BSI gets patent for bamboo based reusable straw

Botanical Scientist, Dr. Lal Ji Singh discovered potentiality of bamboo and invented an eco-friendly reusable drinking straw from the Andamans. This significant invention has been granted patent in the year 2023 by Govt. of India. Botanical Survey of India is an apex taxonomic institute of India is a subordinate office of MoEF&CC which was established in 1890 with prime objective to survey and documentation of plant wealth of the country.

In view of the socio-



economy and ecological balance preventing environmental degradation, Scientist from the Botanical Survey of India serving in Islands, made a notable invention, reusable eco-friendly drinking straw: a novel way to replace plastic drinking straws and there is no use of any synthetic hazardous materials in this

invention. An endemic bamboo species, *Schizostachyum andamanicum* is used as natural source for the invention of natural reusable drinking straw. This invention opens a new avenue for local bamboo growers to explore the possibility of growing the bamboo species in larger area which will be beneficial economically as well as ecologically. Besides this invention, Dr. Singh also discovered over 20 new species and a new genus as new to Science from Islands, a press release from BSI said.

scammers have access to the victim's contacts.

When such apps are installed, it requests permission to access the phone contacts, gallery, etc. The data accessed are sent by the app to the scammers, who then use it to threaten and harass the victim. Depending on the permissions granted by the users, these apps are capable of collecting sensitive information about the victims based on the data available on the phone, including pictures, audio, video, messages, contact list, etc. which can be used to further harass the victim.

In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory in the interest of the general public:

- > Do not install mobile apps which are offering loans online as they are most likely created by scammers.
- > When installing new mobile apps on your phone, check the permissions requested by the app to ensure that it does not have access to your personal information.
- > Occasionally check your phone to see if there are any mobile apps which you may not have installed.
- > Please don't surrender to abusive/torturous method of recovery agents of these Loan App companies. In such case report the matter to the Police.
- > Please do not give your documents for opening of bank accounts to be operated by someone else and also don't allow anybody to use your SIM to be used by someone else. These things can be used for illegal purposes.



Whereas as per the section 21(RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF CERTAIN INDUSTRIAL PLANTS) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, subject to the provisions of this section, no person shall, without the previous consent of the State Board, establish or operate any industrial plant in an air pollution control area.

Whereas, it is the responsibility of the industrial unit to obtain Consent To Establish(CTE) from Andaman Nicobar Pollution Control Committee(ANPCC) before establishment of industry and also obtain Consent to Operate(CTO) after establishment of unit. Non compliance of this is the violation of the provisions made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Whereas, it has come to the notice of ANPCC that the many of Industrial Units have been established without obtaining CTE and also started operating without CTO under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1981, which is a violation of the aforesaid rules.

Whereas, ANPCC has given an opportunity to such units by giving one time window to all such industrial establishment who have not obtained CTE before establishment by giving 60 days window from 10-03-2023 to 10-05-2023 for getting CTO from ANPCC. Even after the lapse of such period, ANPCC is still receiving applications for issue of CTO without having prior CTE.

Now, therefore the ANPCC in its XXVIII meeting held on 12-05-2023 has decided to extend the window for further period of 90 days to regulate all such industrial establishment who have not obtained CTE before establishment by giving a window from 01-07-2023 to 30-09-2023 apply for getting CTO from ANPCC. However the CTO will be issued subject to fulfillment of environmental norms applicable to the industry.

Therefore, it is informed to all the stakeholders and general public that it is the statutory responsibility of all the industries to obtain CTE prior to establishment of any industry& CTO after establishment in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The industrial unit/entrepreneur shall apply for CTE& CTO using the URL: www.anocmms.nic.in for the fulfillment of requirement made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Any industrial unit which fails to obtain CTO from ANPCC within the stipulated time shall be liable for action as the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

No Consent to Operate will be issued to any industry after lapse of 90 days(i.e 30-09-2023)who have not obtained CTE before its establishment.
