

## PM chairs 40<sup>th</sup> PRAGATI Interaction

# States may also formulate State level GatiShakti Master Plan on the lines of PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan: PM

New Delhi, May 25 (PIB)

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today chaired the meeting of 40th edition of PRAGATI, the ICT based multi-modal platform for Pro-Active Governance and Timely Implementation, involving Centre and State Governments.

In the meeting, nine agenda items were taken for review including eight projects and one Programme. Among the eight projects, two projects each were from the Ministry of Railways, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways and



Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas along with one project each from the Ministry of Power and Department of Water

Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation. These eight projects have a cumulative cost of over Rs. 59,900

crore, concerning the 14 States viz Maharashtra, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Chhattisgarh, Odisha,

Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Tripura, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Jharkhand.

Prime Minister said that the agencies working in the infrastructure sector, such as roads and railways, should map their projects with the water bodies being developed under Amrit Sarovar. This would be a win-win situation as the material dug out for the Amrit Sarovars can be utilised for civil works by the agencies.

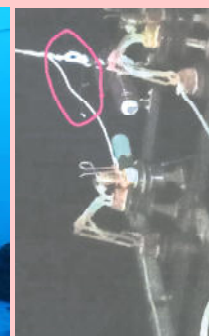

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain is constantly reviewing power situation in the Islands and endeavoured to resolve the current situation arisen due to load shedding and frequent disruption in power supply. As a reaction, teams consisting of engineers of Power Department, Police & Revenue were constituted who have been tasked to conduct surprise inspections in commercial establishments, crusher units, large scale electricity consumers to ascertain their technical parameters, power demand and consumption to check the connected load, peak demand and consumption.

As per directions of the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration,

joint teams have conducted inspections and raids at 13 commercial establishments, industrial units and crusher units at Dollygunj, Brookshabad and Teylorabad areas wherein electricity theft was detected in 10 units. There will be action against detected electricity theft as per section 135 and other sections of Electricity Act, 2003.

Further, incident of sabotage of electricity line has been reported in Swaraj Dweep. Such

incidents are being taken seriously by the Administration and Police complaint has been filed to book the perpetrators in relevant sections of Indian Penal Code.

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration has again issued strict warning to all the hoteliers, rich owners of commercial establishments to judiciously use the power during peak hours and meet their power requirement by using DG Sets

to mitigate the power crisis being experienced in Port Blair and adjoining areas. Further, the Chief Secretary is also monitoring the situation and made Electricity Department review meetings as part of daily agenda till the situation is normalised. Clearing of trees which are causing electricity disruption is also being taken by joint task force constituted on direction of the Chief Secretary A&N Administration.

National Health Policy 2017 under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. The scheme provides a cashless treatment of Rs 5 lakh per family per year against secondary and tertiary hospitalization care to the eligible beneficiaries belonging to the poor and vulnerable sections of the society at empanelled hospitals, private or public, across the country. The beneficiaries get an AB-PMJAY Card that is used to avail the service at empanelled hospitals. This Card is a single document containing detail of beneficiary with nationwide portability.


Presently, 12,468 families (39,944 members) have been registered under AB-PMJAY scheme in this UT and are entitled for cashless treatment of Rs. 5lakh. The treatment for diseases like Cardiology, Neurology, Oncology etc. are not available in this UT, as a result, the beneficiaries are referred to hospitals at mainland. Till date around 700 beneficiaries have been referred under AB-PMJAY Scheme to empanelled hospitals at mainland from this UT.

AB-PMJAY beneficiary expresses gratitude to GoI for aiding the needy

Shri K Ramachandran Pillai, 72 years, R/o Mazar Pahad, Port Blair, South Andaman, Andaman & Nicobar Islands works as a salesperson in a shop to meet the daily need of his family. His wife is a cancer patient who is completely dependent on him. He was already struggling hard to take care of his wife. One morning he experienced little pain in his abdomen. He rushed to G. B. Pant Hospital, where he was detained and few investigations were done. Further, he was diagnosed with Carcinoma Prostate and needed a prostate Biopsy which made him very low and broken.

