amount deposited in the bank, only the amount up to 50 thousand rupees was guaranteed. Then it was raised to one lakh rupees. That is, if the bank sank, then the depositors had a provision to get only up to one lakh rupees. There was no time limit on when this money would be paid. "Understanding the concern of the poor, understanding the concern of the middle class, we increased this amount to Rs 5 lakh", The Prime Minister said. Another problem was tackled by amending the law. "Earlier where there was no time limit for refund, now our government has made it mandatory within 90 days i.e. 3 months. That is, even in the event of a bank sinking, the depositors will get their money back within 90 days", he said.

The Prime Minister remarked that banks play a major role in the prosperity of the country. And for the prosperity of the banks, it is equally important for the depositors' money to be safe. If we want to save the bank, then depositors have to be protected.

Deposit insurance covers all deposits such as savings, fixed, current, recurring deposits, etc. in all commercial banks, functioning in India. Deposits in State, Central and Primary cooperative banks, functioning in States/Union Territories are also covered. In a path breaking reform, Bank deposit insurance cover was enhanced from Rs. 1 lakh to Rs. 5 lakh. With deposit insurance coverage of Rs. 5 lakh per depositor per bank, the number of fully protected accounts at end of previous financial year constituted 98.1% of the total number of accounts, as against the international benchmark of 80%.

The first tranche of interim payments has been released by the Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation recently, against claims received from depositors of 16 Urban Cooperative Banks which are under restrictions by RBI. Payout of over Rs 1300 crore has been made to alternate bank accounts of over 1 lakh depositors against their claims.

It is heartening to note that in A & N Islands, the total number of workers registered in the portal is increasing and has reached 12052 as on Dec. 11, 2021.

Meanwhile, the Labour Department has appealed to all Unorganized Workers (those who aged between 16-59 years, not a member in EPF/ESI and not an Income Tax Payee) to register themselves at e-SHRAM Portal. They can utilize Self Registration or service of any CSCs or the Facilitation Centre functioning at Office of the Labour Commissioner, Deptt. of Labour, Supply Line along with a copy of Aadhaar Card, nominee's details, Bank A/c number, IFSC Code and Aadhaar Linked mobile number. The Labour Department has also appealed to all NGOs, Trade Unions, Social Work Organizations and Social Leaders to conduct eSHRAM Registration Camps in their respective areas for which the Department will facilitate the Unorganized Workers to get them registered on eSHRAM Portal.

Social Security benefits provided are e-SHRAM card received after registration will be accepted across the country; Accidental insurance coverage through PMSBY for a year; Rs. 2 lakhs in case of accidental death and permanent disability and Rs. 1 lakh in case of partial Social Security benefits will be delivered through e-SHRAM Portal.
