## No hotels or restaurants can add service charge automatically or by default in the food bill: Consumer Affairs Ministry

Consumer may lodge a complaint on the National Consumer Helpline against the service charged

New Delhi, July 4 (PIB)

The Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) has issued guidelines for preventing unfair trade practices and violation of consumer rights with regard to levying of service charge in hotels and restaurants.

The guidelines issued by CCPA stipulate that hotels or restaurant shall not add service charge automatically or by default in the food bill. No collection of service charge shall be done by any other name. No hotel or restaurant shall force a consumer to pay service charge and shall clearly inform the consumer that service charge is voluntary, optional and at consumer's

discretion. No restriction on entry or provision of services based on collection of service charge shall be imposed on consumers. Service charge shall not be collected by adding it along with the food bill and levying GST on the total amount. The guidelines can be accessed by clicking on the link.

If any consumer finds that a hotel or restaurant is levying service charge in violation to the guidelines, a consumer may make a request to the concerned hotel or restaurant to remove service charge from the bill amount. Also, the consumer may lodge a complaint on the National Consumer Helpline (NCH), which works

as an alternate dispute redressal mechanism at the pre-litigation level by calling 1915 or through the NCH mobile app.

The consumer may also file a complaint against unfair trade practice with the Consumer Commission. The Complaint can also be filed electronically through e-daakhil portal [www.e-daakhil.nic.in](http://www.e-daakhil.nic.in) for its speedy and effective redressal. Furthermore, the consumer may submit a complaint to the District Collector of the concerned district for investigation and subsequent proceeding by the CCPA. The complaint may also be sent to the CCPA by e-mail at [com-ccpa@nic.in](mailto:com-ccpa@nic.in).

## DoT issues advisory against use of jammers and boosters by private organizations or individuals

New Delhi, July 4

Department of Telecommunications has issued an advisory to the general public on the proper use of wireless jammers and booster/repeaters. The advisory issued on the 1<sup>st</sup> of this month has stated that the use of cellular signal jammer, GPS blocker, or other signal jamming device is generally illegal, except specifically permitted by

Government. The detailed guidelines in this regard are available at <https://cabsec.gov.in/others/jammerpolicy/>. Private sector organizations or private individuals cannot procure or use jammers in India.

The advisory also stated that it is unlawful to advertise, sell, distribute, import, or market signal jamming devices in India,

except as permitted under the guidelines. It is unlawful to possess, sell, or use a mobile signal repeater/booster by any individual or entity other than the licensed Telecom Service Providers.

The Department of Telecom warned all e-commerce companies from selling or facilitating the sale of wireless jammers on their online platforms. (Source: india.gov.in)

## India administers more than 197.98 crore COVID vaccine doses

New Delhi, July 4

More than 197 crore 98 lakh COVID vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far. The Health Ministry said, more than one lakh 78 thousand vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours. During the same period, sixteen thousand one hundred and thirty-five new COVID cases

were reported in the country.

India's Active caseload currently stands at over one lakh thirteen thousand and it is at 0.26 percent. The recovery rate is currently at 98.53 percent. A total of 13 thousand 958 people recovered in the last 24 hours and with this, the total recoveries touched

over four crore 28 lakh. The Ministry said, the Weekly Positivity Rate stands at 3.74 percent and the Daily Positivity Rate is at 4.85 percent. A total of 86 crore 39 lakh COVID tests have been conducted in the country so far. In the last 24 hours, more than three lakh 32 thousand tests were conducted. (Source: india.gov.in)

Governor (Administrator) , Andaman & Nicobar Islands is hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment of the Group 'A' post of Sr. Lecturer, English (Gazetted, Group "A", Non-Ministerial) in the District Institute of Education & Training (DIET), Department of Education, Andaman and Nicobar Administration namely :-

1. **SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENTS:-**  
(i) These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, DIET, Department of Education (Group "A" post in the DIET of Department of Education), Recruitment Rules, 2022  
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **NUMBER OF POSTS, ITS CLASSIFICATION AND LEVEL IN PAY MATRIX:-** The number of said post, its classification and level in Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **METHOD OF RECRUITMENT, AGE LIMIT, QUALIFICATIONS ETC. :-** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in the Columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. **DISQUALIFICATIONS:-** No Persons--  
(a) Who has entered or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or  
(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted marriage with any persons; shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:  
Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation to this rule.

5. **POWER TO RELAX:-** Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so do he may by order for reason to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, if necessary, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class of category of persons.

6. **SAVING:-** Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. from time to time in this regard.
