Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd) Hon'ble Lt Governor, A&N Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency participated in the 14th Conference of Central Council of Health & Family Welfare (CCHFW) chaired by Shri Mansukh Mandaviya, Hon'ble Minister

of Health & Family Welfare and Chemical and Fertilizers, GoI at Kevadia, Gujarat. The conference which began on May 5 concluded today.

Addressing the conference, the Lt Governor highlighted the urgent need of expediting filling up vacancies of specialist doctors, to be appointed through CGHS. He also recommended

augmenting Primary and Secondary Health Care Infrastructure above and beyond mainland norms in view of the remoteness of A&N Islands and its geographical limitations. In view of the thin population density spread over large areas, the Lt Governor suggested hybrid solutions for delivery of Tertiary healthcare on as and when required basis.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 11,936 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs vaccinated so far

Port Blair, May 7

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,77,491 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,454 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 11,936 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries

administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 21084.

A total of 397 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 348 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 21 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 16 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs, 1 beneficiary was in the age group

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain held an interactive meeting with ZP Adhyaksha, N&M Andaman, Smti. Elizabeth and members of ZP N&M in the conference hall of Secretariat yesterday. During the meeting, various issues pertaining to N&M Andaman District and developments related projects were discussed.

Interacting with them, the Chief Secretary emphasized on the importance of planting fruit bearing trees for achieving food security in Isles thereby attaining self sufficiency. Towards this initiative, the Chief Secretary urged the members to create awareness and encourage general public to plant more fruit trees like Jackfruit, Moringa, Guava, in the vacant Govt. land as well as road sides. For achieving this, the Chief Secretary urged the members to launch tree planting drives in their respective



villages. He said, Forest Department will provide training to all villagers on how to preserve seeds. They will also collect seeds preserved by the villagers for planting.

The Chief Secretary further asked to organize tourism drive at Rangat focusing on all aspects of tourism related activities. To maintain sanitation and cleanliness in the villages, he stressed on the need to segregate garbage in every Panchayat/Zilla Parishad for its further utilization and proper disposal. To make Rangat area more appealing, he requested all shops to have similar sign boards while in Diglipur, all

shops at Subhash Gram should be painted with different colours (jelly bee system).

Further, to globalize the mesmerizing beauty of the Islands, the Chief Secretary directed to create Selfie Point at various locations giving prominence to the natural beauty of the place. He also asked the Members to organize Beach festival at Karmatang beach under the banner 'Karen Beach Festival' emphasizing on traditional Karen cuisines. Similarly, at Diglipur, Bengali Kiosk with authentic Bengali food festival has to be organized. Similar beach festival has to be organized at Baratang, Baludera with authentic foods of Jharkand and Tamil Nadu, he said.

The Chief Secretary directed Secretary (RD)/DC to circulate the Laxmanpur beach model to all Panchayats for its implementation. To encourage rural tourism, he urged for beautification of all the shops/residence in the road side of ATR.

passengers and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 58 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was

conducted on 39 passengers and no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 4 passengers were tested with RAT and all were negative, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

Addressing the Seventh Annual Multi-Stakeholder Forum on Science, Technology and Innovation for the Sustainable Development Goals of the UN, Dr Jitendra Singh, Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Science and Technology and Earth Sciences said, India has been strongly advocating for the principle of equity in the WHO and has also proposed, along with South Africa, a TRIPS waiver at the WTO for COVID vaccines, diagnostics, and medicines. He said, India is working actively with the Global Alliance for

Dr Jitendra Singh said the enormous power of digital and information technology has been a key component of the global response to Covid. He added, that utilizing India's strength in the digital space, New Delhi decided to share with the world, India-developed Co-WIN App, to provide digital support to better organize vaccination drives. The Minister highlighted, that India has long been fostering Science

Technology and Innovation and nurturing an enabling ecosystem to incubate and scale revolutionary ideas, help improve the quality of life of people and provide solutions to global problems.

Over 190 crore COVID vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under the Nationwide Vaccination Drive. The Union Health Ministry said, over 17 lakh 49 thousand vaccine doses were administered yesterday. The Ministry said, more than 18 crore 64 lakh balance and unutilized COVID vaccine doses are still available with the States and Union Territories to

be administered.

A total of three thousand 805 new COVID cases were recorded in the last 24 hours. India's active caseload currently stands at 20 thousand 303.

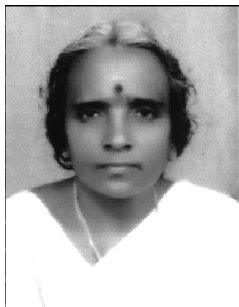
