The Project Implementing Agencies have submitted applications to opt for new trades in place of old deactivated trades and the Project Approval Committee after detailed discussion approved the new trades opted by the PIAs.

Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands is hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment of the Group 'A' post of Sr. Lecturer, English (Gazetted, Group "A", Non-Ministerial) in the District Institute of Education & Training (DIET), Department of Education, Andaman and Nicobar Administration namely:

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENTS:-

- (i) These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, DIET, Department of Education (Group "A" post in the DIET of Department of Education), Recruitment Rules, 2022
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
