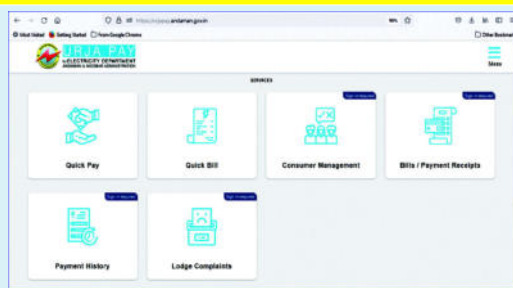

The digital payment facility of electricity bill through <https://urjapay.andaman.gov.in> anytime anywhere has become a boon for islanders residing in Port Blair particularly during this pandemic period. The launch of this facility has facilitated more number of users to register themselves for paying their bill without queuing up at the billing centres for hours.



This is evident from the number of users registered. As on Aug. 27, 2021, a total of 10115 users have been registered under the portal while a total of 95009 consumers had carried out online payment of bills. A total transaction amount of Rs. 9, 55,66,859/- has been made through this facility.

Consumers have been encouraged to make use of this facility by visiting the website <https://urjapay.andaman.gov.in>. The consumers have two options for making the payment viz. by registering themselves on the website- The registered user can add multiple accounts besides they will be provided with a dashboard to view the details of previous transactions of all accounts including the due amount and make payment and by using quick pay option-the consumers can make the payment by entering the consumer number.

Coast Guard rescues 10 fishermen onboard distressed fishing boat Salethmatha-II

Port Blair, Aug. 27

In a swift response and deftly coordinated Search and Rescue Operation on Aug. 25, 2021, Indian Coast Guard rescued a distressed fishing boat 'Salethmatha-II' with 10 crew onboard off Keating Point. The Coast Guard Regional Headquarters at Port Blair received a distress call from IFB Salethmatha-II regarding drifting of fishing boat along with 10 crew onboard off Keating Point on Aug. 24, 2021. As per the information received from sources, the fishing boat 'Salethmatha-II' ventured into sea with 10 crew for fishing on am Aug. 22 from Junglighat fishing harbor. On 24th August the engine of the fishing



boat became non operational due to rough weather. Efforts of the boat crew were in vain to repair the engine. The boat crew dropped anchor off Keating Point to prevent from drifting

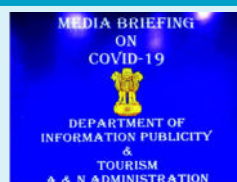

NOTICE

Andaman and Nicobar Idol Immersion Rules, 2018 were published in the Andaman and Nicobar Gazette No. 23 dated 05-03-2018 in compliance of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal Order dated 06-10-2017 in O.A 51/2016/EZ. The Rules framed covers the general guidelines idol making, ban on use of synthetic colors, height of super structures and idols. In this connection, all the Idol Makers and Puja Committees are hereby directed to follow the guidelines for idol immersion as mentioned below:

- Idols should be made from natural materials as described in the holy scripts. Use of traditional clay for idol making rather than baked clay, Plaster of Paris (POP) etc. shall be encouraged, allowed and promoted.
- There shall be a complete ban on the use of POP in idol making till it is established that the POP has no negative impact on the water quality and aquatic bio-diversity.
- Painting of idols should be discouraged. In case idols are to be painted, water soluble and non-toxic natural dyes are to be used.
- There shall be a complete ban on the use of synthetic colour for painting of idols that would require immersion as part of final ritual of the festival.
- The height of the super structure of the idol shall be less than 40 ft. and the idol also shall not exceed 20ft in height.
- Materials used in worship like flowers, *vastras* (clothes), decorative materials (made of paper and plastic) etc. should be removed before immersion of idols. Biodegradable materials should be collected separately for recycling or composting at designated sites whereas the non-biodegradable materials should be collected separately for disposal in sanitary landfills or as prescribed by the local Municipal Authority or local body. Clothes may be sent to local orphanage(s).
- Idol immersion should be done between low tide line and high tide line (irrespective of its depth) in a identified places with permission of District Administration only.
- Single use plastic should not be used during celebration.
