Allegations of irregularities in recruitment drive for Panch. Secy, Extn. Officer Chief Spokesperson of PCC demands probe, time-bound filling-up of vacancies

Port Blair, Nov 21: Controversies seem to refuse to die down over the manner in which recruitment drives have been conducted by the Andaman and been conducted by the Amainian and Nicobar Administration. Repeated appeals by political parties particularly the Pradesh Congress Committee notw ithstanding, delay on the partofthe administration to fill up sanctioned vacancies in several government departments has been drawing flak from the unemployed youth in these islands. Albeit directives issued influes eislands. Albeitdirectives issued by the Union Government, delay in finalization ofrecruitment process by local government agencies is a prime reason for the allegations. After many instances in the past, his time titls the recruitment to the post of Panchayat Secretary, and the post of Panchay at Secretary and Extension Office in the Department of Rural Dev elopmentthat has come under

public scrutiny.

Calls made seeking response from candidates about the written exams conducted by the administration for the

posts of Panchay at Secretary and Extension Office in the Rural Dev elopment Department, by the Chief Editor of this daily, Mr K Ganeshan and former Chairperson of Port Blair Municipal Council drew negative responses. "The question paper, of around 40 pages, instead of being sealed with adhesive paperseal, was stapled at the edges and ittook some time for candidates to unpin the pages. In all the examinations conducted by recruitment bodies like UPSC and Staff Selection Commission UPSC and Staff Selecton Commission, question papers have paper seals to prevent tampering and the envelope containing the papers is sealed. Upon opening the paper, candidates were taken aback by the smaller fontsize of text and poor print quality. The paper was halfthe normal A4 size and had a low quality xerox-lke print. Candidates had to strain hard to read the questions. Further, only one small page was given for rough work attheend, which was not at all sufficient.

"In SSC, Bank and UPSC examinations there is no restriction on usage ofrough sheets, then why are we expected to use air instead of paper," said a candidate who eared in the recruitmentex amination

appeared in the recruitmentex amination.

"High w eightage of Current Affairs questions in the General Awareness section and the sudden change of the difficulty level of the paper raise doubts over the integrity of the recruitment process. The syllabus circulated by the administration for the exams included administration for the exams included Current Affairs, Geography, History, General Polity, Arts & culture and Science & Technology in the General Awareness section, but out of the 40 questions in the section, 37 were from Current Affairs. There was not a single question relating to Village panchay at or Panchay ati Raj More surprisingly not even a single question was asked about these islands.

"Even the skill test was reduced m 45 words to 35 words per minute. In the results only 2 candidates cleared and passed the skill test where the Secretary's daughter too had failed. The final outcome of the entire recruitment process was most surprising and shocking. The 2 candidates who had passed the skill test did not find a place in the selection list, whereas 21 ohers including the Secretary's daughter got the jobs. It is alleged that all those who got the job despite poor performance in written testand failure in skill test paid Rs 8 Lakhs as bribe. "When the disgrunted candidates told the successful ones that they would pursue the matter as it was illegal, they were requested not to do so, as itmay hamper their future and that they

may also lose the money they have spent to acquire the job," claimed one as pirant.

"Invigilators appointed in many examination halls were not sensitive enough to maintain silence during the exam and continued gossiping with other staff. There is a need to impart basic training to invigilators to ensure fair exam conditions for all. A legible font size should have been used, papers printed on a standard sized paper, with margins for roughwork (as in SSC) or provisions for additional rough sheets. The Hindi-translated questions should also be placed in a separate column like done in UPSC and SSC question papers," read another

IMMUNE-SUPPRESSED NOT AT HIGHER RISK OF POOR COVID OUTCOMES: LANCET STUDY People taking medications that

suppress the immune system overall do not have a higher risk of dying from COVID-19 or being put on a ventilator than those not taking these drugs, according to a study published in The

accoining to a study published in The Lannet Rheumablogy journal. The team led by researchers at Johns Hopkins University in the US analy sed electronic health records of adults hospitalised with COVID-19 from January 2020 to June 2021 in the

The study included 222,575 individuals, including 16,494 patients who had been on immunosuppressive medications prior to hospitalisation.

medications into 17 classes and found significantly increased risk of being put on a ventilator – an indication of severe

COVID-19 illness.
"In general, people taking immunosuppressive medications may be reassured that they can safely

At the start of the pandemic people w ho take immunosuppressive drugs for organ transplants, autoimmune diseases, cancers and other conditions were considered as being at potentially increased risk of being at potentially increased risk of severe outcomes, given their weakened immune systems. On the other hand, some of the damage to lungs and other organs in severe COVID-19 comes less from

direct viral damage and more from immune overactivation, the researchers said. By the summer of 2020, doctors

By the summer of 2020, docbrs were treating severe COVID-19 with immunosuppressiv e drugs such as dexametrasone, they said. The researchers noted that it was notinitially clear whether the long-term

increased or decreased the risk severe C OVID-19.

In a smaller, preliminary study published earlier this year, the team found no significant association between the chronic use of

between the chronic use of immunosuppressive drugs and ventlator or mortality risk.

This suggested any increased susceptibility to infection and viral spread may be balanced by a decreased susceptibility to harmful information. The researchers and infammation, the researchers said.

The latest study, drawing from a nation wide dataset gathered by the nation wide dataset garhered by the National COVID Cohort Colaborative, covered a sample of COVID-19 palents that was over 100 times larger than the preliminary study. The US arm of the domestic pharma major is recalling Tadalafil tablets in the American market, according to the latest enforcement report of the US Food and Drug Administration

(USF DA).

maker is recalling the product in 30-


