The Prime Minister said there was a time when auditing in the country was looked

upon with apprehension and dread. 'CAG vs Government', had become the common thought of our system. But, today this mindset has changed. Today audit is being considered as an important part of value addition.

The Prime Minister

commented, earlier, due to lack of transparency in the banking sector, various wrong practices were followed. The result was that the NPAs of the banks kept increasing. "You know very well how, in the past, NPAs were brushed under the carpet. However, we have put the truth of the

previous governments in front of the country with complete honesty. We will find the solutions only when we recognize the problems", he said.

The Prime Minister said "today we are making such a system in which the thinking of 'Sarkar Sarvam' i.e. the interference of the government is decreasing, and your work is also getting easier", the Prime Minister told the auditors. vaccinated. 2239 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 89 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 414 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 9

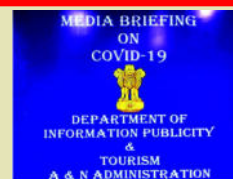

Media briefed on COVID-19

No positive case detected during test conducted on incoming flight passengers: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Nov.16

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar while giving information on COVID-19 status stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 538 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 12 flights with 2,002 passengers arrived, out of which, 1364 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 638 passengers and the reports are awaited. RAT was conducted on 181 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case has



been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 83 passengers and all were found negative. At Helipad 08 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 53 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. Today, till 3 pm, 577 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Nicobari fowl of A&N Islands: A hidden treasure under impending climate change scenario

Nicobari fowl is well adapted in the island milieu condition under impending climate change scenario. Nicobari fowl in Mon-Khmer language (Austro-asiatic language spoken by Nicobarese) is called as Takniet which means 'short legged chicken'. Nicobari fowl is endemic breed of Nicobar group of Islands and maintained their unique genetic identity due to natural geographical barrier. The one and unique breed has evolved in Nicobar group of islands and genetically closely related to Red jungle fowl and belong to *Gallus domesticus* species. They are medium sized with short leg. They have compact body conformity. These birds are mostly single combed. Wattles and ear lobe are pinkish in colour. They have short and thick neck with mostly black plumage tipped with brown shade, breast bulging in front, medium size tail and long saddle feathers fitting well with tail. Nicobari fowl is less susceptible to Ranikhet disease, Mareks disease and infectious bursal disease unlike exotic breeds of fowl. They are comparatively better egg productivity compared to desi birds reared in backyard farming. They produce 130-140 eggs per annum and gains 1.2 kg body weight at 20 weeks of age.

Intervention proposed and implemented by scientists of ICAR-CIARI:

Since the Nicobari fowl is efficient feed converters, production potential of these fowl can be improved through development of low cost housing and feeding of balanced ration prepared using locally available ingredients such as rice, wheat, coconut cake and fishmeal. The systemic approach is the need of the hour since this unique germplasm is on the verge of extinction after Tsunami and also due to introduction of exotic breeds. Thus rearing of this germplasm at village level in Andaman and Nicobar group islands is recommended as a token of in situ conservation. Further, for conservation of this germplasm, ICAR-CARI is maintaining Nicobari fowl and is supplying cocks of Nicobari fowl.

Benefit: Establishment of rural poultry farming with cocks of native Nicobari fowl and large scale multiplication at farm level is a novel vista for mass propagation of this germplasm, which is bestowed for their hardness, better immunity and adaptability to local agro-climatic environments.

Jaipur to host India, New Zealand T20I with no restrictions today

New Delhi, Nov.16

India will take on New Zealand in the first T-20 encounter of the 3-match series tomorrow at the Sawai Mansingh Stadium in Jaipur. The match will start at 7 p.m.

Rohit Sharma will lead the Indian team while K. L. Rahul will be the Vice-Captain. Virat Kohli, who relinquished his T-20 captaincy has been rested. Senior leg-spinner Yuzvendra Chahal and pacer Mohammed Siraj return to the Indian squad for a series against New Zealand.

New Zealand's Captain Kane Williamson will miss the upcoming three-match T-20I series, opting instead to focus on the Test series that



begins on 25th of November in Kanpur. In Williamson's absence, Tim Southee will serve as the visiting team's Captain. Pacer Lockie Ferguson, who had to skip the T-20 World Cup due to a right calf strain, is expected to be fit for the T-20I series.

The two teams last played a bilateral T-20I series in early 2020, with India registering a 5-0 sweep in New Zealand. However, New Zealand emerged victorious in the teams' most recent encounter during the group stages of the T-20 World cup.

The second match will be played at Ranchi while the third in Kolkata. The new Head Coach Rahul Dravid's tenure begins with the three-match T20I series against New Zealand, starting tomorrow.

India's Covid vaccination coverage crosses 113 crore mark

New Delhi, Nov. 16

India's Covid vaccination coverage has crossed 113 crore mark. Out of the total vaccination, more than 75 crore 50 lakh doses have been given as first dose while over 37 crore 51 lakh doses have been administered as second dose. Around 60 lakh vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours. Meanwhile, over eight thousand new COVID-19 cases were reported in the country in the last 24 hours while around 12 thousand people recovered. One hundred ninety-seven people lost



their lives during the period.

Till now, more than three crore 38 lakh people have recovered from COVID-19. Union Health Ministry said, the COVID recovery rate in the country now stands at 98.27 percent which is the highest

since March last year. India's Active caseload is presently over one lakh 30 thousand which is the lowest in 522 days. Over 11 lakh COVID tests were conducted yesterday. So far, 62 crore 57 lakh tests have been conducted in the country. (Source: india.gov.in)

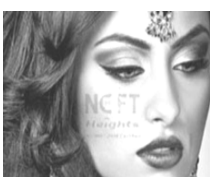