To his relief, the doctor suggested him to visit Ayushman Bharat Reliever and enquire whether he can avail the benefit of AB-PMJAY. He was eligible to become an AB-PMJAY beneficiary and accordingly, he was referred to Urologist for TURP and prostate Biopsy to Muthu Hospital, Chennai under unspecified surgical package and availed free treatment.

K Ramachandran Pillai expressed his gratitude to GoI for launching this scheme and helping the needy.

objective & preparation for the State & District level functions of the PM's virtual interaction with beneficiaries to be held at Port Blair and at North & Middle Andaman District as well as Nicobar District.

Addressing the media persons, the Secretary (RD) informed that the 15 welfare schemes on which the Hon'ble Prime Minister will interact with the beneficiaries includes Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana (both Grameen & Urban), Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi, Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana, POSHAN Abhiyan, Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana, Swachh Bharat Mission (both Grameen & Urban), Jal Jeevan Mission & AMRUT, Pradhan Mantri SVANidhi Scheme, One Nation One Ration Card, Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana, Ayushman Bharat-PM Jan Arogya Yojana, Ayushman Bharat-Health and Wellness Centre and Pradhan Mantri MUDRAYojana.

The broad objectives of interaction programme is to ascertain how those left behind can be saturated- Antyodaya approach, understand the ease of living brought by various beneficiary oriented schemes, seek ideas for improvement of the schemes, explore possibilities of further convergence for the realization of higher benefits, and discuss citizen aspirations@ 2047, when the nation will be celebrating its 100 years of Independence, the Secretary RD said.

At Port Blair, the State level function will be held at DBRAIT while the District level functions will be held at North & Middle Andaman District and at Nicobar District on May 31, 2022. Giving details of the programme, the Secretary (RD) informed that the first part of interaction will be held at State and District levels which will start at 10:15 a.m. and conclude at 10:50 a.m. On this occasion, interaction with beneficiaries will be done by the State & District Officials.

and Management of Non-communicable Diseases and Chronic Communicable diseases like Tuberculosis was introduced at every HWCs earlier. On completion of the roll out of the additional services, the H&WC would provide Preventive, Promotive, Rehabilitative and Curative care for RMNCH+A, communicable diseases, non-communicable diseases, Ophthalmology, ENT, Dental, Mental, Geriatric care, Palliative care, treatment for acute simple medical conditions and emergency & trauma services will be provided at the HWCs.

In the functional HWCs, a total of 104 Sub Centres have been posted with 1 Mid Level Health Provider (MLHPs)/Community Health Officer (CHOs) each to provide the defined services with the existing workforce.

Accordingly, this UT had made functional 129HWCs, out of 129 Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs) approved by the MoH& FW. With this achievement, this UT has already achieved the saturation of the target set by GoI for operationalization of Health & Wellness Centres.

In addition to this, as part of Comprehensive Primary Health Care (CPHC), additional emergency services have also been added like Basic Oral Health Care, Care for Common Ophthalmic and ENT problems, Elderly and Palliative Health Care Services, Screening and Basic Management of Mental Health ailment. Necessary hands on training has already been provided to the concerned para medical staffs i.e. Staff Nurse, CHOs, ANMs etc. for the proper implementation of the activities covered under Comprehensive Primary Health Care (CPHC), a press release from DHS said.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

12,320 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs vaccinated so far

Port Blair, May 25

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,80,260 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,528 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs. and 12,320 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 23662. A total of 309 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 256 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 34 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 4 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 54. 53 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 50, a press release from DHS said.

BSNL launches 3G services at Katchal Island

Port Blair, May 25

In the continuing endeavor towards extending and improving internet services in remote Islands of A&N Islands, BSNL A&N has added another feather in its cap by launching 3G Mobile services at Katchal Island on 23rd May, 2022. This is the first time that the people of this Island could use mobile data services with appreciable speed. Before this, the residents of these Islands were having only 2G Mobile services, BSNL is the sole mobile operator having their presence in Katchal island.

The Chief General Manager, BSNL, A&N Telecom Circle, Shri G Raja Ram Mohan during the launch of 3G Mobile data services at Katchal Island made few video calls through Whatsapp to staffs of BSNL at Katchal and appreciated their efforts in launching the services. He expressed his sincere thanks to the A&N Administration in extending all support in commissioning of 3G Mobile services in this remote Island. He also thanked BSNL Co& BSNL STR for timely augmenting the satellite bandwidth at Katchal.

