbit of the Chandrayaan 3 spacecraft yesterday. In this first orbit raising manoeuvre through Earth-bound firing, the spacecraft was placed in 41,782 kms orbit. It means that the

Chandrayaan 3 is now rotating Earth in an orbit which is the closest to Earth at 173 km and farthest from it at 41,782 km. ISRO sources said, the spacecraft's health is normal.

During its 42 days journey to the Moon, the three other orbit-raising manoeuvres around Earth are

abandoned quarry into a water reservoir to supplement water supply in Teylarabad area.

During the inspection, plan for completion of development work of newly identified ponds as well as status of work of integration of new sources with nearest Treatment Plant and existing completed Amrit Sarovars were also discussed. Strict direction has been issued to Officials of APWD to complete these works in timely manner to ensure that these ponds are ready to store rain water during remaining raining season and brought into use during summer.

It has also been directed to take up other works like bore wells and construction of check weirs immediately in the identified areas. Long term projects like Rutland Water Supply Phase-II, Bachra Pahar and Karupyaswamy Dam at Chouldari and Teylarabad respectively may also be expedited and completed within the next one year. Further, directions were also issued to take up identified new water supply scheme in other places on priority basis to ensure sustainable water supply in A&N Islands and protect public from future water shortage.

Finance Minister calls for investment by private sector in urban infrastructure to create resilient future cities

Gandhinagar, July 16

Union Finance Minister, Smti Nirmala Sitharaman has stressed the need to augment private-sector partnerships in financing future cities. Addressing the Investors' Dialogue, at GIFT City in Gandhinagar today, Ms Sitharaman said innovative financing by the private sector in urban infrastructure is imperative for the creation of sustainable and resilient future cities. She said in view of the rapid urbanization, cumulative climate investment needed for cities is estimated to be 29.4 trillion dollars during 2018-2030.

The Finance Minister said innovative financing strategies such as



blended finances, and payments for ecosystem services, can fill the gap of financing and propel the economic growth of the cities. She also stressed on better policy and regulatory framework to promote public-private partnerships in infrastructure financing.

The Investors' Dialogue was organised as part of the 3rd G20 Finance Ministers' and Central Bank Governors' meeting which will begin in Gandhinagar

tomorrow. Earlier today, Union Finance Minister, Smti Nirmala Sitharaman and Finance Minister of Indonesia Mulyani Indrawati announced the launch of the "India - Indonesia Economic and Financial Dialogue" on the sidelines of the meeting in Gandhinagar. The initiative aims to strengthen cooperation between the two nations and foster a shared understanding on global issues. (Source: india.gov.in)

Startups will increase 10 times in the next 4-5 years: Minister

New Delhi, July 16 (PIB)

Union Minister of State for Skill Development & Entrepreneurship and Electronics & IT, Shri Rajeev Chandrasekhar, highlighted India's remarkable progress in building unicorns and startups, how they have successfully entered areas in emerging technologies, such as AI, Web 3, and deep tech. Speaking at the JITO Incubation Innovation Foundation (JIIF) 6th Foundation Day & Investors/Startup Conclave in Hyderabad, the Minister engaged

with industry leaders and aspiring young entrepreneurs.

Shri Rajeev Chandrasekhar emphasised the transformative journey India has embarked upon since 2014. From being predominantly focused on IT and ITes, the next 4-5 years will witness substantial growth for startups and unicorns, the Minister said during his interaction. "In 2014, our nation's tech landscape was limited to IT and ITes. However, since then, opportunities have emerged across

various domains such as deep tech, AI, data economy, semiconductor design, microelectronics, and high-performance computing. Due to the vision of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi what was once just one-third of the overall tech space has now expanded, presenting immense potential for unicorns and startups. From 108 unicorns I am sure we will reach 10,000 in the next 4-5 years. Today we have over a lakh startups in India and it will increase by 10 times," the Minister said.

Asian Athletics Championships 2023: India finish 3rd with 27 medals in Bangkok, Thailand

Bangkok, July 16

Indian athletes won a total of 27 medals - six gold, 12 silver and nine bronze - at the Asian Athletics Championships 2023, which was held at the Suphachalasai National Stadium in Bangkok, Thailand, from July 12 to 16.

The performance saw India equal their best-ever showing at the Asian Athletics Championships in terms of medals count. Indian athletes won 27 medals, including nine golds, at Bhubaneswar

2017 as well.

The Asian Athletics Championships was held after a gap of four years after the 2021 edition in Hangzhou, China was cancelled due to COVID-19. The previous edition, Doha 2019, saw India finish with 16 medals - two gold, seven silver and seven bronze.

Men's shot putter Tajinderpal Singh Toor, women's hurdler Jyothi Yarraji, triple jumper Abdulla Aboobacker, women's steeplechaser Parul Chaudhary, men's 1500m runner Ajay Kumar

Saroj and the mixed 4x400m relay team of Rajesh Ramesh, Aishwarya Kailash Mishra, Amoj Jacob and Subha Venkatesan accounted for India's six gold medals at the Asian Athletics Championships 2023 in Bangkok.

In the overall Asian Athletics Championships 2023 medals table, India finished third, behind Japan and the People's Republic of China. Japan won 37 medals, including 16 golds, while China bagged 22 medals, including eight golds.

London, July 16

Marketa Vondrousova beat Ons Jabeur 6-4, 6-4 in the summit clash of Women's Singles on Saturday to become the first unseeded woman to win the title in Open era. The Czech Republic star defeated Jabeur 6-4 in the first set. The Tunisian player

started the set with her serve and did take a 2-0 lead after breaking Vondrousova, but the latter bounced back beautifully to seal the set. The second set was a neck-and-neck contest before Vondrousova edged past Jabeur 6-4 again to claim her maiden title.

planned on 18th, 20th and 25th of July.

The Spacecraft will move towards the Moon on the intervening night of the 31st of July and the 1st of August when the Earth-bound manoeuvres will end and trans-lunar ion will take place.

The spacecraft will be captured by the Moon and the propulsion module will go around the Moon in a 100 km lunar orbit. The soft landing of the lander and roll out of the rover will happen on the 23rd of August at 5.47 pm. When successful, India will be the fourth country in the world to achieve the feat, following the USSR, the US and China. (Source: india.gov.in)
