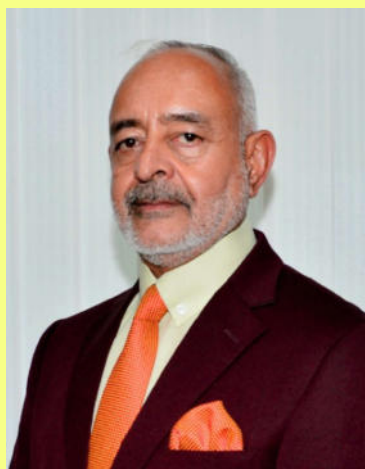

Chief Secretary chairs meeting of APWD

Chief Secretary asks Engineers not to delay genuine payments of Contractors and at the same time warns of serious CBI & Anti Corruption enquiries, if illegitimate, illegal, unwarranted diversions of works are done in nature of work, scope of work

Serious complaints have come to Chief Secretary about APWD at the behest of Architects and some Junior Engineers allowing major deviations and diversions from the expenditure sanctioned and administrative approval

CS observed that many structures have been built much beyond the sanctioned plan and the case in point is also Medical College. Works that are done after diversions are paid first; Vigilance, Anti Corruption raids Medical College for illegal Contractor- Engineer nexus

Port Blair, Dec. 23

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain chaired a meeting of APWD in the Conference Hall of Secretariat to review the works being executed by APWD in various places with Secretary (APWD) and other Secretaries, Deputy Commissioners of all Districts and Engineers of APWD. During the meeting, the Chief Secretary expressed his displeasure regarding deviation from the original sanctions that leads to arbitration by the contractor and loss of Govt. money. He directed the field Engineers to be vigilant and ensure execution of works within the sanctioned amount and scope of the work. No deviation from the original sanction should be allowed and any such practice by any of the Engineers will be dealt with iron hands.

The Chief Secretary said, serious complaints have come to him about APWD, at the behest of Architects and some Junior Engineers allowing major deviations and diversions from the expenditure sanctions and administrative approval. Chief Secretary observed that many structures have been built much beyond the sanctioned plan and the case in point is also Medical College. Works that are done after diversions are paid first; Vigilance, Anti Corruption raids Medical College for illegal

Contractor- Engineer nexus. Such engineers & contractors, who connive to deprive the poor people, will face strict vigilance action, no matter how big the contractor or his political connections. Illegal works which have been reported have already been paid and Senior Engineers are likely to be suspended soon.

The Chief Secretary directed the Anti-Corruption Unit & CBI to verify each and every aspect of construction work in Medical College site. In the case of any deviation or diversion, the Anti-Corruption Unit has been tasked to take necessary action, if the same was done without due permissions.

To oversee the works of APWD, an Oversight Committee has been constituted with seven Executive Engineers of APWD who will prepare the annual action plan of the Department in larger public interest, monitor preparation of estimates, tendering within the timeline. The Committee will also ensure that there is no diversion from the original sanction and in case, any such diversion is noticed, the same will be brought to the notice of higher authorities.

A Sub Committee of APWD Assistant Engineers with fifteen Assistant Engineers has also been constituted to oversee the progress, quality and other parameters of the works. They will also make surprise visit to sites and check the presence of Engineers of the Department,

contractor and quality of work being executed.

The Chief Secretary further directed to ensure presence of Engineers at site while the work is in progress and the field measurement book to be checked by the Assistant and Executive Engineers for the entire work to avoid any deviation from the original sanctions. JEs have been directed to stay at their work sites from 9 am to 10 am and 4 pm to 5 pm. Directions were also issued to ensure that work is equally divided among all JEs. For each major work, two JEs should be placed in charge.

The Chief Secretary also directed to ensure commencement of the work within three weeks of award of the work. He said that many Engineers complete the tender, award the work but the work does not start on the site. He said that strict action will be taken against the Engineers and Contractors where the work does not commence within the time frame.

It was also directed by the Chief Secretary to ensure that no contractor is harassed unwarrantedly or due to any other reasons by the Engineers. If any contractor has dutifully completed his work without any deviation or diversion and without any delay, then his payment should be made in time.

The Chief Secretary was also anguished over the promotional avenues of Junior

Port Blair, Dec. 23

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Jitendra Narain has asked SP, Anti Corruption Unit to have a survey of all Inspectors, who have worked in Anti Corruption Unit for the last 10 years and their building, properties, benami properties in the name of their relatives and others and ask the public to provide feedback. This

action has to be completed by January 15, 2022 after public feedback and the report should be submitted to Lt Governor and Chief Secretary. The Secretary (Home) will monitor this matter on a day - to - day basis.

In this regard, public have been asked to inform through social media about the assets of Inspectors posted in ACU in the last 10 years. This is done

only to look into the action of certain Inspectors. It is also learned that another two Inspectors of Anti Corruption Unit are being changed till stop press.

The Government has given the responsibility to Shri Rajeev Singh, IPS, with the task to investigate and report on the assets of all Inspectors in Anti Corruption in the last 10 years to the Vigilance Department for onward

submission to Lt Governor and CS. This report shall be completed by Shri Rajeev Singh by January 15, 2022 after thorough detailed personal data collection and information from various public through social media and public platforms.

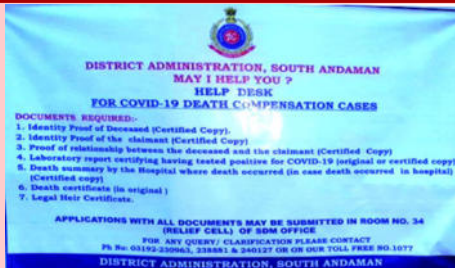
DC (SA) sanctions ex-gratia to next of kin of deceased due to COVID-19

Port Blair, Dec. 23

In pursuance of Hon'ble Supreme Court's Judgment in W. P. (C) No. 539 & 554 of 2021, the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Government of India has issued guidelines for ex-gratia assistance to next of kin of the deceased due to COVID-19 pandemic and recommended an amount of Rs. 50,000/- per deceased person including those involved in relief operations or associated in preparedness activities of COVID-19 subject to cause of death certified as COVID-19 and the said ex-gratia assistance to be paid from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF).

In compliance to the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and guidelines issued by the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, the District Administration, South Andaman has started the procedure for identifying the cases for ex-gratia assistance to next of the kin of the deceased by COVID-19 pandemic.

Taking pro-active steps in this matter, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman



has launched a Help Desk for hassle free processing of applications related to COVID-19 death compensation cases. The dedicated help desk is assisting the next of kin/family members of the deceased with any information related to documents required for processing the applications smoothly and also help the applicants in getting early disbursement of ex-gratia relief.

After scrutinizing the application an amount of Rs 9,00,000/- has been sanctioned to total 18 nos of cases belonging to next of kin of the deceased by COVID-19 which will be credited into their respective Bank Account. which, 45 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 33 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 4 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 7 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, a press release from DHS said.

Four positive cases detected during test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, Dec. 23

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 473 passengers who arrived here yesterday, four positive cases have been detected. Today, 12 flights with 2102 passengers arrived, out of which, 1629 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 473 passengers (includes 59 international travellers) and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 190 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 112 passengers and all were found negative. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 106 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. Today, till 3 pm 221 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 198 were of 18 plus age group, a press release from the Directorate of IP&T said.