The Chief General Manager, BSNL, A&N Telecom Circle, also informed that proposal for augmenting all mobile BTS in A&N islands to 4G has been sent to BSNL Co and the same is likely to be rolled out under the Phase-IX.2 'Atmanirbhar' project by the end of this financial year which will be a real boost to the Islanders.

Further, he stated that In order to bridge the digital divide in these Islands, BSNL has invited interested TIPS/LCOs/ CSCs to enroll as partner for further extending FTTH/Air Fiber services to uncovered and rural areas of these islands, a press release from BSNL, A&N Circle said.

Certification.

In order to retain the Blue Flag Certification during the current bathing season 2022-2023, the Chairman, Beach Management Committee, South Andaman District is committed to fulfill all the parameters required to obtain the Blue Flag Certification.

In pursuance to the above, Beach Management Committee (BMC) convened a meeting under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman/ Chairman, BMC today along with AC (S), DFO, Swaraj Dweep, SDPO, Swaraj Dweep, Health officials, Pradhan, Shyamnagar and other PRI members in the Conference Hall of DC Office. All parameters for Blue Flag were discussed in presence of the Members of Beach Management Committee.

After detailed deliberation, the Chairman, BMC has directed the concerned to expedite the process of Collation of test reports from BMCs, Consolidated datasheet for Bathing Water Quality Test (BWQT), Verification of Water Quality (WQ) Test Results w.r.t FEE Macro (Blue Flag Certification Agency) and Bathing Water profile (BWP).

Directions have been issued to Rural Development Department for making the plant operational for Solid Waste Management Plan (WMP) of the beach immediately in consultation with the respective PRI members.

1. Short title and Commencement :-  
(i) These Rules may be called “Andaman and Nicobar (Panchayat Administration) (Amendment) Rules, 2022.  
(ii) This shall come into force from the date of Notification.

AMENDMENTS

2. The Rule 34 of the “Andaman and Nicobar (Panchayat Administration) Rules, 1997” (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rule) shall be substituted as under :-  
“34.Construction proposal to pre-suppose civic amenities:-(1) with effect from such date and with respect to such Gram or Grams as may be specific by the Administration by Notification, a plan for new structure or building within the jurisdiction of a Gram Panchayat shall have reasonable provisions for:-  
a.adequate drainage facility by means of access and passage leading to existing public drains or drainage channels or by means of soak-pit having adequate capacity,  
b.sanitary facilities include garbage disposal facility, and  
c. access road or passage to the plot as referred to in Rule 33.  
2.If a Gram Panchayat is of opinion that for the purpose of proper sanitation on a locality, any premises should have its drainage facility through a private drain owned by another plot-holder, the Gram Panchayat may, by a written notice to the owner of such premises as also of such private drain, require-  
(i)The owner of such premises to connect his house drain with such private drain, and  
(ii) The owner of such private drain to permit such connection with the private drain.  
3.When a connection is made under sub-rule (2) maintenance, repair and clearing of the private drain from the point of such connection upto the public drain shall be the joint responsibility of the owners of such premises and private drain:  
Provided that, if any dispute arises between the owners in the discharge of the joint responsibilities, it shall be referred to the Pradhan, and his decision in such dispute shall be final and binding on the owners.  
Explanation:- For the purpose of this rule, “Public Drain” means a drain maintained by the Government of India, the Administration or any local authority where the owners or the occupier of a building or land may cause his drains to empty.  
4.Andaman & Nicobar Islands Energy Conservation Building Code and Rule, 2019 notified vide Gazette Notification No.158 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> August,2019 shall be mutatis and mutandis applicable to the Rural Area of Andaman and Nicobar Islands in respect of all the Government and Private Buildings (building for commercial or institutional purposes and also residential purposes).”

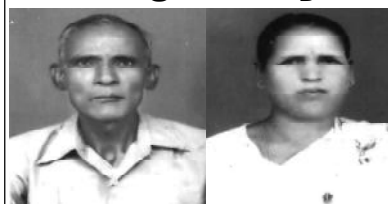
